- Gen_1:1 In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth.
- <u>Gen_1:2</u> And the earth was without form, and void; and darkness *was* upon the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters.
- <u>Gen_1:10</u> And God called the dry *land* Earth; and the gathering together of the waters called he Seas: and God saw that *it was* good.
- <u>Gen_1:11</u> And God said, Let the earth bring forth grass, the herb yielding seed, *and* the fruit tree yielding fruit after his kind, whose seed *is* in itself, upon the earth: and it was so.
- <u>Gen 1:12</u> And the earth brought forth grass, *and* herb yielding seed after his kind, and the tree yielding fruit, whose seed *was* in itself, after his kind: and God saw that *it was* good.
- <u>Gen_1:15</u> And let them be for lights in the firmament of the heaven to give light upon the earth: and it was so.
- <u>Gen_1:17</u> And God set them in the firmament of the heaven to give light upon the earth,
- <u>Gen_1:20</u> And God said, Let the waters bring forth abundantly the moving creature that hath life, and fowl *that* may fly above the earth in the open firmament of heaven.
- <u>Gen 1:22</u> And God blessed them, saying, Be fruitful, and multiply, and fill the waters in the seas, and let fowl multiply in the earth.
- <u>Gen_1:24</u> And God said, Let the earth bring forth the living creature after his kind, cattle, and creeping thing, and beast of the earth after his kind: and it was so.
- <u>Gen_1:25</u> And God made the beast of the earth after his kind, and cattle after their kind, and every thing that creepeth upon the earth after his kind: and God saw that *it was* good.
- <u>Gen_1:26</u> And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth.
- <u>Gen_1:28</u> And God blessed them, and God said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth, and subdue it: and have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over every living thing that moveth upon the earth.
- <u>Gen_1:29</u> And God said, Behold, I have given you every herb bearing seed,

- which *is* upon the face of all the earth, and every tree, in the which *is* the fruit of a tree yielding seed; to you it shall be for meat.
- <u>Gen_1:30</u> And to every beast of the earth, and to every fowl of the air, and to every thing that creepeth upon the earth, wherein *there is* life, *I have given* every green herb for meat: and it was so.
- <u>Gen_2:1</u> Thus the heavens and the earth were finished, and all the host of them.
- <u>Gen_2:4</u> These *are* the generations of the heavens and of the earth when they were created, in the day that the LORD God made the earth and the heavens,
- <u>Gen_2:5</u> And every plant of the field before it was in the earth, and every herb of the field before it grew: for the LORD God had not caused it to rain upon the earth, and *there was* not a man to till the ground.
- <u>Gen_2:6</u> But there went up a mist from the earth, and watered the whole face of the ground.
- <u>Gen_4:11</u> And now *art* thou cursed from the earth, which hath opened her mouth to receive thy brother's blood from thy hand;
- <u>Gen_4:12</u> When thou tillest the ground, it shall not henceforth yield unto thee her strength; a fugitive and a vagabond shalt thou be in the earth.
- <u>Gen 4:14</u> Behold, thou hast driven me out this day from the face of the earth; and from thy face shall I be hid; and I shall be a fugitive and a vagabond in the earth; and it shall come to pass, *that* every one that findeth me shall slay me.
- <u>Gen_6:1</u> And it came to pass, when men began to multiply on the face of the earth, and daughters were born unto them,
- <u>Gen_6:4</u> There were giants in the earth in those days; and also after that, when the sons of God came in unto the daughters of men, and they bare *children* to them, the same *became* mighty men which *were* of old, men of renown.
- <u>Gen_6:5</u> And GOD saw that the wickedness of man *was* great in the earth, and *that* every imagination of the thoughts of his heart *was* only evil continually.
- <u>Gen_6:6</u> And it repented the LORD that he had made man on the earth, and it grieved him at his heart.
- <u>Gen_6:7</u> And the LORD said, I will destroy man whom I have created from the face of the earth; both man, and beast, and the creeping thing, and the fowls of the air; for it repenteth me that I have made them.
- <u>Gen_6:11</u> The earth also was corrupt before God, and the earth was filled with

violence.

- <u>Gen_6:12</u> And God looked upon the earth, and, behold, it was corrupt; for all flesh had corrupted his way upon the earth.
- <u>Gen_6:13</u> And God said unto Noah, The end of all flesh is come before me; for the earth is filled with violence through them; and, behold, I will destroy them with the earth.
- <u>Gen_6:17</u> And, behold, I, even I, do bring a flood of waters upon the earth, to destroy all flesh, wherein *is* the breath of life, from under heaven; *and* every thing that *is* in the earth shall die.
- <u>Gen_6:20</u> Of fowls after their kind, and of cattle after their kind, of every creeping thing of the earth after his kind, two of every *sort* shall come unto thee, to keep *them* alive.
- <u>Gen_7:3</u> Of fowls also of the air by sevens, the male and the female; to keep seed alive upon the face of all the earth.
- <u>Gen_7:4</u> For yet seven days, and I will cause it to rain upon the earth forty days and forty nights; and every living substance that I have made will I destroy from off the face of the earth.
- <u>Gen_7:6</u> And Noah was six hundred years old when the flood of waters was upon the earth.
- <u>Gen_7:8</u> Of clean beasts, and of beasts that *are* not clean, and of fowls, and of every thing that creepeth upon the earth,
- <u>Gen_7:10</u> And it came to pass after seven days, that the waters of the flood were upon the earth.
- Gen_7:12 And the rain was upon the earth forty days and forty nights.
- <u>Gen_7:14</u> They, and every beast after his kind, and all the cattle after their kind, and every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth after his kind, and every fowl after his kind, every bird of every sort.
- <u>Gen_7:17</u> And the flood was forty days upon the earth; and the waters increased, and bare up the ark, and it was lift up above the earth.
- <u>Gen_7:18</u> And the waters prevailed, and were increased greatly upon the earth; and the ark went upon the face of the waters.
- <u>Gen_7:19</u> And the waters prevailed exceedingly upon the earth; and all the high hills, that *were* under the whole heaven, were covered.
- Gen_7:21 And all flesh died that moved upon the earth, both of fowl, and of

- cattle, and of beast, and of every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth, and every man:
- <u>Gen_7:23</u> And every living substance was destroyed which was upon the face of the ground, both man, and cattle, and the creeping things, and the fowl of the heaven; and they were destroyed from the earth: and Noah only remained *alive*, and they that *were* with him in the ark.
- Gen 7:24 And the waters prevailed upon the earth an hundred and fifty days.
- <u>Gen_8:1</u> And God remembered Noah, and every living thing, and all the cattle that *was* with him in the ark: and God made a wind to pass over the earth, and the waters asswaged;
- <u>Gen_8:3</u> And the waters returned from off the earth continually: and after the end of the hundred and fifty days the waters were abated.
- <u>Gen_8:7</u> And he sent forth a raven, which went forth to and fro, until the waters were dried up from off the earth.
- <u>Gen_8:9</u> But the dove found no rest for the sole of her foot, and she returned unto him into the ark, for the waters *were* on the face of the whole earth: then he put forth his hand, and took her, and pulled her in unto him into the ark.
- <u>Gen_8:11</u> And the dove came in to him in the evening; and, lo, in her mouth was an olive leaf pluckt off: so Noah knew that the waters were abated from off the earth.
- <u>Gen_8:13</u> And it came to pass in the six hundredth and first year, in the first *month,* the first *day* of the month, the waters were dried up from off the earth: and Noah removed the covering of the ark, and looked, and, behold, the face of the ground was dry.
- <u>Gen_8:14</u> And in the second month, on the seven and twentieth day of the month, was the earth dried.
- <u>Gen_8:17</u> Bring forth with thee every living thing that *is* with thee, of all flesh, *both* of fowl, and of cattle, and of every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth; that they may breed abundantly in the earth, and be fruitful, and multiply upon the earth.
- <u>Gen 8:19</u> Every beast, every creeping thing, and every fowl, *and* whatsoever creepeth upon the earth, after their kinds, went forth out of the ark.
- <u>Gen_8:22</u> While the earth remaineth, seedtime and harvest, and cold and heat, and summer and winter, and day and night shall not cease.
- Gen_9:1 And God blessed Noah and his sons, and said unto them, Be fruitful,

- and multiply, and replenish the earth.
- <u>Gen_9:2</u> And the fear of you and the dread of you shall be upon every beast of the earth, and upon every fowl of the air, upon all that moveth *upon* the earth, and upon all the fishes of the sea; into your hand are they delivered.
- <u>Gen_9:7</u> And you, be ye fruitful, and multiply; bring forth abundantly in the earth, and multiply therein.
- <u>Gen_9:10</u> And with every living creature that *is* with you, of the fowl, of the cattle, and of every beast of the earth with you; from all that go out of the ark, to every beast of the earth.
- <u>Gen_9:11</u> And I will establish my covenant with you; neither shall all flesh be cut off any more by the waters of a flood; neither shall there any more be a flood to destroy the earth.
- <u>Gen_9:13</u> I do set my bow in the cloud, and it shall be for a token of a covenant between me and the earth.
- <u>Gen_9:14</u> And it shall come to pass, when I bring a cloud over the earth, that the bow shall be seen in the cloud:
- <u>Gen_9:16</u> And the bow shall be in the cloud; and I will look upon it, that I may remember the everlasting covenant between God and every living creature of all flesh that *is* upon the earth.
- Gen_9:17 And God said unto Noah, This is the token of the covenant, which I have established between me and all flesh that
- is upon the earth.
- <u>Gen_9:19</u> These *are* the three sons of Noah: and of them was the whole earth overspread.
- <u>Gen_10:8</u> And Cush begat Nimrod: he began to be a mighty one in the earth.
- <u>Gen_10:25</u> And unto Eber were born two sons: the name of one *was* Peleg; for in his days was the earth divided; and his brother's name *was* Joktan.
- <u>Gen_10:32</u> These *are* the families of the sons of Noah, after their generations, in their nations: and by these were the nations divided in the earth after the flood.
- <u>Gen_11:1</u> And the whole earth was of one language, and of one speech.
- <u>Gen_11:4</u> And they said, Go to, let us build us a city and a tower, whose top may reach unto heaven; and let us make us a name, lest we be scattered abroad upon the face of the whole earth.

- <u>Gen_11:8</u> So the LORD scattered them abroad from thence upon the face of all the earth: and they left off to build the city.
- <u>Gen_11:9</u> Therefore is the name of it called Babel; because the LORD did there confound the language of all the earth: and from thence did the LORD scatter them abroad upon the face of all the earth.
- <u>Gen_12:3</u> And I will bless them that bless thee, and curse him that curseth thee: and in thee shall all families of the earth be blessed.
- <u>Gen_13:16</u> And I will make thy seed as the dust of the earth: so that if a man can number the dust of the earth, *then* shall thy seed also be numbered.
- <u>Gen_14:19</u> And he blessed him, and said, Blessed *be* Abram of the most high God, possessor of heaven and earth:
- Gen_14:22 And Abram said to the king of Sodom, I have lift up mine hand unto the LORD, the most high God, the possessor of heaven and earth,
- Gen_18:18 Seeing that Abraham shall surely become a great and mighty nation, and all the nations of the earth shall be blessed in him?
- <u>Gen_18:25</u> That be far from thee to do after this manner, to slay the righteous with the wicked: and that the righteous should be as the wicked, that be far from thee: Shall not the Judge of all the earth do right?
- <u>Gen_19:23</u> The sun was risen upon the earth when Lot entered into Zoar.
- <u>Gen_19:31</u> And the firstborn said unto the younger, Our father *is* old, and *there is* not a man in the earth to come in unto us after the manner of all the earth:
- <u>Gen_22:18</u> And in thy seed shall all the nations of the earth be blessed; because thou hast obeyed my voice.
- <u>Gen_24:3</u> And I will make thee swear by the LORD, the God of heaven, and the God of the earth, that thou shalt not take a wife unto my son of the daughters of the Canaanites, among whom I dwell:
- <u>Gen 24:52</u> And it came to pass, that, when Abraham's servant heard their words, he worshipped the LORD, *bowing himself* to the earth.
- <u>Gen_26:4</u> And I will make thy seed to multiply as the stars of heaven, and will give unto thy seed all these countries; and in thy seed shall all the nations of the earth be blessed;
- <u>Gen_26:15</u> For all the wells which his father's servants had digged in the days of Abraham his father, the Philistines had stopped them, and filled them with earth.

