COMMANDMENTS

<u>Gen_26:5</u> Because that Abraham obeyed my voice, and kept my charge, my commandments, my statutes, and my laws.

<u>Exo_15:26</u> And said, If thou wilt diligently hearken to the voice of the LORD thy God, and wilt do that which is right in his sight, and wilt give ear to his commandments, and keep all his statutes, I will put none of these diseases upon thee, which I have brought upon the Egyptians: for I *am* the LORD that healeth thee.

<u>Exo_16:28</u> And the LORD said unto Moses, How long refuse ye to keep my commandments and my laws?

<u>Exo_20:6</u> And shewing mercy unto thousands of them that love me, and keep my commandments.

<u>Exo_24:12</u> And the LORD said unto Moses, Come up to me into the mount, and be there: and I will give thee tables of stone, and a law, and commandments which I have written; that thou mayest teach them.

<u>Exo_34:28</u> And he was there with the LORD forty days and forty nights; he did neither eat bread, nor drink water. And he wrote upon the tables the words of the covenant, the ten commandments.

Lev_4:2 Speak unto the children of Israel, saying, If a soul shall sin through ignorance against any of the commandments of the LORD *concerning things* which ought not to be done, and shall do against any of them:

<u>Lev_4:13</u> And if the whole congregation of Israel sin through ignorance, and the thing be hid from the eyes of the assembly, and they have done *somewhat against* any of the commandments of the LORD *concerning things* which should not be done, and are guilty;

Lev_4:22 When a ruler hath sinned, and done *somewhat* through ignorance *against* any of the commandments of the LORD his God *concerning things* which should not be done, and is guilty;

Lev_4:27 And if any one of the common people sin through ignorance, while he doeth *somewhat against* any of the commandments of the LORD *concerning things* which ought not to be done, and be guilty;

Lev_5:17 And if a soul sin, and commit any of these things which are forbidden to be done by the commandments of the LORD; though he wist *it* not, yet is he guilty, and shall bear his iniquity.

<u>Lev_22:31</u> Therefore shall ye keep my commandments, and do them: I am the LORD.

Lev_26:3 If ye walk in my statutes, and keep my commandments, and do

them;

Lev_26:14 But if ye will not hearken unto me, and will not do all these commandments;

Lev_26:15 And if ye shall despise my statutes, or if your soul abhor my judgments, so that ye will not do all my commandments, *but* that ye break my covenant:

Lev_27:34 These *are* the commandments, which the LORD commanded Moses for the children of Israel in mount Sinai.

<u>Num_15:22</u> And if ye have erred, and not observed all these commandments, which the LORD hath spoken unto Moses,

<u>Num_15:39</u> And it shall be unto you for a fringe, that ye may look upon it, and remember all the commandments of the LORD, and do them; and that ye seek not after your own heart and your own eyes, after which ye use to go a whoring:

<u>Num_15:40</u> That ye may remember, and do all my commandments, and be holy unto your God.

<u>Num_36:13</u> These *are* the commandments and the judgments, which the LORD commanded by the hand of Moses unto the children of Israel in the plains of Moab by Jordan *near* Jericho.

<u>Deu_4:2</u> Ye shall not add unto the word which I command you, neither shall ye diminish *ought* from it, that ye may keep the commandments of the LORD your God which I command you.

<u>Deu_4:13</u> And he declared unto you his covenant, which he commanded you to perform, *even* ten commandments; and he wrote them upon two tables of stone.

<u>Deu_4:40</u> Thou shalt keep therefore his statutes, and his commandments, which I command thee this day, that it may go well with thee, and with thy children after thee, and that thou mayest prolong *thy* days upon the earth, which the LORD thy God giveth thee, for ever.

<u>Deu 5:10</u> And shewing mercy unto thousands of them that love me and keep my commandments.

<u>Deu 5:29</u> O that there were such an heart in them, that they would fear me, and keep all my commandments always, that it might be well with them, and with their children for ever!

<u>Deu_5:31</u> But as for thee, stand thou here by me, and I will speak unto thee

all the commandments, and the statutes, and the judgments, which thou shalt teach them, that they may do *them* in the land which I give them to possess it.

<u>Deu_6:1</u> Now these *are* the commandments, the statutes, and the judgments, which the LORD your God commanded to teach you, that ye might do *them* in the land whither ye go to possess it:

<u>Deu_6:2</u> That thou mightest fear the LORD thy God, to keep all his statutes and his commandments, which I command thee, thou, and thy son, and thy son's son, all the days of thy life; and that thy days may be prolonged.