- <u>Gen_27:28</u> Therefore God give thee of the dew of heaven, and the fatness of the earth, and plenty of corn and wine:
- <u>Gen_27:39</u> And Isaac his father answered and said unto him, Behold, thy dwelling shall be the fatness of the earth, and of the dew of heaven from above;
- <u>Gen_28:12</u> And he dreamed, and behold a ladder set up on the earth, and the top of it reached to heaven: and behold the angels of God ascending and descending on it.
- <u>Gen_28:14</u> And thy seed shall be as the dust of the earth, and thou shalt spread abroad to the west, and to the east, and to the north, and to the south: and in thee and in thy seed shall all the families of the earth be blessed.
- <u>Gen_37:10</u> And he told *it* to his father, and to his brethren: and his father rebuked him, and said unto him, What *is* this dream that thou hast dreamed? Shall I and thy mother and thy brethren indeed come to bow down ourselves to thee to the earth?
- <u>Gen_41:47</u> And in the seven plenteous years the earth brought forth by handfuls.
- <u>Gen_41:56</u> And the famine was over all the face of the earth: And Joseph opened all the storehouses, and sold unto the Egyptians; and the famine waxed sore in the land of Egypt.
- <u>Gen_42:6</u> And Joseph *was* the governor over the land, *and* he *it was* that sold to all the people of the land: and Joseph's brethren came, and bowed down themselves before him *with* their faces to the earth.
- <u>Gen_43:26</u> And when Joseph came home, they brought him the present which was in their hand into the house, and bowed themselves to him to the earth.
- <u>Gen_45:7</u> And God sent me before you to preserve you a posterity in the earth, and to save your lives by a great deliverance.
- Gen_48:12 And Joseph brought them out from between his knees, and he bowed himself with his face to the earth.
- <u>Gen_48:16</u> The Angel which redeemed me from all evil, bless the lads; and let my name be named on them, and the name of my fathers Abraham and Isaac; and let them grow into a multitude in the midst of the earth.
- Exo_8:17 And they did so; for Aaron stretched out his hand with his rod, and smote the dust of the earth, and it became lice in man, and in beast; all the dust of the land became lice throughout all the land of Egypt.

- Exo_8:22 And I will sever in that day the land of Goshen, in which my people dwell, that no swarms *of flies* shall be there; to the end thou mayest know that I *am* the LORD in the midst of the earth.
- <u>Exo_9:14</u> For I will at this time send all my plagues upon thine heart, and upon thy servants, and upon thy people; that thou mayest know that *there is* none like me in all the earth.
- <u>Exo_9:15</u> For now I will stretch out my hand, that I may smite thee and thy people with pestilence; and thou shalt be cut off from the earth.
- Exo_9:16 And in very deed for this *cause* have I raised thee up, for to shew *in* thee my power; and that my name may be declared throughout all the earth.
- <u>Exo_9:29</u> And Moses said unto him, As soon as I am gone out of the city, I will spread abroad my hands unto the LORD; *and* the thunder shall cease, neither shall there be any more hail; that thou mayest know how that the earth *is* the LORD'S.
- Exo_9:33 And Moses went out of the city from Pharaoh, and spread abroad his hands unto the LORD: and the thunders and hail ceased, and the rain was not poured upon the earth.
- <u>Exo_10:5</u> And they shall cover the face of the earth, that one cannot be able to see the earth: and they shall eat the residue of that which is escaped, which remaineth unto you from the hail, and shall eat every tree which groweth for you out of the field:
- <u>Exo_10:6</u> And they shall fill thy houses, and the houses of all thy servants, and the houses of all the Egyptians; which neither thy fathers, nor thy fathers' fathers have seen, since the day that they were upon the earth unto this day. And he turned himself, and went out from Pharaoh.
- <u>Exo_10:15</u> For they covered the face of the whole earth, so that the land was darkened; and they did eat every herb of the land, and all the fruit of the trees which the hail had left: and there remained not any green thing in the trees, or in the herbs of the field, through all the land of Egypt.
- <u>Exo_15:12</u> Thou stretchedst out thy right hand, the earth swallowed them.
- Exo_19:5 Now therefore, if ye will obey my voice indeed, and keep my covenant, then ye shall be a peculiar treasure unto me above all people: for all the earth *is* mine:
- Exo_20:4 Thou shalt not make unto thee any graven image, or any likeness of any thing that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth:

- $Exo_20:11$ For *in* six days the LORD made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them *is*, and rested the seventh day: wherefore the LORD blessed the sabbath day, and hallowed it.
- <u>Exo_20:24</u> An altar of earth thou shalt make unto me, and shalt sacrifice thereon thy burnt offerings, and thy peace offerings, thy sheep, and thine oxen: in all places where I record my name I will come unto thee, and I will bless thee.
- Exo_31:17 It is a sign between me and the children of Israel for ever: for in six days the LORD made heaven and earth, and on the seventh day he rested, and was refreshed.
- <u>Exo_32:12</u> Wherefore should the Egyptians speak, and say, For mischief did he bring them out, to slay them in the mountains, and to consume them from the face of the earth? Turn from thy fierce wrath, and repent of this evil against thy people.
- <u>Exo_33:16</u> For wherein shall it be known here that I and thy people have found grace in thy sight? *is it* not in that thou goest with us? so shall we be separated, I and thy people, from all the people that *are* upon the face of the earth.
- Exo_34:8 And Moses made haste, and bowed his head toward the earth, and worshipped.
- $Exo_34:10$ And he said, Behold, I make a covenant: before all thy people I will do marvels, such as have not been done in all the earth, nor in any nation: and all the people among which thou art shall see the work of the LORD: for it is a terrible thing that I will do with thee.
- <u>Lev_11:2</u> Speak unto the children of Israel, saying, These *are* the beasts which ye shall eat among all the beasts that *are* on the earth.
- <u>Lev_11:21</u> Yet these may ye eat of every flying creeping thing that goeth upon all four, which have legs above their feet, to leap withal upon the earth;
- <u>Lev 11:29</u> These also *shall be* unclean unto you among the creeping things that creep upon the earth; the weasel, and the mouse, and the tortoise after his kind,
- <u>Lev_11:41</u> And every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth *shall be* an abomination; it shall not be eaten.
- <u>Lev_11:42</u> Whatsoever goeth upon the belly, and whatsoever goeth upon *all* four, or whatsoever hath more feet among all creeping things that creep upon the earth, them ye shall not eat; for they *are* an abomination.

<u>Lev_11:44</u> For I *am* the LORD your God: ye shall therefore sanctify yourselves, and ye shall be holy; for I *am* holy: neither shall ye defile yourselves with any manner of creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth.

Lev 11:46 This

- is the law of the beasts, and of the fowl, and of every living creature that moveth in the waters, and of every creature that creepeth upon the earth:
- <u>Lev_15:12</u> And the vessel of earth, that he toucheth which hath the issue, shall be broken: and every vessel of wood shall be rinsed in water.
- <u>Lev_26:19</u> And I will break the pride of your power; and I will make your heaven as iron, and your earth as brass:
- <u>Num_11:31</u> And there went forth a wind from the LORD, and brought quails from the sea, and let *them* fall by the camp, as it were a day's journey on this side, and as it were a day's journey on the other side, round about the camp, and as it were two cubits *high* upon the face of the earth.
- Num_12:3 (Now the man Moses *was* very meek, above all the men which *were* upon the face of the earth.)
- Num_14:21 But as truly as I live, all the earth shall be filled with the glory of the LORD.
- Num_16:30 But if the LORD make a new thing, and the earth open her mouth, and swallow them up, with all that *appertain* unto them, and they go down quick into the pit; then ye shall understand that these men have provoked the LORD.
- Num_16:32 And the earth opened her mouth, and swallowed them up, and their houses, and all the men that *appertained* unto Korah, and all *their* goods.
- Num_16:33 They, and all that *appertained* to them, went down alive into the pit, and the earth closed upon them: and they perished from among the congregation.
- Num_16:34 And all Israel that were round about them fled at the cry of them: for they said, Lest the earth swallow us up also.
- Num 22:5 He sent messengers therefore unto Balaam the son of Beor to Pethor, which *is* by the river of the land of the children of his people, to call him, saying, Behold, there is a people come out from Egypt: behold, they cover the face of the earth, and they abide over against me:
- Num_22:11 Behold, there is a people come out of Egypt, which covereth the face of the earth: come now, curse me them; peradventure I shall be able to

- overcome them, and drive them out.
- Num 26:10 And the earth opened her mouth, and swallowed them up together with Korah, when that company died, what time the fire devoured two hundred and fifty men: and they became a sign.
- <u>Deu_3:24</u> O Lord GOD, thou hast begun to shew thy servant thy greatness, and thy mighty hand: for what God *is there* in heaven or in earth, that can do according to thy works, and according to thy might?
- <u>Deu_4:10</u> Specially the day that thou stoodest before the LORD thy God in Horeb, when the LORD said unto me, Gather me the people together, and I will make them hear my words, that they may learn to fear me all the days that they shall live upon the earth, and *that* they may teach their children.
- <u>Deu_4:17</u> The likeness of any beast that *is* on the earth, the likeness of any winged fowl that flieth in the air,
- <u>Deu_4:18</u> The likeness of any thing that creepeth on the ground, the likeness of any fish that *is* in the waters beneath the earth:
- <u>Deu_4:26</u> I call heaven and earth to witness against you this day, that ye shall soon utterly perish from off the land whereunto ye go over Jordan to possess it; ye shall not prolong *your* days upon it, but shall utterly be destroyed.
- <u>Deu_4:32</u> For ask now of the days that are past, which were before thee, since the day that God created man upon the earth, and *ask* from the one side of heaven unto the other, whether there hath been *any such thing* as this great thing *is*, or hath been heard like it?
- <u>Deu_4:36</u> Out of heaven he made thee to hear his voice, that he might instruct thee: and upon earth he shewed thee his great fire; and thou heardest his words out of the midst of the fire.
- <u>Deu_4:39</u> Know therefore this day, and consider *it* in thine heart, that the LORD he *is* God in heaven above, and upon the earth beneath: *there is* none else.
- <u>Deu_4:40</u> Thou shalt keep therefore his statutes, and his commandments, which I command thee this day, that it may go well with thee, and with thy children after thee, and that thou mayest prolong *thy* days upon the earth, which the LORD thy God giveth thee, for ever.
- <u>Deu_5:8</u> Thou shalt not make thee *any* graven image, *or* any likeness *of any* thing that *is* in heaven above, or that *is* in the earth beneath, or that *is* in the waters beneath the earth:
- <u>Deu_6:15</u> (For the LORD thy God *is* a jealous God among you) lest the anger

- of the LORD thy God be kindled against thee, and destroy thee from off the face of the earth.
- <u>Deu_7:6</u> For thou *art* an holy people unto the LORD thy God: the LORD thy God hath chosen thee to be a special people unto himself, above all people that *are* upon the face of the earth.
- <u>Deu_10:14</u> Behold, the heaven and the heaven of heavens *is* the LORD'S thy God, the earth *also*, with all that therein *is*.
- <u>Deu_11:6</u> And what he did unto Dathan and Abiram, the sons of Eliab, the son of Reuben: how the earth opened her mouth, and swallowed them up, and their households, and their tents, and all the substance that *was* in their possession, in the midst of all Israel:
- <u>Deu_11:21</u> That your days may be multiplied, and the days of your children, in the land which the LORD sware unto your fathers to give them, as the days of heaven upon the earth.
- <u>Deu_12:1</u> These *are* the statutes and judgments, which ye shall observe to do in the land, which the LORD God of thy fathers giveth thee to possess it, all the days that ye live upon the earth.
- <u>Deu_12:16</u> Only ye shall not eat the blood; ye shall pour it upon the earth as water.
- <u>Deu_12:19</u> Take heed to thyself that thou forsake not the Levite as long as thou livest upon the earth.
- <u>Deu_12:24</u> Thou shalt not eat it; thou shalt pour it upon the earth as water.
- <u>Deu_13:7</u> Namely, of the gods of the people which are round about you, nigh unto thee, or far off from thee, from the *one* end of the earth even unto the *other* end of the earth;
- <u>Deu_14:2</u> For thou *art* an holy people unto the LORD thy God, and the LORD hath chosen thee to be a peculiar people unto himself, above all the nations that *are* upon the earth.
- <u>Deu_26:2</u> That thou shalt take of the first of all the fruit of the earth, which thou shalt bring of thy land that the LORD thy God giveth thee, and shalt put *it* in a basket, and shalt go unto the place which the LORD thy God shall choose to place his name there.
- <u>Deu_28:1</u> And it shall come to pass, if thou shalt hearken diligently unto the voice of the LORD thy God, to observe *and* to do all his commandments which I command thee this day, that the LORD thy God will set thee on high above all nations of the earth:

- <u>Deu_28:10</u> And all people of the earth shall see that thou art called by the name of the LORD; and they shall be afraid of thee.
- <u>Deu_28:23</u> And thy heaven that *is* over thy head shall be brass, and the earth that is under thee *shall be* iron.
- <u>Deu_28:25</u> The LORD shall cause thee to be smitten before thine enemies: thou shalt go out one way against them, and flee seven ways before them: and shalt be removed into all the kingdoms of the earth.
- <u>Deu_28:26</u> And thy carcase shall be meat unto all fowls of the air, and unto the beasts of the earth, and no man shall fray *them* away.
- <u>Deu_28:49</u> The LORD shall bring a nation against thee from far, from the end of the earth, *as swift* as the eagle flieth; a nation whose tongue thou shalt not understand;
- <u>Deu_28:64</u> And the LORD shall scatter thee among all people, from the one end of the earth even unto the other; and there thou shalt serve other gods, which neither thou nor thy fathers have known, *even* wood and stone.
- <u>Deu_30:19</u> I call heaven and earth to record this day against you, *that* I have set before you life and death, blessing and cursing: therefore choose life, that both thou and thy seed may live:
- <u>Deu 31:28</u> Gather unto me all the elders of your tribes, and your officers, that I may speak these words in their ears, and call heaven and earth to record against them.
- <u>Deu_32:1</u> Give ear, O ye heavens, and I will speak; and hear, O earth, the words of my mouth.
- <u>Deu_32:13</u> He made him ride on the high places of the earth, that he might eat the increase of the fields; and he made him to suck honey out of the rock, and oil out of the flinty rock;
- <u>Deu_32:22</u> For a fire is kindled in mine anger, and shall burn unto the lowest hell, and shall consume the earth with her increase, and set on fire the foundations of the mountains.
- <u>Deu_33:16</u> And for the precious things of the earth and fulness thereof, and *for* the good will of him that dwelt in the bush: let *the blessing* come upon the head of Joseph, and upon the top of the head of him *that was* separated from his brethren.
- <u>Deu_33:17</u> His glory *is like* the firstling of his bullock, and his horns *are like* the horns of unicorns: with them he shall push the people together to the ends of the earth: and they *are* the ten thousands of Ephraim, and they *are* the

thousands of Manasseh.

- Jos 2:11 And as soon as we had heard *these things*, our hearts did melt, neither did there remain any more courage in any man, because of you: for the LORD your God, he *is* God in heaven above, and in earth beneath.
- <u>Jos_3:11</u> Behold, the ark of the covenant of the Lord of all the earth passeth over before you into Jordan.
- <u>Jos_3:13</u> And it shall come to pass, as soon as the soles of the feet of the priests that bear the ark of the LORD, the Lord of all the earth, shall rest in the waters of Jordan, *that* the waters of Jordan shall be cut off *from* the waters that come down from above; and they shall stand upon an heap.
- <u>Jos 4:24</u> That all the people of the earth might know the hand of the LORD, that it *is* mighty: that ye might fear the LORD your God for ever.
- <u>Jos_5:14</u> And he said, Nay; but *as* captain of the host of the LORD am I now come. And Joshua fell on his face to the earth, and did worship, and said unto him, What saith my lord unto his servant?
- <u>Jos_7:6</u> And Joshua rent his clothes, and fell to the earth upon his face before the ark of the LORD until the eventide, he and the elders of Israel, and put dust upon their heads.
- <u>Jos_7:9</u> For the Canaanites and all the inhabitants of the land shall hear
- of it, and shall environ us round, and cut off our name from the earth: and what wilt thou do unto thy great name?
- <u>Jos_7:21</u> When I saw among the spoils a goodly Babylonish garment, and two hundred shekels of silver, and a wedge of gold of fifty shekels weight, then I coveted them, and took them; and, behold, they *are* hid in the earth in the midst of my tent, and the silver under it.
- Jos_23:14 And, behold, this day I am going the way of all the earth: and ye know in all your hearts and in all your souls, that not one thing hath failed of all the good things which the LORD your God spake concerning you; all are come to pass unto you, and not one thing hath failed thereof.
- <u>Jdg_3:25</u> And they tarried till they were ashamed: and, behold, he opened not the doors of the parlour; therefore they took a key, and opened *them:* and, behold, their lord *was* fallen down dead on the earth.
- <u>Jdg_5:4</u> LORD, when thou wentest out of Seir, when thou marchedst out of the field of Edom, the earth trembled, and the heavens dropped, the clouds also dropped water.

- <u>Jdg 6:4</u> And they encamped against them, and destroyed the increase of the earth, till thou come unto Gaza, and left no sustenance for Israel, neither sheep, nor ox, nor ass.
- <u>Jdg_6:37</u> Behold, I will put a fleece of wool in the floor; and if the dew be on the fleece only, and it be dry upon all the earth beside, then shall I know that thou wilt save Israel by mine hand, as thou hast said.
- <u>Jdg_18:10</u> When ye go, ye shall come unto a people secure, and to a large land: for God hath given it into your hands; a place where *there is* no want of any thing that *is* in the earth.
- <u>1Sa_2:8</u> He raiseth up the poor out of the dust, *and* lifteth up the beggar from the dunghill, to set *them* among princes, and to make them inherit the throne of glory: for the pillars of the earth *are* the LORD'S, and he hath set the world upon them.
- <u>1Sa_2:10</u> The adversaries of the LORD shall be broken to pieces; out of heaven shall he thunder upon them: the LORD shall judge the ends of the earth; and he shall give strength unto his king, and exalt the horn of his anointed.
- <u>1Sa_4:5</u> And when the ark of the covenant of the LORD came into the camp, all Israel shouted with a great shout, so that the earth rang again.
- 1Sa_4:12 And there ran a man of Benjamin out of the army, and came to Shiloh the same day with his clothes rent, and with earth upon his head.
- <u>1Sa_5:3</u> And when they of Ashdod arose early on the morrow, behold, Dagon was fallen upon his face to the earth before the ark of the LORD. And they took Dagon, and set him in his place again.
- <u>1Sa_14:15</u> And there was trembling in the host, in the field, and among all the people: the garrison, and the spoilers, they also trembled, and the earth quaked: so it was a very great trembling.
- <u>1Sa_17:46</u> This day will the LORD deliver thee into mine hand; and I will smite thee, and take thine head from thee; and I will give the carcases of the host of the Philistines this day unto the fowls of the air, and to the wild beasts of the earth; that all the earth may know that there is a God in Israel.
- <u>1Sa_17:49</u> And David put his hand in his bag, and took thence a stone, and slang *it*, and smote the Philistine in his forehead, that the stone sunk into his forehead; and he fell upon his face to the earth.
- <u>1Sa_20:15</u> But *also* thou shalt not cut off thy kindness from my house for ever: no, not when the LORD hath cut off the enemies of David every one from the face of the earth.

- <u>1Sa_24:8</u> David also arose afterward, and went out of the cave, and cried after Saul, saying, My lord the king. And when Saul looked behind him, David stooped with his face to the earth, and bowed himself.
- <u>1Sa_25:41</u> And she arose, and bowed herself on *her* face to the earth, and said, Behold, *let* thine handmaid *be* a servant to wash the feet of the servants of my lord.
- <u>1Sa_26:8</u> Then said Abishai to David, God hath delivered thine enemy into thine hand this day: now therefore let me smite him, I pray thee, with the spear even to the earth at once, and I will not *smite* him the second time.
- <u>1Sa_26:20</u> Now therefore, let not my blood fall to the earth before the face of the LORD: for the king of Israel is come out to seek a flea, as when one doth hunt a partridge in the mountains.
- <u>1Sa 28:13</u> And the king said unto her, Be not afraid: for what sawest thou? And the woman said unto Saul, I saw gods ascending out of the earth.
- <u>1Sa_28:20</u> Then Saul fell straightway all along on the earth, and was sore afraid, because of the words of Samuel: and there was no strength in him; for he had eaten no bread all the day, nor all the night.
- <u>1Sa_28:23</u> But he refused, and said, I will not eat. But his servants, together with the woman, compelled him; and he hearkened unto their voice. So he arose from the earth, and sat upon the bed.
- <u>1Sa_30:16</u> And when he had brought him down, behold, *they were* spread abroad upon all the earth, eating and drinking, and dancing, because of all the great spoil that they had taken out of the land of the Philistines, and out of the land of Judah.
- <u>2Sa_1:2</u> It came even to pass on the third day, that, behold, a man came out of the camp from Saul with his clothes rent, and earth upon his head: and *so* it was, when he came to David, that he fell to the earth, and did obeisance.
- <u>2Sa_4:11</u> How much more, when wicked men have slain a righteous person in his own house upon his bed? shall I not therefore now require his blood of your hand, and take you away from the earth?
- <u>2Sa_7:9</u> And I was with thee whithersoever thou wentest, and have cut off all thine enemies out of thy sight, and have made thee a great name, like unto the name of the great *men* that *are* in the earth.
- <u>2Sa_7:23</u> And what one nation in the earth *is* like thy people, *even* like Israel, whom God went to redeem for a people to himself, and to make him a name, and to do for you great things and terrible, for thy land, before thy people, which thou redeemedst to thee from Egypt, *from* the nations and their gods?

- <u>2Sa 12:16</u> David therefore besought God for the child; and David fasted, and went in, and lay all night upon the earth.
- <u>2Sa_12:17</u> And the elders of his house arose, *and went* to him, to raise him up from the earth: but he would not, neither did he eat bread with them.
- <u>2Sa_12:20</u> Then David arose from the earth, and washed, and anointed *himself*, and changed his apparel, and came into the house of the LORD, and worshipped: then he came to his own house; and when he required, they set bread before him, and he did eat.
- <u>2Sa</u> <u>13:31</u> Then the king arose, and tare his garments, and lay on the earth; and all his servants stood by with their clothes rent.
- <u>2Sa_14:7</u> And, behold, the whole family is risen against thine handmaid, and they said, Deliver him that smote his brother, that we may kill him, for the life of his brother whom he slew; and we will destroy the heir also: and so they shall quench my coal which is left, and shall not leave to my husband *neither* name nor remainder upon the earth.
- <u>2Sa_14:11</u> Then said she, I pray thee, let the king remember the LORD thy God, that thou wouldest not suffer the revengers of blood to destroy any more, lest they destroy my son. And he said, *As* the LORD liveth, there shall not one hair of thy son fall to the earth.
- <u>2Sa</u> <u>14:20</u> To fetch about this form of speech hath thy servant Joab done this thing: and my lord *is* wise, according to the wisdom of an angel of God, to know all *things* that *are* in the earth.
- <u>2Sa_15:32</u> And it came to pass, that *when* David was come to the top *of the mount,* where he worshipped God, behold, Hushai the Archite came to meet him with his coat rent, and earth upon his head:
- <u>2Sa_18:9</u> And Absalom met the servants of David. And Absalom rode upon a mule, and the mule went under the thick boughs of a great oak, and his head caught hold of the oak, and he was taken up between the heaven and the earth; and the mule that *was* under him went away.
- <u>2Sa_18:28</u> And Ahimaaz called, and said unto the king, All is well. And he fell down to the earth upon his face before the king, and said, Blessed *be* the LORD thy God, which hath delivered up the men that lifted up their hand against my lord the king.
- <u>2Sa_22:8</u> Then the earth shook and trembled; the foundations of heaven moved and shook, because he was wroth.
- <u>2Sa_22:43</u> Then did I beat them as small as the dust of the earth, I did stamp them as the mire of the street, *and* did spread them abroad.