<u>Deu_6:17</u> Ye shall diligently keep the commandments of the LORD your God, and his testimonies, and his statutes, which he hath commanded thee.

<u>Deu_6:25</u> And it shall be our righteousness, if we observe to do all these commandments before the LORD our God, as he hath commanded us.

<u>Deu_7:9</u> Know therefore that the LORD thy God, he *is* God, the faithful God, which keepeth covenant and mercy with them that love him and keep his commandments to a thousand generations;

<u>Deu_7:11</u> Thou shalt therefore keep the commandments, and the statutes, and the judgments, which I command thee this day, to do them.

<u>Deu_8:1</u> All the commandments which I command thee this day shall ye observe to do, that ye may live, and multiply, and go in and possess the land which the LORD sware unto your fathers.

<u>Deu_8:2</u> And thou shalt remember all the way which the LORD thy God led thee these forty years in the wilderness, to humble thee, *and* to prove thee, to know what *was* in thine heart, whether thou wouldest keep his commandments, or no.

<u>Deu_8:6</u> Therefore thou shalt keep the commandments of the LORD thy God, to walk in his ways, and to fear him.

<u>Deu_8:11</u> Beware that thou forget not the LORD thy God, in not keeping his commandments, and his judgments, and his statutes, which I command thee this day:

<u>Deu_10:4</u> And he wrote on the tables, according to the first writing, the ten commandments, which the LORD spake unto you in the mount out of the midst of the fire in the day of the assembly: and the LORD gave them unto me.

<u>Deu_10:13</u> To keep the commandments of the LORD, and his statutes, which I command thee this day for thy good?

<u>Deu_11:1</u> Therefore thou shalt love the LORD thy God, and keep his charge,

and his statutes, and his judgments, and his commandments, alway.

<u>Deu_11:8</u> Therefore shall ye keep all the commandments which I command you this day, that ye may be strong, and go in and possess the land, whither ye go to possess it;

<u>Deu_11:13</u> And it shall come to pass, if ye shall hearken diligently unto my commandments which I command you this day, to love the LORD your God, and to serve him with all your heart and with all your soul,

<u>Deu_11:22</u> For if ye shall diligently keep all these commandments which I command you, to do them, to love the LORD your God, to walk in all his ways, and to cleave unto him;

<u>Deu_11:27</u> A blessing, if ye obey the commandments of the LORD your God, which I command you this day:

<u>Deu_11:28</u> And a curse, if ye will not obey the commandments of the LORD your God, but turn aside out of the way which I command you this day, to go after other gods, which ye have not known.

<u>Deu_13:4</u> Ye shall walk after the LORD your God, and fear him, and keep his commandments, and obey his voice, and ye shall serve him, and cleave unto him.

<u>Deu 13:18</u> When thou shalt hearken to the voice of the LORD thy God, to keep all his commandments which I command thee this day, to do *that which is* right in the eyes of the LORD thy God.

<u>Deu_15:5</u> Only if thou carefully hearken unto the voice of the LORD thy God, to observe to do all these commandments which I command thee this day.

<u>Deu_19:9</u> If thou shalt keep all these commandments to do them, which I command thee this day, to love the LORD thy God, and to walk ever in his ways; then shalt thou add three cities more for thee, beside these three:

<u>Deu_26:13</u> Then thou shalt say before the LORD thy God, I have brought away the hallowed things out of *mine* house, and also have given them unto the Levite, and unto the stranger, to the fatherless, and to the widow, according to all thy commandments which thou hast commanded me: I have not transgressed thy commandments, neither have I forgotten *them:*

<u>Deu_26:17</u> Thou hast avouched the LORD this day to be thy God, and to walk in his ways, and to keep his statutes, and his commandments, and his judgments, and to hearken unto his voice:

<u>Deu_26:18</u> And the LORD hath avouched thee this day to be his peculiar people, as he hath promised thee, and that *thou* shouldest keep all his

commandments;

<u>Deu_27:1</u> And Moses with the elders of Israel commanded the people, saying, Keep all the commandments which I command you this day.

<u>Deu_27:10</u> Thou shalt therefore obey the voice of the LORD thy God, and do his commandments and his statutes, which I command thee this day.

<u>Deu_28:1</u> And it shall come to pass, if thou shalt hearken diligently unto the voice of the LORD thy God, to observe *and* to do all his commandments which I command thee this day, that the LORD thy God will set thee on high above all nations of the earth:

<u>Deu_28:9</u> The LORD shall establish thee an holy people unto himself, as he hath sworn unto thee, if thou shalt keep the commandments of the LORD thy God, and walk in his ways.

<u>Deu_28:13</u> And the LORD shall make thee the head, and not the tail; and thou shalt be above only, and thou shalt not be beneath; if that thou hearken unto the commandments of the LORD thy God, which I command thee this day, to observe and to do *them:*

<u>Deu_28:15</u> But it shall come to pass, if thou wilt not hearken unto the voice of the LORD thy God, to observe to do all his commandments and his statutes which I command thee this day; that all these curses shall come upon thee, and overtake thee:

<u>Deu_28:45</u> Moreover all these curses shall come upon thee, and shall pursue thee, and overtake thee, till thou be destroyed; because thou hearkenedst not unto the voice of the LORD thy God, to keep his

commandments and his statutes which he commanded thee:

<u>Deu_30:8</u> And thou shalt return and obey the voice of the LORD, and do all his commandments which I command thee this day.

<u>Deu_30:10</u> If thou shalt hearken unto the voice of the LORD thy God, to keep his commandments and his statutes which are written in this book of the law, *and* if thou turn unto the LORD thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul.

<u>Deu_30:16</u> In that I command thee this day to love the LORD thy God, to walk in his ways, and to keep his commandments and his statutes and his judgments, that thou mayest live and multiply: and the LORD thy God shall bless thee in the land whither thou goest to possess it.

<u>Deu_31:5</u> And the LORD shall give them up before your face, that ye may do unto them according unto all the commandments which I have commanded

you.

<u>Jos_22:5</u> But take diligent heed to do the commandment and the law, which Moses the servant of the LORD charged you, to love the LORD your God, and to walk in all his ways, and to keep his commandments, and to cleave unto him, and to serve him with all your heart and with all your soul.

<u>Jdg_2:17</u> And yet they would not hearken unto their judges, but they went a whoring after other gods, and bowed themselves unto them: they turned quickly out of the way which their fathers walked in, obeying the commandments of the LORD; *but* they did not so.

<u>Jdg_3:4</u> And they were to prove Israel by them, to know whether they would hearken unto the commandments of the LORD, which he commanded their fathers by the hand of Moses.

<u>1Sa_15:11</u> It repenteth me that I have set up Saul *to be* king: for he is turned back from following me, and hath not performed my commandments. And it grieved Samuel; and he cried unto the LORD all night.

<u>1Ki_2:3</u> And keep the charge of the LORD thy God, to walk in his ways, to keep his statutes, and his commandments, and his judgments, and his testimonies, as it is written in the law of Moses, that thou mayest prosper in all that thou doest, and whithersoever thou turnest thyself:

<u> $1Ki_3:14$ </u> And if thou wilt walk in my ways, to keep my statutes and my commandments, as thy father David did walk, then I will lengthen thy days.

<u>1Ki_6:12</u> Concerning this house which thou art in building, if thou wilt walk in my statutes, and execute my judgments, and keep all my commandments to walk in them; then will I perform my word with thee, which I spake unto David thy father:

<u>1Ki_8:58</u> That he may incline our hearts unto him, to walk in all his ways, and to keep his commandments, and his statutes, and his judgments, which he commanded our fathers.

<u> $1Ki_8:61$ </u> Let your heart therefore be perfect with the LORD our God, to walk in his statutes, and to keep his commandments, as at this day.

<u>1Ki_9:6</u> But if ye shall at all turn from following me, ye or your children, and will not keep my commandments *and* my statutes which I have set before you, but go and serve other gods, and worship them:

<u>1Ki_11:34</u> Howbeit I will not take the whole kingdom out of his hand: but I will make him prince all the days of his life for David my servant's sake, whom I chose, because he kept my commandments and my statutes:

<u>1Ki_11:38</u> And it shall be, if thou wilt hearken unto all that I command thee, and wilt walk in my ways, and do *that is* right in my sight, to keep my statutes and my commandments, as David my servant did; that I will be with thee, and build thee a sure house, as I built for David, and will give Israel unto thee.