- <u>2Sa_23:4</u> And *he shall be* as the light of the morning, *when* the sun riseth, *even* a morning without clouds; *as* the tender grass *springing* out of the earth by clear shining after rain.
- <u>1Ki_1:31</u> Then Bathsheba bowed with *her* face to the earth, and did reverence to the king, and said, Let my lord king David live for ever.
- <u>1Ki_1:40</u> And all the people came up after him, and the people piped with pipes, and rejoiced with great joy, so that the earth rent with the sound of them.
- <u>1Ki 1:52</u> And Solomon said, If he will shew himself a worthy man, there shall not an hair of him fall to the earth: but if wickedness shall be found in him, he shall die.
- <u>1Ki_2:2</u> I go the way of all the earth: be thou strong therefore, and shew thyself a man;
- <u>1Ki_4:34</u> And there came of all people to hear the wisdom of Solomon, from all kings of the earth, which had heard of his wisdom.
- <u>1Ki_8:23</u> And he said, LORD God of Israel, *there is* no God like thee, in heaven above, or on earth beneath, who keepest covenant and mercy with thy servants that walk before thee with all their heart:
- <u>1Ki_8:27</u> But will God indeed dwell on the earth? behold, the heaven and heaven of heavens cannot contain thee; how much less this house that I have builded?
- <u>1Ki_8:43</u> Hear thou in heaven thy dwelling place, and do according to all that the stranger calleth to thee for: that all people of the earth may know thy name, to fear thee, as *do* thy people Israel; and that they may know that this house, which I have builded, is called by thy name.
- 1Ki_8:53 For thou didst separate them from among all the people of the
- earth, to be thine inheritance, as thou spakest by the hand of Moses thy servant, when thou broughtest our fathers out of Egypt, O Lord GOD.
- <u>1Ki_8:60</u> That all the people of the earth may know that the LORD *is* God, *and* that there *is* none else.
- 1Ki_10:23 So king Solomon exceeded all the kings of the earth for riches and for wisdom.
- $1Ki_10:24$ And all the earth sought to Solomon, to hear his wisdom, which God had put in his heart.
- 1Ki_13:34 And this thing became sin unto the house of Jeroboam, even to cut

- it off, and to destroy it from off the face of the earth.
- <u>1Ki_17:14</u> For thus saith the LORD God of Israel, The barrel of meal shall not waste, neither shall the cruse of oil fail, until the day *that* the LORD sendeth rain upon the earth.
- <u>1Ki_18:1</u> And it came to pass *after* many days, that the word of the LORD came to Elijah in the third year, saying, Go, shew thyself unto Ahab; and I will send rain upon the earth.
- <u>1Ki_18:42</u> So Ahab went up to eat and to drink. And Elijah went up to the top of Carmel; and he cast himself down upon the earth, and put his face between his knees,
- <u>2Ki_5:15</u> And he returned to the man of God, he and all his company, and came, and stood before him: and he said, Behold, now I know that *there is* no God in all the earth, but in Israel: now therefore, I pray thee, take a blessing of thy servant.
- <u>2Ki_5:17</u> And Naaman said, Shall there not then, I pray thee, be given to thy servant two mules' burden of earth? for thy servant will henceforth offer neither burnt offering nor sacrifice unto other gods, but unto the LORD.
- <u>2Ki_10:10</u> Know now that there shall fall unto the earth nothing of the word of the LORD, which the LORD spake concerning the house of Ahab: for the LORD hath done *that* which he spake by his servant Elijah.
- <u>2Ki_19:15</u> And Hezekiah prayed before the LORD, and said, O LORD God of Israel, which dwellest *between* the cherubims, thou art the God, *even* thou alone, of all the kingdoms of the earth; thou hast made heaven and earth.
- <u>2Ki_19:19</u> Now therefore, O LORD our God, I beseech thee, save thou us out of his hand, that all the kingdoms of the earth may know that thou *art* the LORD God, *even* thou only.
- 1Ch_1:10 And Cush begat Nimrod: he began to be mighty upon the earth.
- <u>1Ch</u> <u>1:19</u> And unto Eber were born two sons: the name of the one *was* Peleg; because in his days the earth was divided: and his brother's name *was* Joktan.
- 1Ch_16:14 He is the LORD our God; his judgments are in all the earth.
- 1Ch_16:23 Sing unto the LORD, all the earth; shew forth from day to day his salvation.
- 1Ch_16:30 Fear before him, all the earth: the world also shall be stable, that it be not moved.
- <u>1Ch_16:31</u> Let the heavens be glad, and let the earth rejoice: and let *men* say

- among the nations, The LORD reigneth.
- <u>1Ch_16:33</u> Then shall the trees of the wood sing out at the presence of the LORD, because he cometh to judge the earth.
- <u>1Ch_17:8</u> And I have been with thee whithersoever thou hast walked, and have cut off all thine enemies from before thee, and have made thee a name like the name of the great men that *are* in the earth.
- <u>1Ch_17:21</u> And what one nation in the earth *is* like thy people Israel, whom God went to redeem *to be* his own people, to make thee a name of greatness and terribleness, by driving out nations from before thy people, whom thou hast redeemed out of Egypt?
- <u>1Ch_21:16</u> And David lifted up his eyes, and saw the angel of the LORD stand between the earth and the heaven, having a drawn sword in his hand stretched out over Jerusalem. Then David and the elders *of Israel, who were* clothed in sackcloth, fell upon their faces.
- <u>1Ch_22:8</u> But the word of the LORD came to me, saying, Thou hast shed blood abundantly, and hast made great wars: thou shalt not build an house unto my name, because thou hast shed much blood upon the earth in my sight.
- <u>1Ch_29:11</u> Thine, O LORD, *is* the greatness, and the power, and the glory, and the victory, and the majesty: for all *that is* in the heaven and in the earth *is thine;* thine *is* the kingdom, O LORD, and thou art exalted as head above all.
- <u>1Ch 29:15</u> For we *are* strangers before thee, and sojourners, as *were* all our fathers: our days on the earth *are* as a shadow, and *there is* none abiding.
- <u>2Ch_1:9</u> Now, O LORD God, let thy promise unto David my father be established: for thou hast made me king over a people like the dust of the earth in multitude.
- <u>2Ch_2:12</u> Huram said moreover, Blessed *be* the LORD God of Israel, that made heaven and earth, who hath given to David the king a wise son, endued with prudence and understanding, that might build an house for the LORD, and an house for his kingdom.
- <u>2Ch_6:14</u> And said, O LORD God of Israel, *there is* no God like thee in the heaven, nor in the earth; which keepest covenant, and *shewest* mercy unto thy servants, that walk before thee with all their hearts:
- <u>2Ch_6:18</u> But will God in very deed dwell with men on the earth? behold, heaven and the heaven of heavens cannot contain thee; how much less this house which I have built!
- <u>2Ch_6:33</u> Then hear thou from the heavens, even from thy dwelling place,

- and do according to all that the stranger calleth to thee for; that all people of the earth may know thy name, and fear thee, as *doth* thy people Israel, and may know that this house which I have built is called by thy name.
- 2Ch_9:22 And king Solomon passed all the kings of the earth in riches and wisdom.
- 2Ch_9:23 And all the kings of the earth sought the presence of Solomon, to hear his wisdom, that God had put in his heart.
- <u>2Ch_16:9</u> For the eyes of the LORD run to and fro throughout the whole earth, to shew himself strong in the behalf of *them* whose heart *is* perfect toward him. Herein thou hast done foolishly: therefore from henceforth thou shalt have wars.
- <u>2Ch_20:24</u> And when Judah came toward the watch tower in the wilderness, they looked unto the multitude, and, behold, they *were* dead bodies fallen to the earth, and none escaped.
- <u>2Ch_32:19</u> And they spake against the God of Jerusalem, as against the gods of the people of the earth, *which were* the work of the hands of man.
- <u>2Ch_36:23</u> Thus saith Cyrus king of Persia, All the kingdoms of the earth hath the LORD God of heaven given me; and he hath charged me to build him an house in Jerusalem, which *is* in Judah. Who *is there* among you of all his people? The LORD his God *be* with him, and let him go up.
- <u>Ezr_1:2</u> Thus saith Cyrus king of Persia, The LORD God of heaven hath given me all the kingdoms of the earth; and he hath charged me to build him an house at Jerusalem, which *is* in Judah.
- <u>Ezr_5:11</u> And thus they returned us answer, saying, We are the servants of the God of heaven and earth, and build the house that was builded these many years ago, which a great king of Israel builded and set up.
- Neh_9:1 Now in the twenty and fourth day of this month the children of Israel were assembled with fasting, and with sackclothes, and earth upon them.
- <u>Neh_9:6</u> Thou, *even* thou, *art* LORD alone; thou hast made heaven, the heaven of heavens, with all their host, the earth, and all *things* that *are* therein, the seas, and all that *is* therein, and thou preservest them all; and the host of heaven worshippeth thee.
- <u>Job_1:7</u> And the LORD said unto Satan, Whence comest thou? Then Satan answered the LORD, and said, From going to and fro in the earth, and from walking up and down in it.
- <u>Job_1:8</u> And the LORD said unto Satan, Hast thou considered my servant Job,

- that *there is* none like him in the earth, a perfect and an upright man, one that feareth God, and escheweth evil?
- <u>Job_2:2</u> And the LORD said unto Satan, From whence comest thou? And Satan answered the LORD, and said, From going to and fro in the earth, and from walking up and down in it.
- <u>Job_2:3</u> And the LORD said unto Satan, Hast thou considered my servant Job, that *there is* none like him in the earth, a perfect and an upright man, one that feareth God, and escheweth evil? and still he holdeth fast his integrity, although thou movedst me against him, to destroy him without cause.
- <u>Job_3:14</u> With kings and counsellors of the earth, which built desolate places for themselves;
- Job 5:10 Who giveth rain upon the earth, and sendeth waters upon the fields:
- <u>Job_5:22</u> At destruction and famine thou shalt laugh: neither shalt thou be afraid of the beasts of the earth.
- <u>Job_5:25</u> Thou shalt know also that thy seed *shall be* great, and thine offspring as the grass of the earth.
- <u>Job_7:1</u> *Is there* not an appointed time to man upon earth? *are not* his days also like the days of an hireling?
- <u>Job_8:9</u> (For we *are but of* yesterday, and know nothing, because our days upon earth *are* a shadow:)
- $\underline{\text{Job}}$ 8:19 Behold, this *is* the joy of his way, and out of the earth shall others grow.
- <u>Job_9:6</u> Which shaketh the earth out of her place, and the pillars thereof tremble.
- <u>Job_9:24</u> The earth is given into the hand of the wicked: he covereth the faces of the judges thereof; if not, where, *and* who *is* he?
- <u>Job_11:9</u> The measure thereof *is* longer than the earth, and broader than the sea.
- <u>Job_12:8</u> Or speak to the earth, and it shall teach thee: and the fishes of the sea shall declare unto thee.
- <u>Job_12:15</u> Behold, he withholdeth the waters, and they dry up: also he sendeth them out, and they overturn the earth.
- <u>Job_12:24</u> He taketh away the heart of the chief of the people of the earth, and causeth them to wander in a wilderness *where there is* no way.

- <u>Job_14:8</u> Though the root thereof wax old in the earth, and the stock thereof die in the ground;
- <u>Job_14:19</u> The waters wear the stones: thou washest away the things which grow *out* of the dust of the earth; and thou destroyest the hope of man.
- <u>Job_15:19</u> Unto whom alone the earth was given, and no stranger passed among them.
- <u>Job_15:29</u> He shall not be rich, neither shall his substance continue, neither shall he prolong the perfection thereof upon the earth.
- <u>Job_16:18</u> O earth, cover not thou my blood, and let my cry have no place.
- <u>Job_18:4</u> He teareth himself in his anger: shall the earth be forsaken for thee? and shall the rock be removed out of his place?
- <u>Job_18:17</u> His remembrance shall perish from the earth, and he shall have no name in the street.
- <u>Job_19:25</u> For I know that my redeemer liveth, and that he shall stand at the latter day upon the earth:
- <u>Job_20:4</u> Knowest thou *not* this of old, since man was placed upon earth,
- <u>Job_20:27</u> The heaven shall reveal his iniquity; and the earth shall rise up against him.
- <u>Job_22:8</u> But *as for* the mighty man, he had the earth; and the honourable man dwelt in it.
- <u>Job_24:4</u> They turn the needy out of the way: the poor of the earth hide themselves together.
- $<u>Job_24:18</u>$ He *is* swift as the waters; their portion is cursed in the earth: he beholdeth not the way of the vineyards.
- <u>Job_26:7</u> He stretcheth out the north over the empty place, *and* hangeth the earth upon nothing.
- <u>Job_28:2</u> Iron is taken out of the earth, and brass *is* molten *out of* the stone.
- <u>Job_28:5</u> As for the earth, out of it cometh bread: and under it is turned up as it were fire.
- <u>Job_28:24</u> For he looketh to the ends of the earth, *and* seeth under the whole heaven;
- <u>Job_30:6</u> To dwell in the clifts of the valleys, *in* caves of the earth, and *in* the

rocks.

- <u>Job_30:8</u> They were children of fools, yea, children of base men: they were viler than the earth.
- <u>Job_34:13</u> Who hath given him a charge over the earth? or who hath disposed the whole world?
- <u>Job_35:11</u> Who teacheth us more than the beasts of the earth, and maketh us wiser than the fowls of heaven?
- <u>Job_37:3</u> He directeth it under the whole heaven, and his lightning unto the ends of the earth.
- <u>Job_37:6</u> For he saith to the snow, Be thou *on* the earth; likewise to the small rain, and to the great rain of his strength.
- <u>Job_37:12</u> And it is turned round about by his counsels: that they may do whatsoever he commandeth them upon the face of the world in the earth.
- <u>Job_37:17</u> How thy garments *are* warm, when he quieteth the earth by the south *wind?*
- <u>Job_38:4</u> Where wast thou when I laid the foundations of the earth? declare, if thou hast understanding.
- <u>Job_38:13</u> That it might take hold of the ends of the earth, that the wicked might be shaken out of it?
- <u>Job_38:18</u> Hast thou perceived the breadth of the earth? declare if thou knowest it all.
- <u>Job_38:24</u> By what way is the light parted, *which* scattereth the east wind upon the earth?
- <u>Job_38:26</u> To cause it to rain on the earth, *where* no man *is; on* the wilderness, wherein *there is* no man;
- <u>Job_38:33</u> Knowest thou the ordinances of heaven? canst thou set the dominion thereof in the earth?
- Job_39:14 Which leaveth her eggs in the earth, and warmeth them in dust,
- <u>Job_41:33</u> Upon earth there is not his like, who is made without fear.
- <u>Psa_2:2</u> The kings of the earth set themselves, and the rulers take counsel together, against the LORD, and against his anointed, *saying*,
- Psa_2:8 Ask of me, and I shall give thee the heathen for thine inheritance, and

- the uttermost parts of the earth for thy possession.
- <u>Psa_2:10</u> Be wise now therefore, O ye kings: be instructed, ye judges of the earth.
- <u>Psa_7:5</u> Let the enemy persecute my soul, and take *it;* yea, let him tread down my life upon the earth, and lay mine honour in the dust. Selah.
- <u>Psa_8:1</u> **To the chief Musician upon Gittith, A Psalm of David.** O LORD our Lord, how excellent *is* thy name in all the earth! who hast set thy glory above the heavens.
- Psa_8:9 O LORD our Lord, how excellent is thy name in all the earth!
- <u>Psa_10:18</u> To judge the fatherless and the oppressed, that the man of the earth may no more oppress.
- <u>Psa_12:6</u> The words of the LORD *are* pure words: *as* silver tried in a furnace of earth, purified seven times.
- <u>Psa_16:3</u> But to the saints that are in the earth, and to the excellent, in whom is all my delight.
- <u>Psa_17:11</u> They have now compassed us in our steps: they have set their eyes bowing down to the earth;
- <u>Psa_18:7</u> Then the earth shook and trembled; the foundations also of the hills moved and were shaken, because he was wroth.
- <u>Psa_19:4</u> Their line is gone out through all the earth, and their words to the end of the world. In them hath he set a tabernacle for the sun,
- <u>Psa_21:10</u> Their fruit shalt thou destroy from the earth, and their seed from among the children of men.
- <u>Psa_22:29</u> All they that be fat upon earth shall eat and worship: all they that go down to the dust shall bow before him: and none can keep alive his own soul.
- <u>Psa_24:1</u> **A Psalm of David.** The earth *is* the LORD'S, and the fulness thereof; the world, and they that dwell therein.
- Psa_25:13 His soul shall dwell at ease; and his seed shall inherit the earth.
- <u>Psa_33:5</u> He loveth righteousness and judgment: the earth is full of the goodness of the LORD.
- <u>Psa_33:8</u> Let all the earth fear the LORD: let all the inhabitants of the world stand in awe of him.

- <u>Psa_33:14</u> From the place of his habitation he looketh upon all the inhabitants of the earth.
- <u>Psa_34:16</u> The face of the LORD *is* against them that do evil, to cut off the remembrance of them from the earth.
- <u>Psa_37:9</u> For evildoers shall be cut off: but those that wait upon the LORD, they shall inherit the earth.
- <u>Psa_37:11</u> But the meek shall inherit the earth; and shall delight themselves in the abundance of peace.
- <u>Psa_37:22</u> For such as be blessed of him shall inherit the earth; and they that be cursed of him shall be cut off.
- <u>Psa_41:2</u> The LORD will preserve him, and keep him alive; *and* he shall be blessed upon the earth: and thou wilt not deliver him unto the will of his enemies.
- <u>Psa_44:25</u> For our soul is bowed down to the dust: our belly cleaveth unto the earth.
- <u>Psa_45:16</u> Instead of thy fathers shall be thy children, whom thou mayest make princes in all the earth.
- <u>Psa_46:2</u> Therefore will not we fear, though the earth be removed, and though the mountains be carried into the midst of the sea;
- <u>Psa_46:6</u> The heathen raged, the kingdoms were moved: he uttered his voice, the earth melted.
- <u>Psa_46:8</u> Come, behold the works of the LORD, what desolations he hath made in the earth.
- <u>Psa_46:9</u> He maketh wars to cease unto the end of the earth; he breaketh the bow, and cutteth the spear in sunder; he burneth the chariot in the fire.
- <u>Psa_46:10</u> Be still, and know that I *am* God: I will be exalted among the heathen, I will be exalted in the earth.
- <u>Psa_47:2</u> For the LORD most high *is* terrible; *he is* a great King over all the earth.
- <u>Psa_47:7</u> For God *is* the King of all the earth: sing ye praises with understanding.
- <u>Psa_47:9</u> The princes of the people are gathered together, *even* the people of the God of Abraham: for the shields of the earth *belong* unto God: he is greatly exalted.

- <u>Psa_48:2</u> Beautiful for situation, the joy of the whole earth, *is* mount Zion, *on* the sides of the north, the city of the great King.
- <u>Psa_48:10</u> According to thy name, O God, so *is* thy praise unto the ends of the earth: thy right hand is full of righteousness.
- <u>Psa_50:1</u> **A Psalm of Asaph.** The mighty God, *even* the LORD, hath spoken, and called the earth from the rising of the sun unto the going down thereof.
- <u>Psa_50:4</u> He shall call to the heavens from above, and to the earth, that he may judge his people.
- <u>Psa_57:5</u> Be thou exalted, O God, above the heavens; *let* thy glory *be* above all the earth.
- <u>Psa_57:11</u> Be thou exalted, O God, above the heavens: *let* thy glory *be* above all the earth.
- <u>Psa_58:2</u> Yea, in heart ye work wickedness; ye weigh the violence of your hands in the earth.
- <u>Psa_58:11</u> So that a man shall say, Verily *there is* a reward for the righteous: verily he is a God that judgeth in the earth.
- <u>Psa_59:13</u> Consume *them* in wrath, consume *them*, that they *may* not *be:* and let them know that God ruleth in Jacob unto the ends of the earth. Selah.
- <u>Psa_60:2</u> Thou hast made the earth to tremble; thou hast broken it: heal the breaches thereof; for it shaketh.
- <u>Psa_61:2</u> From the end of the earth will I cry unto thee, when my heart is overwhelmed: lead me to the rock *that* is higher than I.
- <u>Psa_63:9</u> But those *that* seek my soul, to destroy *it,* shall go into the lower parts of the earth.
- <u>Psa_65:5</u> By terrible things in righteousness wilt thou answer us, O God of our salvation; who art the confidence of all the ends of the earth, and of them that are afar off upon the sea:
- <u>Psa_65:9</u> Thou visitest the earth, and waterest it: thou greatly enrichest it with the river of God, *which* is full of water: thou preparest them corn, when thou hast so provided for it.
- <u>Psa_66:4</u> All the earth shall worship thee, and shall sing unto thee; they shall sing *to* thy name. Selah.
- <u>Psa_67:2</u> That thy way may be known upon earth, thy saving health among all nations.

- <u>Psa_67:4</u> O let the nations be glad and sing for joy: for thou shalt judge the people righteously, and govern the nations upon earth. Selah.
- <u>Psa_67:6</u> Then shall the earth yield her increase; and God, even our own God, shall bless us.
- Psa 67:7 God shall bless us; and all the ends of the earth shall fear him.
- <u>Psa_68:8</u> The earth shook, the heavens also dropped at the presence of God: even Sinai itself was moved at the presence of God, the God of Israel.
- <u>Psa_68:32</u> Sing unto God, ye kingdoms of the earth; O sing praises unto the Lord; Selah:
- <u>Psa_69:34</u> Let the heaven and earth praise him, the seas, and every thing that moveth therein.
- <u>Psa_71:20</u> Thou, which hast shewed me great and sore troubles, shalt quicken me again, and shalt bring me up again from the depths of the earth.
- <u>Psa_72:6</u> He shall come down like rain upon the mown grass: as showers *that* water the earth.
- <u>Psa_72:8</u> He shall have dominion also from sea to sea, and from the river unto the ends of the earth.
- <u>Psa_72:16</u> There shall be an handful of corn in the earth upon the top of the mountains; the fruit thereof shall shake like Lebanon: and *they* of the city shall flourish like grass of the earth.
- <u>Psa_72:19</u> And blessed *be* his glorious name for ever: and let the whole earth be filled *with* his glory; Amen, and Amen.
- <u>Psa_73:9</u> They set their mouth against the heavens, and their tongue walketh through the earth.
- <u>Psa_73:25</u> Whom have I in heaven *but thee?* and *there is* none upon earth *that* I desire beside thee.
- <u>Psa_74:12</u> For God *is* my King of old, working salvation in the midst of the earth.
- <u>Psa_74:17</u> Thou hast set all the borders of the earth: thou hast made summer and winter.
- <u>Psa_74:20</u> Have respect unto the covenant: for the dark places of the earth are full of the habitations of cruelty.

- <u>Psa_75:3</u> The earth and all the inhabitants thereof are dissolved: I bear up the pillars of it. Selah.
- <u>Psa_75:8</u> For in the hand of the LORD *there is* a cup, and the wine is red; it is full of mixture; and he poureth out of the same: but the dregs thereof, all the wicked of the earth shall wring *them* out, *and* drink *them*.
- <u>Psa_76:8</u> Thou didst cause judgment to be heard from heaven; the earth feared, and was still,
- <u>Psa_76:9</u> When God arose to judgment, to save all the meek of the earth. Selah.
- <u>Psa_76:12</u> He shall cut off the spirit of princes: *he is* terrible to the kings of the earth.
- <u>Psa_77:18</u> The voice of thy thunder *was* in the heaven: the lightnings lightened the world: the earth trembled and shook.
- <u>Psa_78:69</u> And he built his sanctuary like high *palaces*, like the earth which he hath established for ever.
- <u>Psa_79:2</u> The dead bodies of thy servants have they given *to be* meat unto the fowls of the heaven, the flesh of thy saints unto the beasts of the earth.
- <u>Psa_82:5</u> They know not, neither will they understand; they walk on in darkness: all the foundations of the earth are out of course.
- Psa_82:8 Arise, O God, judge the earth: for thou shalt inherit all nations.
- Psa_83:10 Which perished at Endor: they became as dung for the earth.
- <u>Psa_83:18</u> That *men* may know that thou, whose name alone *is* JEHOVAH, *art* the most high over all the earth.
- <u>Psa_85:11</u> Truth shall spring out of the earth; and righteousness shall look down from heaven.
- <u>Psa_89:11</u> The heavens *are* thine, the earth also *is* thine: *as for* the world and the fulness thereof, thou hast founded them.
- <u>Psa_89:27</u> Also I will make him *my* firstborn, higher than the kings of the earth.
- <u>Psa_90:2</u> Before the mountains were brought forth, or ever thou hadst formed the earth and the world, even from everlasting to everlasting, thou *art* God.
- <u>Psa_94:2</u> Lift up thyself, thou judge of the earth: render a reward to the proud.