<u>1Ki_14:8</u> And rent the kingdom away from the house of David, and gave it thee: and *yet* thou hast not been as my servant David, who kept my commandments, and who followed me with all his heart, to do *that* only *which was* right in mine eyes;

<u>1Ki_18:18</u> And he answered, I have not troubled Israel; but thou, and thy father's house, in that ye have forsaken the commandments of the LORD, and thou hast followed Baalim.

<u>2Ki_17:13</u> Yet the LORD testified against Israel, and against Judah, by all the prophets, *and by* all the seers, saying, Turn ye from your evil ways, and keep my commandments *and* my statutes, according to all the law which I commanded your fathers, and which I sent to you by my servants the prophets.

<u>2Ki_17:16</u> And they left all the commandments of the LORD their God, and made them molten images, *even* two calves, and made a grove, and worshipped all the host of heaven, and served Baal.

 $2Ki_{17:19}$ Also Judah kept not the commandments of the LORD their God, but walked in the statutes of Israel which they made.

<u>2Ki_18:6</u> For he clave to the LORD, *and* departed not from following him, but kept his commandments, which the LORD commanded Moses.

<u>2Ki_23:3</u> And the king stood by a pillar, and made a covenant before the LORD, to walk after the LORD, and to keep his commandments and his testimonies and his statutes with all *their* heart and all *their* soul, to perform the words of this covenant that were written in this book. And all the people stood to the covenant.

<u>1Ch_28:7</u> Moreover I will establish his kingdom for ever, if he be constant to do my commandments and my judgments, as at this day.

<u>1Ch_28:8</u> Now therefore in the sight of all Israel the congregation of the LORD, and in the audience of our God, keep and seek for all the commandments of the LORD your God: that ye may possess this good land, and leave *it* for an inheritance for your children after you for ever.

<u>1Ch_29:19</u> And give unto Solomon my son a perfect heart, to keep thy commandments, thy testimonies, and thy statutes, and to do all *these things*, and to build the palace, *for* the which I have made provision.

<u>2Ch_7:19</u> But if ye turn away, and forsake my statutes and my commandments, which I have set before you, and shall go and serve other gods, and worship them;

<u>2Ch_17:4</u> But sought to the *LORD* God of his father, and walked in his commandments, and not after the doings of Israel.

<u>2Ch_24:20</u> And the Spirit of God came upon Zechariah the son of Jehoiada the priest, which stood above the people, and said unto them, Thus saith God, Why transgress ye the commandments of the LORD, that ye cannot prosper? because ye have forsaken the LORD, he hath also forsaken you.

<u>2Ch_31:21</u> And in every work that he began in the service of the house of God, and in the law, and in the commandments, to seek his God, he did *it* with all his heart, and prospered.

<u>2Ch_34:31</u> And the king stood in his place, and made a covenant before the LORD, to walk after the LORD, and to keep his commandments, and his testimonies, and his statutes, with all his heart, and with all his soul, to perform the words of the covenant which are written in this book.

Ezr_7:11 Now this *is* the copy of the letter that the king Artaxerxes gave unto Ezra the priest, the scribe, *even* a scribe of the words of the commandments of the LORD, and of his statutes to Israel.

<u>Ezr_9:10</u> And now, O our God, what shall we say after this? for we have forsaken thy commandments,

<u>Ezr_9:14</u> Should we again break thy commandments, and join in affinity with the people of these abominations? wouldest not thou be angry with us till thou hadst consumed *us*, so that *there should be* no remnant nor escaping?

<u>Neh_1:5</u> And said, I beseech thee, O LORD God of heaven, the great and terrible God, that keepeth covenant and mercy for them that love him and observe his commandments:

<u>Neh_1:7</u> We have dealt very corruptly against thee, and have not kept the commandments, nor the statutes, nor the judgments, which thou commandedst thy servant Moses.

<u>Neh_1:9</u> But *if* ye turn unto me, and keep my commandments, and do them; though there were of you cast out unto the uttermost part of the heaven, *yet* will I gather them from thence, and will bring them unto the place that I have chosen to set my name there.

<u>Neh_9:13</u> Thou camest down also upon mount Sinai, and spakest with them from heaven, and gavest them right judgments, and true laws, good statutes and commandments:

<u>Neh_9:16</u> But they and our fathers dealt proudly, and hardened their necks, and hearkened not to thy commandments,

<u>Neh_9:29</u> And testifiedst against them, that thou mightest bring them again unto thy law: yet they dealt proudly, and hearkened not unto thy commandments, but sinned against thy judgments, (which if a man do, he shall live in them;) and withdrew the shoulder, and hardened their neck, and would not hear.

<u>Neh_9:34</u> Neither have our kings, our princes, our priests, nor our fathers, kept thy law, nor hearkened unto thy commandments and thy testimonies, wherewith thou didst testify against them.

<u>Neh_10:29</u> They clave to their brethren, their nobles, and entered into a curse, and into an oath, to walk in God's law, which was given by Moses the servant of God, and to observe and do all the commandments of the LORD our Lord, and his judgments and his statutes;

<u>Psa_78:7</u> That they might set their hope in God, and not forget the works of God, but keep his commandments:

<u>Psa_89:31</u> If they break my statutes, and keep not my commandments;

<u>Psa_103:18</u> To such as keep his covenant, and to those that remember his commandments to do them.

<u>Psa_103:20</u> Bless the LORD, ye his angels, that excel in strength, that do his commandments, hearkening unto the voice of his word.

<u>Psa_111:7</u> The works of his hands *are* verity and judgment; all his commandments *are* sure.

<u>Psa_111:10</u> The fear of the LORD *is* the beginning of wisdom: a good understanding have all they that do *his commandments:* his praise endureth for ever.

<u>Psa_112:1</u> Praise ye the LORD. Blessed *is* the man *that* feareth the LORD, *that* delighteth greatly in his commandments.

<u>Psa_119:6</u> Then shall I not be ashamed, when I have respect unto all thy commandments.

<u>Psa_119:10</u> With my whole heart have I sought thee: O let me not wander from thy commandments.

<u>Psa_119:19</u> I *am* a stranger in the earth: hide not thy commandments from me.

<u>Psa_119:21</u> Thou hast rebuked the proud *that are* cursed, which do err from

thy commandments.

<u>Psa_119:32</u> I will run the way of thy commandments, when thou shalt enlarge my heart.

<u>Psa_119:35</u> Make me to go in the path of thy

commandments; for therein do I delight.

<u>Psa_119:47</u> And I will delight myself in thy commandments, which I have loved.

<u>Psa_119:48</u> My hands also will I lift up unto thy commandments, which I have loved; and I will meditate in thy statutes.

<u>Psa_119:60</u> I made haste, and delayed not to keep thy commandments.

<u>Psa_119:66</u> Teach me good judgment and knowledge: for I have believed thy commandments.

<u>Psa_119:73</u> JOD. Thy hands have made me and fashioned me: give me understanding, that I may learn thy commandments.

<u>Psa_119:86</u> All thy commandments *are* faithful: they persecute me wrongfully; help thou me.

<u>Psa_119:98</u> Thou through thy commandments hast made me wiser than mine enemies: for they *are* ever with me.

<u>Psa_119:115</u> Depart from me, ye evildoers: for I will keep the commandments of my God.

<u>Psa_119:127</u> Therefore I love thy commandments above gold; yea, above fine gold.

<u>Psa_119:131</u> I opened my mouth, and panted: for I longed for thy commandments.

<u>Psa_119:143</u> Trouble and anguish have taken hold on me: *yet* thy commandments *are* my delights.

<u>Psa_119:151</u> Thou *art* near, O LORD; and all thy commandments *are* truth.

<u>Psa_119:166</u> LORD, I have hoped for thy salvation, and done thy commandments.

<u>Psa_119:172</u> My tongue shall speak of thy word: for all thy commandments *are* righteousness.

<u>Psa_119:176</u> I have gone astray like a lost sheep; seek thy servant; for I do not forget thy commandments.

<u>Pro_2:1</u> My son, if thou wilt receive my words, and hide my commandments with thee;

<u>Pro_3:1</u> My son, forget not my law; but let thine heart keep my commandments:

<u>Pro_4:4</u> He taught me also, and said unto me, Let thine heart retain my words: keep my commandments, and live.

<u>Pro_7:1</u> My son, keep my words, and lay up my commandments with thee.

<u>Pro_7:2</u> Keep my commandments, and live; and my law as the apple of thine eye.

<u>Pro_10:8</u> The wise in heart will receive commandments: but a prating fool shall fall.

<u>Ecc_12:13</u> Let us hear the conclusion of the whole matter: Fear God, and keep his commandments: for this *is* the whole *duty* of man.