- <u>Psa_95:4</u> In his hand *are* the deep places of the earth: the strength of the hills *is* his also.
- Psa_96:1 O sing unto the LORD a new song: sing unto the LORD, all the earth.
- <u>Psa_96:9</u> O worship the LORD in the beauty of holiness: fear before him, all the earth.
- <u>Psa_96:11</u> Let the heavens rejoice, and let the earth be glad; let the sea roar, and the fulness thereof.
- <u>Psa_96:13</u> Before the LORD: for he cometh, for he cometh to judge the earth: he shall judge the world with righteousness, and the people with his truth.
- <u>Psa_97:1</u> The LORD reigneth; let the earth rejoice; let the multitude of isles be glad *thereof*.
- <u>Psa_97:4</u> His lightnings enlightened the world: the earth saw, and trembled.
- <u>Psa_97:5</u> The hills melted like wax at the presence of the LORD, at the presence of the Lord of the whole earth.
- <u>Psa_97:9</u> For thou, LORD, *art* high above all the earth: thou art exalted far above all gods.
- <u>Psa_98:3</u> He hath remembered his mercy and his truth toward the house of Israel: all the ends of the earth have seen the salvation of our God.
- <u>Psa 98:4</u> Make a joyful noise unto the LORD, all the earth: make a loud noise, and rejoice, and sing praise.
- <u>Psa_98:9</u> Before the LORD; for he cometh to judge the earth: with righteousness shall he judge the world, and the people with equity.
- <u>Psa_99:1</u> The LORD reigneth; let the people tremble: he sitteth *between* the cherubims; let the earth be moved.
- <u>Psa_102:15</u> So the heathen shall fear the name of the LORD, and all the kings of the earth thy glory.
- <u>Psa_102:19</u> For he hath looked down from the height of his sanctuary; from heaven did the LORD behold the earth;
- <u>Psa_102:25</u> Of old hast thou laid the foundation of the earth: and the heavens are the work of thy hands.
- <u>Psa_103:11</u> For as the heaven is high above the earth, *so* great is his mercy toward them that fear him.

- <u>Psa_104:5</u> Who laid the foundations of the earth, that it should not be removed for ever.
- <u>Psa_104:9</u> Thou hast set a bound that they may not pass over; that they turn not again to cover the earth.
- <u>Psa_104:13</u> He watereth the hills from his chambers: the earth is satisfied with the fruit of thy works.
- <u>Psa_104:14</u> He causeth the grass to grow for the cattle, and herb for the service of man: that he may bring forth food out of the earth;
- <u>Psa_104:24</u> O LORD, how manifold are thy works! in wisdom hast thou made them all: the earth is full of thy riches.
- <u>Psa_104:30</u> Thou sendest forth thy spirit, they are created: and thou renewest the face of the earth.
- <u>Psa_104:32</u> He looketh on the earth, and it trembleth: he toucheth the hills, and they smoke.
- <u>Psa_104:35</u> Let the sinners be consumed out of the earth, and let the wicked be no more. Bless thou the LORD, O my soul. Praise ye the LORD.
- Psa_105:7 He is the LORD our God: his judgments are in all the earth.
- <u>Psa_106:17</u> The earth opened and swallowed up Dathan, and covered the company of Abiram.
- <u>Psa_108:5</u> Be thou exalted, O God, above the heavens: and thy glory above all the earth;
- <u>Psa_109:15</u> Let them be before the LORD continually, that he may cut off the memory of them from the earth.
- <u>Psa_112:2</u> His seed shall be mighty upon earth: the generation of the upright shall be blessed.
- <u>Psa_113:6</u> Who humbleth *himself* to behold *the things that are* in heaven, and in the earth!
- <u>Psa_114:7</u> Tremble, thou earth, at the presence of the Lord, at the presence of the God of Jacob;
- Psa_115:15 Ye are blessed of the LORD which made heaven and earth.
- <u>Psa_115:16</u> The heaven, *even* the heavens, *are* the LORD'S: but the earth hath he given to the children of men.

- <u>Psa_119:19</u> I *am* a stranger in the earth: hide not thy commandments from me.
- Psa_119:64 The earth, O LORD, is full of thy mercy: teach me thy statutes.
- <u>Psa_119:87</u> They had almost consumed me upon earth; but I forsook not thy precepts.
- <u>Psa_119:90</u> Thy faithfulness *is* unto all generations: thou hast established the earth, and it abideth.
- <u>Psa_119:119</u> Thou puttest away all the wicked of the earth *like* dross: therefore I love thy testimonies.
- Psa_121:2 My help cometh from the LORD, which made heaven and earth.
- Psa_124:8 Our help is in the name of the LORD, who made heaven and earth.
- Psa 134:3 The LORD that made heaven and earth bless thee out of Zion.
- <u>Psa_135:6</u> Whatsoever the LORD pleased, *that* did he in heaven, and in earth, in the seas, and all deep places.
- <u>Psa_135:7</u> He causeth the vapours to ascend from the ends of the earth; he maketh lightnings for the rain; he bringeth the wind out of his treasuries.
- <u>Psa_136:6</u> To him that stretched out the earth above the waters: for his mercy endureth for ever.
- <u>Psa_138:4</u> All the kings of the earth shall praise thee, O LORD, when they hear the words of thy mouth.
- <u>Psa_139:15</u> My substance was not hid from thee, when I was made in secret, and curiously wrought in the lowest parts of the earth.
- <u>Psa_140:11</u> Let not an evil speaker be established in the earth: evil shall hunt the violent man to overthrow *him*.
- <u>Psa_141:7</u> Our bones are scattered at the grave's mouth, as when one cutteth and cleaveth *wood* upon the earth.
- <u>Psa_146:4</u> His breath goeth forth, he returneth to his earth; in that very day his thoughts perish.
- <u>Psa_146:6</u> Which made heaven, and earth, the sea, and all that therein *is:* which keepeth truth for ever:
- <u>Psa_147:8</u> Who covereth the heaven with clouds, who prepareth rain for the earth, who maketh grass to grow upon the mountains.

- <u>Psa_147:15</u> He sendeth forth his commandment *upon* earth: his word runneth very swiftly.
- Psa_148:7 Praise the LORD from the earth, ye dragons, and all deeps:
- <u>Psa_148:11</u> Kings of the earth, and all people; princes, and all judges of the earth:
- <u>Psa_148:13</u> Let them praise the name of the LORD: for his name alone is excellent; his glory *is* above the earth and heaven.
- <u>Pro_2:22</u> But the wicked shall be cut off from the earth, and the transgressors shall be rooted out of it.
- <u>Pro_3:19</u> The LORD by wisdom hath founded the earth; by understanding hath he established the heavens.
- <u>Pro_8:16</u> By me princes rule, and nobles, *even* all the judges of the earth.
- <u>Pro_8:23</u> I was set up from everlasting, from the beginning, or ever the earth was.
- <u>Pro_8:26</u> While as yet he had not made the earth, nor the fields, nor the highest part of the dust of the world.
- <u>Pro_8:29</u> When he gave to the sea his decree, that the waters should not pass his commandment: when he appointed the foundations of the earth:
- <u>Pro_8:31</u> Rejoicing in the habitable part of his earth; and my delights *were* with the sons of men.
- <u>Pro_10:30</u> The righteous shall never be removed: but the wicked shall not inhabit the earth.
- <u>Pro_11:31</u> Behold, the righteous shall be recompensed in the earth: much more the wicked and the sinner.
- <u>Pro_17:24</u> Wisdom *is* before him that hath understanding; but the eyes of a fool *are* in the ends of the earth.
- <u>Pro_25:3</u> The heaven for height, and the earth for depth, and the heart of kings *is* unsearchable.
- <u>Pro_30:4</u> Who hath ascended up into heaven, or descended? who hath gathered the wind in his fists? who hath bound the waters in a garment? who hath established all the ends of the earth? what *is* his name, and what *is* his son's name, if thou canst tell?
- Pro_30:14 There is a generation, whose teeth are as swords, and their jaw

- teeth *as* knives, to devour the poor from off the earth, and the needy from *among* men.
- <u>Pro_30:16</u> The grave; and the barren womb; the earth *that* is not filled with water; and the fire *that* saith not, *It is* enough.
- <u>Pro_30:21</u> For three *things* the earth is disquieted, and for four *which* it cannot bear:
- <u>Pro_30:24</u> There be four *things which are* little upon the earth, but they *are* exceeding wise:
- <u>Ecc_1:4</u> One generation passeth away, and another generation cometh: but the earth abideth for ever.
- Ecc_3:21 Who knoweth the spirit of man that goeth upward, and the spirit of the beast that goeth downward to the earth?
- <u>Ecc_5:2</u> Be not rash with thy mouth, and let not thine heart be hasty to utter any thing before God: for God
- is in heaven, and thou upon earth: therefore let thy words be few.
- <u>Ecc_5:9</u> Moreover the profit of the earth is for all: the king *himself* is served by the field.
- <u>Ecc_7:20</u> For *there is* not a just man upon earth, that doeth good, and sinneth not.
- <u>Ecc_8:14</u> There is a vanity which is done upon the earth; that there be just *men*, unto whom it happeneth according to the work of the wicked; again, there be wicked *men*, to whom it happeneth according to the work of the righteous: I said that this also *is* vanity.
- <u>Ecc_8:16</u> When I applied mine heart to know wisdom, and to see the business that is done upon the earth: (for also *there is that* neither day nor night seeth sleep with his eyes:)
- $\underline{\text{Ecc}}_{10:7}$ I have seen servants upon horses, and princes walking as servants upon the earth.
- Ecc_11:2 Give a portion to seven, and also to eight; for thou knowest not what evil shall be upon the earth.
- <u>Ecc_11:3</u> If the clouds be full of rain, they empty *themselves* upon the earth: and if the tree fall toward the south, or toward the north, in the place where the tree falleth, there it shall be.
- Ecc_12:7 Then shall the dust return to the earth as it was: and the spirit shall

- return unto God who gave it.
- <u>Son 2:12</u> The flowers appear on the earth; the time of the singing *of birds* is come, and the voice of the turtle is heard in our land;
- <u>Isa_1:2</u> Hear, O heavens, and give ear, O earth: for the LORD hath spoken, I have nourished and brought up children, and they have rebelled against me.
- <u>Isa_2:19</u> And they shall go into the holes of the rocks, and into the caves of the earth, for fear of the LORD, and for the glory of his majesty, when he ariseth to shake terribly the earth.
- <u>Isa 2:21</u> To go into the clefts of the rocks, and into the tops of the ragged rocks, for fear of the LORD, and for the glory of his majesty, when he ariseth to shake terribly the earth.
- <u>Isa_4:2</u> In that day shall the branch of the LORD be beautiful and glorious, and the fruit of the earth *shall be* excellent and comely for them that are escaped of Israel.
- <u>Isa_5:8</u> Woe unto them that join house to house, *that* lay field to field, till *there be* no place, that they may be placed alone in the midst of the earth!
- <u>Isa_5:26</u> And he will lift up an ensign to the nations from far, and will hiss unto them from the end of the earth: and, behold, they shall come with speed swiftly:
- <u>Isa_6:3</u> And one cried unto another, and said, Holy, holy, is the LORD of hosts: the whole earth is full of his glory.
- <u>Isa</u> 8:22 And they shall look unto the earth; and behold trouble and darkness, dimness of anguish; and *they shall be* driven to darkness.
- <u>Isa_10:14</u> And my hand hath found as a nest the riches of the people: and as one gathereth eggs *that are* left, have I gathered all the earth; and there was none that moved the wing, or opened the mouth, or peeped.
- <u>Isa_11:4</u> But with righteousness shall he judge the poor, and reprove with equity for the meek of the earth: and he shall smite the earth with the rod of his mouth, and with the breath of his lips shall he slay the wicked.
- <u>Isa_11:9</u> They shall not hurt nor destroy in all my holy mountain: for the earth shall be full of the knowledge of the LORD, as the waters cover the sea.
- <u>Isa_11:12</u> And he shall set up an ensign for the nations, and shall assemble the outcasts of Israel, and gather together the dispersed of Judah from the four corners of the earth.
- <u>Isa_12:5</u> Sing unto the LORD; for he hath done excellent things: this *is* known

in all the earth.

- <u>Isa_13:13</u> Therefore I will shake the heavens, and the earth shall remove out of her place, in the wrath of the LORD of hosts, and in the day of his fierce anger.
- <u>Isa_14:7</u> The whole earth is at rest, *and* is quiet: they break forth into singing.
- <u>Isa_14:9</u> Hell from beneath is moved for thee to meet *thee* at thy coming: it stirreth up the dead for thee, *even* all the chief ones of the earth; it hath raised up from their thrones all the kings of the nations.
- <u>Isa_14:16</u> They that see thee shall narrowly look upon thee, *and* consider thee, *saying*, *Is* this the man that made the earth to tremble, that did shake kingdoms;
- <u>Isa_14:26</u> This *is* the purpose that is purposed upon the whole earth: and this *is* the hand that is stretched out upon all the nations.
- <u>Isa_18:3</u> All ye inhabitants of the world, and dwellers on the earth, see ye, when he lifteth up an ensign on the mountains; and when he bloweth a trumpet, hear ye.
- <u>Isa_18:6</u> They shall be left together unto the fowls of the mountains, and to the beasts of the earth: and the fowls shall summer upon them, and all the beasts of the earth shall winter upon them.
- <u>Isa 23:8</u> Who hath taken this counsel against Tyre, the crowning *city*, whose merchants *are* princes, whose traffickers *are* the honourable of the earth?
- <u>Isa</u> 23:9 The LORD of hosts hath purposed it, to stain the pride of all glory, and to bring into contempt all the honourable of the earth.
- <u>Isa_23:17</u> And it shall come to pass after the end of seventy years, that the LORD will visit Tyre, and she shall turn to her hire, and shall commit fornication with all the kingdoms of the world upon the face of the earth.
- <u>Isa_24:1</u> Behold, the LORD maketh the earth empty, and maketh it waste, and turneth it upside down, and scattereth abroad the inhabitants thereof.
- <u>Isa 24:4</u> The earth mourneth *and* fadeth away, the world languisheth *and* fadeth away, the haughty people of the earth do languish.
- <u>Isa_24:5</u> The earth also is defiled under the inhabitants thereof; because they have transgressed the laws, changed the ordinance, broken the everlasting covenant.
- <u>Isa_24:6</u> Therefore hath the curse devoured the earth, and they that dwell therein are desolate: therefore the inhabitants of the earth are burned, and few

men left.

- <u>Isa_24:16</u> From the uttermost part of the earth have we heard songs, *even* glory to the righteous. But I said, My leanness, my leanness, woe unto me! the treacherous dealers have dealt treacherously; yea, the treacherous dealers have dealt very treacherously.
- <u>Isa_24:17</u> Fear, and the pit, and the snare, *are* upon thee, O inhabitant of the earth.
- <u>Isa_24:18</u> And it shall come to pass, *that* he who fleeth from the noise of the fear shall fall into the pit; and he that cometh up out of the midst of the pit shall be taken in the snare: for the windows from on high are open, and the foundations of the earth do shake.
- <u>Isa_24:19</u> The earth is utterly broken down, the earth is clean dissolved, the earth is moved exceedingly.
- <u>Isa_24:20</u> The earth shall reel to and fro like a drunkard, and shall be removed like a cottage; and the transgression thereof shall be heavy upon it; and it shall fall, and not rise again.
- <u>Isa_24:21</u> And it shall come to pass in that day, *that* the LORD shall punish the host of the high ones *that are* on high, and the kings of the earth upon the earth.
- <u>Isa_25:8</u> He will swallow up death in victory; and the Lord GOD will wipe away tears from off all faces; and the rebuke of his people shall he take away from off all the earth: for the LORD hath spoken *it*.
- <u>Isa_26:9</u> With my soul have I desired thee in the night; yea, with my spirit within me will I seek thee early: for when thy judgments *are* in the earth, the inhabitants of the world will learn righteousness.
- <u>Isa_26:15</u> Thou hast increased the nation, O LORD, thou hast increased the nation: thou art glorified: thou hadst removed *it* far *unto* all the ends of the earth.
- <u>Isa_26:18</u> We have been with child, we have been in pain, we have as it were brought forth wind; we have not wrought any deliverance in the earth; neither have the inhabitants of the world fallen.
- <u>Isa_26:19</u> Thy dead *men* shall live, *together with* my dead body shall they arise. Awake and sing, ye that dwell in dust: for thy dew *is as* the dew of herbs, and the earth shall cast out the dead.
- <u>Isa_26:21</u> For, behold, the LORD cometh out of his place to punish the inhabitants of the earth for their iniquity: the earth also shall disclose her

- blood, and shall no more cover her slain.
- <u>Isa_28:2</u> Behold, the Lord hath a mighty and strong one, *which* as a tempest of hail *and* a destroying storm, as a flood of mighty waters overflowing, shall cast down to the earth with the hand.
- <u>Isa_28:22</u> Now therefore be ye not mockers, lest your bands be made strong: for I have heard from the Lord GOD of hosts a consumption, even determined upon the whole earth.
- <u>Isa_30:23</u> Then shall he give the rain of thy seed, that thou shalt sow the ground withal; and bread of the increase of the earth, and it shall be fat and plenteous: in that day shall thy cattle feed in large pastures.
- <u>Isa_33:9</u> The earth mourneth *and* languisheth: Lebanon is ashamed *and* hewn down: Sharon is like a wilderness; and Bashan and Carmel shake off *their fruits.*
- <u>Isa_34:1</u> Come near, ye nations, to hear; and hearken, ye people: let the earth hear, and all that is therein; the world, and all things that come forth of it.
- <u>Isa_37:16</u> O LORD of hosts, God of Israel, that dwellest *between* the cherubims, thou *art* the God, *even* thou alone, of all the kingdoms of the earth: thou hast made heaven and earth.
- <u>Isa_37:20</u> Now therefore, O LORD our God, save us from his hand, that all the kingdoms of the earth may know that thou *art* the LORD, *even* thou only.
- <u>Isa_40:12</u> Who hath measured the waters in the hollow of his hand, and meted out heaven with the span, and comprehended the dust of the earth in a measure, and weighed the mountains in scales, and the hills in a balance?
- <u>Isa_40:21</u> Have ye not known? have ye not heard? hath it not been told you from the beginning? have ye not understood from the foundations of the earth?
- <u>Isa_40:22</u> It is he that sitteth upon the circle of the earth, and the inhabitants thereof *are* as grasshoppers; that stretcheth out the heavens as a curtain, and spreadeth them out as a tent to dwell in:
- <u>Isa_40:23</u> That bringeth the princes to nothing; he maketh the judges of the earth as vanity.
- <u>Isa_40:24</u> Yea, they shall not be planted; yea, they shall not be sown: yea, their stock shall not take root in the earth: and he shall also blow upon them, and they shall wither, and the whirlwind shall take them away as stubble.
- <u>Isa_40:28</u> Hast thou not known? hast thou not heard, *that* the everlasting

- God, the LORD, the Creator of the ends of the earth, fainteth not, neither is weary? *there is* no searching of his understanding.
- <u>Isa_41:5</u> The isles saw *it,* and feared; the ends of the earth were afraid, drew near, and came.
- <u>Isa_41:9</u> Thou whom I have taken from the ends of the earth, and called thee from the chief men thereof, and said unto thee, Thou *art* my servant; I have chosen thee, and not cast thee away.
- <u>Isa_42:4</u> He shall not fail nor be discouraged, till he have set judgment in the earth: and the isles shall wait for his law.
- <u>Isa_42:5</u> Thus saith God the LORD, he that created the heavens, and stretched them out; he that spread forth the earth, and that which cometh out of it; he that giveth breath unto the people upon it, and spirit to them that walk therein:
- <u>Isa_42:10</u> Sing unto the LORD a new song, *and* his praise from the end of the earth, ye that go down to the sea, and all that is therein; the isles, and the inhabitants thereof.
- <u>Isa_43:6</u> I will say to the north, Give up; and to the south, Keep not back: bring my sons from far, and my daughters from the ends of the earth;
- <u>Isa_44:23</u> Sing, O ye heavens; for the LORD hath done *it:* shout, ye lower parts of the earth: break forth into singing, ye mountains, O forest, and every tree therein: for the LORD hath redeemed Jacob, and glorified himself in Israel.
- <u>Isa_44:24</u> Thus saith the LORD, thy redeemer, and he that formed thee from the womb, I *am* the LORD that maketh all *things;* that stretcheth forth the heavens alone; that spreadeth abroad the earth by myself;
- <u>Isa_45:8</u> Drop down, ye heavens, from above, and let the skies pour down righteousness: let the earth open, and let them bring forth salvation, and let righteousness spring up together; I the LORD have created it.
- <u>Isa_45:9</u> Woe unto him that striveth with his Maker! *Let* the potsherd *strive* with the potsherds of the earth. Shall the clay say to him that fashioneth it, What makest thou? or thy work, He hath no hands?
- <u>Isa 45:12</u> I have made the earth, and created man upon it: I, *even* my hands, have stretched out the heavens, and all their host have I commanded.
- <u>Isa_45:18</u> For thus saith the LORD that created the heavens; God himself that formed the earth and made it; he hath established it, he created it not in vain, he formed it to be inhabited: I *am* the LORD; and *there is* none else.

- <u>Isa_45:19</u> I have not spoken in secret, in a dark place of the earth: I said not unto the seed of Jacob, Seek ye me in vain: I the LORD speak righteousness, I declare things that are right.
- <u>Isa_45:22</u> Look unto me, and be ye saved, all the ends of the earth: for I *am* God, and *there is* none else.
- <u>Isa_48:13</u> Mine hand also hath laid the foundation of the earth, and my right hand hath spanned the heavens: *when* I call unto them, they stand up together.
- <u>Isa_48:20</u> Go ye forth of Babylon, flee ye from the Chaldeans, with a voice of singing declare ye, tell this, utter it *even* to the end of the earth; say ye, The LORD hath redeemed his servant Jacob.
- <u>Isa_49:6</u> And he said, It is a light thing that thou shouldest be my servant to raise up the tribes of Jacob, and to restore the preserved of Israel: I will also give thee for a light to the Gentiles, that thou mayest be my salvation unto the end of the earth.
- <u>Isa_49:8</u> Thus saith the LORD, In an acceptable time have I heard thee, and in a day of salvation have I helped thee: and I will preserve thee, and give thee for a covenant of the people, to establish the earth, to cause to inherit the desolate heritages;
- <u>Isa</u> 49:13 Sing, O heavens; and be joyful, O earth; and break forth into singing, O mountains: for the LORD hath comforted his people, and will have mercy upon his afflicted.
- <u>Isa 49:23</u> And kings shall be thy nursing fathers, and their queens thy nursing mothers: they shall bow down to thee with *their* face toward the earth, and lick up the dust of thy feet; and thou shalt know that I *am* the LORD: for they shall not be ashamed that wait for me.
- <u>Isa_51:6</u> Lift up your eyes to the heavens, and look upon the earth beneath: for the heavens shall vanish away like smoke, and the earth shall wax old like a garment, and they that dwell therein shall die in like manner: but my salvation shall be for ever, and my righteousness shall not be abolished.
- <u>Isa_51:13</u> And forgettest the LORD thy maker, that hath stretched forth the heavens, and laid the foundations of the earth; and hast feared continually every day because of the fury of the oppressor, as if he were ready to destroy? and where *is* the fury of the oppressor?
- <u>Isa_51:16</u> And I have put my words in thy mouth, and I have covered thee in the shadow of mine hand, that I may plant the heavens, and lay the foundations of the earth, and say unto Zion, Thou *art* my people.

- <u>Isa</u> <u>52:10</u> The LORD hath made bare his holy arm in the eyes of all the nations; and all the ends of the earth shall see the salvation of our God.
- <u>Isa_54:5</u> For thy Maker *is* thine husband; the LORD of hosts *is* his name; and thy Redeemer the Holy One of Israel; The God of the whole earth shall he be called.
- <u>Isa_54:9</u> For this *is as* the waters of Noah unto me: for *as* I have sworn that the waters of Noah should no more go over the earth; so have I sworn that I would not be wroth with thee, nor rebuke thee.
- <u>Isa</u> <u>55:9</u> For *as* the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways, and my thoughts than your thoughts.
- <u>Isa_55:10</u> For as the rain cometh down, and the snow from heaven, and returneth not thither, but watereth the earth, and maketh it bring forth and bud, that it may give seed to the sower, and bread to the eater:
- <u>Isa_58:14</u> Then shalt thou delight thyself in the LORD; and I will cause thee to ride upon the high places of the earth, and feed thee with the heritage of Jacob thy father: for the mouth of the LORD hath spoken *it*.
- <u>Isa_60:2</u> For, behold, the darkness shall cover the earth, and gross darkness the people: but the LORD shall arise upon thee, and his glory shall be seen upon thee.
- <u>Isa_61:11</u> For as the earth bringeth forth her bud, and as the garden causeth the things that are sown in it to spring forth; so the Lord GOD will cause righteousness and praise to spring forth before all the nations.
- <u>Isa_62:7</u> And give him no rest, till he establish, and till he make Jerusalem a praise in the earth.
- <u>Isa_63:6</u> And I will tread down the people in mine anger, and make them drunk in my fury, and I will bring down their strength to the earth.
- <u>Isa_65:16</u> That he who blesseth himself in the earth shall bless himself in the God of truth; and he that sweareth in the earth shall swear by the God of truth; because the former troubles are forgotten, and because they are hid from mine eyes.
- <u>Isa_65:17</u> For, behold, I create new heavens and a new earth: and the former shall not be remembered, nor come into mind.
- <u>Isa_66:1</u> Thus saith the LORD, The heaven *is* my throne, and the earth *is* my footstool: where *is* the house that ye build unto me? and where *is* the place of my rest?