<u>Isa_48:18</u> O that thou hadst hearkened to my commandments! then had thy peace been as a river, and thy righteousness as the waves of the sea:

<u>Dan_9:4</u> And I prayed unto the LORD my God, and made my confession, and said, O Lord, the great and dreadful God, keeping the covenant and mercy to them that love him, and to them that keep his commandments;

<u>Amo_2:4</u> Thus saith the LORD; For three transgressions of Judah, and for four, I will not turn away *the punishment* thereof; because they have despised the law of the LORD, and have not kept his commandments, and their lies caused them to err, after the which their fathers have walked:

<u>Mat_5:19</u> Whosoever therefore shall break one of these least commandments, and shall teach men so, he shall be called the least in the kingdom of heaven: but whosoever shall do and teach *them*, the same shall be called great in the kingdom of heaven.

<u>Mat_15:9</u> But in vain they do worship me, teaching *for* doctrines the commandments of men.

<u>Mat 19:17</u> And he said unto him, Why callest thou me good? *there is* none good but one, *that is,* God: but if thou wilt enter into life, keep the commandments.

Mat_22:40 On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets.

<u>Mar_7:7</u> Howbeit in vain do they worship me, teaching *for* doctrines the commandments of men.

<u>Mar_10:19</u> Thou knowest the commandments, Do not commit adultery, Do not kill, Do not steal, Do not bear false witness, Defraud not, Honour thy father and mother.

<u>Mar_12:29</u> And Jesus answered him, The first of all the commandments *is*, Hear, O Israel; The Lord our God is one Lord:

Luk_1:6 And they were both righteous before God, walking in all the commandments and ordinances of the Lord blameless.

Luk_18:20 Thou knowest the commandments, Do not commit adultery, Do not kill, Do not steal, Do not bear false witness, Honour thy father and thy mother.

<u>Joh_14:15</u> If ye love me, keep my commandments.

<u>Joh_14:21</u> He that hath my commandments, and keepeth them, he it is that loveth me: and he that loveth me shall be loved of my Father, and I will love him, and will manifest myself to him.

<u>Joh_15:10</u> If ye keep my commandments, ye shall abide in my love; even as I have kept my Father's commandments, and abide in his love.

<u>Act_1:2</u> Until the day in which he was taken up, after that he through the Holy Ghost had given commandments unto the apostles whom he had chosen:

<u> $1Co_7:19$ </u> Circumcision is nothing, and uncircumcision is nothing, but the keeping of the commandments of God.

<u>1Co_14:37</u> If any man think himself to be a prophet, or spiritual, let him acknowledge that the things that I write unto you are the commandments of the Lord.

<u>Eph_2:15</u> Having abolished in his flesh the enmity, *even* the law of commandments *contained* in ordinances; for to make in himself of twain one new man, *so* making peace;

<u>Col_2:22</u> Which all are to perish with the using;) after the commandments and doctrines of men?

<u>Col_4:10</u> Aristarchus my fellowprisoner saluteth you, and Marcus, sister's son to Barnabas, (touching whom ye received commandments: if he come unto you, receive him;)

 $1Th_{4:2}$ For ye know what commandments we gave you by the Lord Jesus.

<u>Tit_1:14</u> Not giving heed to Jewish fables, and commandments of men, that

turn from the truth.

<u> $1Jn_2:3$ </u> And hereby we do know that we know him, if we keep his commandments.

<u> $1Jn_2:4$ </u> He that saith, I know him, and keepeth not his commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him.

<u>1Jn_3:22</u> And whatsoever we ask, we receive of him, because we keep his commandments, and do those things that are pleasing in his sight.

<u> $1Jn_3:24$ </u> And he that keepeth his commandments dwelleth in him, and he in him. And hereby we know that he abideth in us, by the Spirit which he hath given us.

<u> $1Jn_5:2$ </u> By this we know that we love the children of God, when we love God, and keep his commandments.

<u> $1Jn_5:3$ </u> For this is the love of God, that we keep his commandments: and his commandments are not grievous.

<u>2Jn_1:6</u> And this is love, that we walk after his commandments. This is the commandment, That, as ye have heard from the beginning, ye should walk in it.

<u>Rev_12:17</u> And the dragon was wroth with the woman, and went to make war with the remnant of her seed, which keep the commandments of God, and have the testimony of Jesus Christ.

<u>Rev_14:12</u> Here is the patience of the saints: here *are* they that keep the commandments of God, and the faith of Jesus.

<u>Rev_22:14</u> Blessed *are* they that do his commandments, that they may have right to the tree of life, and may enter in through the gates into the city.