- <u>Isa_66:8</u> Who hath heard such a thing? who hath seen such things? Shall the earth be made to bring forth in one day? *or* shall a nation be born at once? for as soon as Zion travailed, she brought forth her children.
- <u>Isa_66:22</u> For as the new heavens and the new earth, which I will make, shall remain before me, saith the LORD, so shall your seed and your name remain.
- <u>Jer_4:23</u> I beheld the earth, and, lo, *it was* without form, and void; and the heavens, and they *had* no light.
- <u>Jer_4:28</u> For this shall the earth mourn, and the heavens above be black: because I have spoken *it*, I have purposed *it*, and will not repent, neither will I turn back from it.
- <u>Jer_6:19</u> Hear, O earth: behold, I will bring evil upon this people, *even* the fruit of their thoughts, because they have not hearkened unto my words, nor to my law, but rejected it.
- <u>Jer_6:22</u> Thus saith the LORD, Behold, a people cometh from the north country, and a great nation shall be raised from the sides of the earth.
- <u>Jer_7:33</u> And the carcases of this people shall be meat for the fowls of the heaven, and for the beasts of the earth; and none shall fray *them* away.
- <u>Jer_8:2</u> And they shall spread them before the sun, and the moon, and all the host of heaven, whom they have loved, and whom they have served, and after whom they have walked, and whom they have sought, and whom they have worshipped: they shall not be gathered, nor be buried; they shall be for dung upon the face of the earth.
- <u>Jer_9:3</u> And they bend their tongues *like* their bow *for* lies: but they are not valiant for the truth upon the earth; for they proceed from evil to evil, and they know not me, saith the LORD.
- <u>Jer_9:24</u> But let him that glorieth glory in this, that he understandeth and knoweth me, that I *am* the LORD which exercise lovingkindness, judgment, and righteousness, in the earth: for in these *things* I delight, saith the LORD.
- <u>Jer_10:10</u> But the LORD *is* the true God, he *is* the living God, and an everlasting king: at his wrath the earth shall tremble, and the nations shall not be able to abide his indignation.
- <u>Jer_10:11</u> Thus shall ye say unto them, The gods that have not made the heavens and the earth, *even* they shall perish from the earth, and from under these heavens.
- <u>Jer_10:12</u> He hath made the earth by his power, he hath established the world by his wisdom, and hath stretched out the heavens by his discretion.

- <u>Jer 10:13</u> When he uttereth his voice, *there is* a multitude of waters in the heavens, and he causeth the vapours to ascend from the ends of the earth; he maketh lightnings with rain, and bringeth forth the wind out of his treasures.
- <u>Jer_14:4</u> Because the ground is chapt, for there was no rain in the earth, the plowmen were ashamed, they covered their heads.
- <u>Jer_15:3</u> And I will appoint over them four kinds, saith the LORD: the sword to slay, and the dogs to tear, and the fowls of the heaven, and the beasts of the earth, to devour and destroy.
- Jer 15:4 And I will cause them to be removed into all kingdoms of the
- earth, because of Manasseh the son of Hezekiah king of Judah, for *that* which he did in Jerusalem.
- <u>Jer_15:10</u> Woe is me, my mother, that thou hast borne me a man of strife and a man of contention to the whole earth! I have neither lent on usury, nor men have lent to me on usury; *yet* every one of them doth curse me.
- <u>Jer_16:4</u> They shall die of grievous deaths; they shall not be lamented; neither shall they be buried; *but* they shall be as dung upon the face of the earth: and they shall be consumed by the sword, and by famine; and their carcases shall be meat for the fowls of heaven, and for the beasts of the earth.
- <u>Jer_16:19</u> O LORD, my strength, and my fortress, and my refuge in the day of affliction, the Gentiles shall come unto thee from the ends of the earth, and shall say, Surely our fathers have inherited lies, vanity, and *things* wherein *there is* no profit.
- <u>Jer_17:13</u> O LORD, the hope of Israel, all that forsake thee shall be ashamed, and they that depart from me shall be written in the earth, because they have forsaken the LORD, the fountain of living waters.
- <u>Jer_19:7</u> And I will make void the counsel of Judah and Jerusalem in this place; and I will cause them to fall by the sword before their enemies, and by the hands of them that seek their lives: and their carcases will I give to be meat for the fowls of the heaven, and for the beasts of the earth.
- <u>Jer_22:29</u> O earth, earth, hear the word of the LORD.
- <u>Jer_23:5</u> Behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that I will raise unto David a righteous Branch, and a King shall reign and prosper, and shall execute judgment and justice in the earth.
- <u>Jer_23:24</u> Can any hide himself in secret places that I shall not see him? saith the LORD. Do not I fill heaven and earth? saith the LORD.

- <u>Jer 24:9</u> And I will deliver them to be removed into all the kingdoms of the earth for *their* hurt, *to be* a reproach and a proverb, a taunt and a curse, in all places whither I shall drive them.
- <u>Jer 25:26</u> And all the kings of the north, far and near, one with another, and all the kingdoms of the world, which *are* upon the face of the earth: and the king of Sheshach shall drink after them.
- <u>Jer_25:29</u> For, lo, I begin to bring evil on the city which is called by my name, and should ye be utterly unpunished? Ye shall not be unpunished: for I will call for a sword upon all the inhabitants of the earth, saith the LORD of hosts.
- <u>Jer_25:30</u> Therefore prophesy thou against them all these words, and say unto them, The LORD shall roar from on high, and utter his voice from his holy habitation; he shall mightily roar upon his habitation; he shall give a shout, as they that tread *the grapes*, against all the inhabitants of the earth.
- <u>Jer_25:31</u> A noise shall come *even* to the ends of the earth; for the LORD hath a controversy with the nations, he will plead with all flesh; he will give them *that are* wicked to the sword, saith the LORD.
- <u>Jer_25:32</u> Thus saith the LORD of hosts, Behold, evil shall go forth from nation to nation, and a great whirlwind shall be raised up from the coasts of the earth.
- <u>Jer_25:33</u> And the slain of the LORD shall be at that day from *one* end of the earth even unto the *other* end of the earth: they shall not be lamented, neither gathered, nor buried; they shall be dung upon the ground.
- <u>Jer_26:6</u> Then will I make this house like Shiloh, and will make this city a curse to all the nations of the earth.
- <u>Jer_27:5</u> I have made the earth, the man and the beast that *are* upon the ground, by my great power and by my outstretched arm, and have given it unto whom it seemed meet unto me.
- <u>Jer_28:16</u> Therefore thus saith the LORD; Behold, I will cast thee from off the face of the earth: this year thou shalt die, because thou hast taught rebellion against the LORD.
- <u>Jer_29:18</u> And I will persecute them with the sword, with the famine, and with the pestilence, and will deliver them to be removed to all the kingdoms of the earth, to be a curse, and an astonishment, and an hissing, and a reproach, among all the nations whither I have driven them:
- <u>Jer_31:8</u> Behold, I will bring them from the north country, and gather them from the coasts of the earth, *and* with them the blind and the lame, the woman with child and her that travaileth with child together: a great company shall return thither.

- <u>Jer_31:22</u> How long wilt thou go about, O thou backsliding daughter? for the LORD hath created a new thing in the earth, A woman shall compass a man.
- <u>Jer_31:37</u> Thus saith the LORD; If heaven above can be measured, and the foundations of the earth searched out beneath, I will also cast off all the seed of Israel for all that they have done, saith the LORD.
- <u>Jer_32:17</u> Ah Lord GOD! behold, thou hast made the heaven and the earth by thy great power and stretched out arm, *and* there is nothing too hard for thee:
- <u>Jer_33:9</u> And it shall be to me a name of joy, a praise and an honour before all the nations of the earth, which shall hear all the good that I do unto them: and they shall fear and tremble for all the goodness and for all the prosperity that I procure unto it.
- <u>Jer_33:25</u> Thus saith the LORD; If my covenant *be* not with day and night, and if I have not appointed the ordinances of heaven and earth;
- <u>Jer_34:1</u> The word which came unto Jeremiah from the LORD, when Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon, and all his army, and all the kingdoms of the earth of his dominion, and all the people, fought against Jerusalem, and against all the cities thereof, saying,
- Jer_34:17 Therefore thus saith the LORD; Ye have not hearkened unto me, in proclaiming liberty, every one to his brother, and every man to his neighbour: behold, I proclaim a liberty for you, saith the LORD, to the sword, to the pestilence, and to the famine; and I will make you to be removed into all the kingdoms of the earth.
- <u>Jer_34:20</u> I will even give them into the hand of their enemies, and into the hand of them that seek their life: and their dead bodies shall be for meat unto the fowls of the heaven, and to the beasts of the earth.
- <u>Jer_44:8</u> In that ye provoke me unto wrath with the works of your hands, burning incense unto other gods in the land of Egypt, whither ye be gone to dwell, that ye might cut yourselves off, and that ye might be a curse and a reproach among all the nations of the earth?
- <u>Jer_46:8</u> Egypt riseth up like a flood, and *his* waters are moved like the rivers; and he saith, I will go up, *and* will cover the earth; I will destroy the city and the inhabitants thereof.
- <u>Jer_49:21</u> The earth is moved at the noise of their fall, at the cry the noise thereof was heard in the Red sea.
- <u>Jer_50:23</u> How is the hammer of the whole earth cut asunder and broken! how is Babylon become a desolation among the nations!

- <u>Jer 50:41</u> Behold, a people shall come from the north, and a great nation, and many kings shall be raised up from the coasts of the earth.
- <u>Jer_50:46</u> At the noise of the taking of Babylon the earth is moved, and the cry is heard among the nations.
- <u>Jer_51:7</u> Babylon *hath been* a golden cup in the LORD'S hand, that made all the earth drunken: the nations have drunken of her wine; therefore the nations are mad.
- <u>Jer_51:15</u> He hath made the earth by his power, he hath established the world by his wisdom, and hath stretched out the heaven by his understanding.
- <u>Jer 51:16</u> When he uttereth *his* voice, *there is* a multitude of waters in the heavens; and he causeth the vapours to ascend from the ends of the earth: he maketh lightnings with rain, and bringeth forth the wind out of his treasures.
- <u>Jer_51:25</u> Behold, I *am* against thee, O destroying mountain, saith the LORD, which destroyest all the earth: and I will stretch out mine hand upon thee, and roll thee down from the rocks, and will make thee a burnt mountain.
- <u>Jer_51:41</u> How is Sheshach taken! and how is the praise of the whole earth surprised! how is Babylon become an astonishment among the nations!
- <u>Jer_51:48</u> Then the heaven and the earth, and all that *is* therein, shall sing for Babylon: for the spoilers shall come unto her from the north, saith the LORD.
- <u>Jer_51:49</u> As Babylon *hath caused* the slain of Israel to fall, so at Babylon shall fall the slain of all the earth.
- <u>Lam_2:1</u> How hath the Lord covered the daughter of Zion with a cloud in his anger, *and* cast down from heaven unto the earth the beauty of Israel, and remembered not his footstool in the day of his anger!
- <u>Lam_2:11</u> Mine eyes do fail with tears, my bowels are troubled, my liver is poured upon the earth, for the destruction of the daughter of my people; because the children and the sucklings swoon in the streets of the city.
- <u>Lam_2:15</u> All that pass by clap *their* hands at thee; they hiss and wag their head at the daughter of Jerusalem, *saying*, *Is* this the city that *men* call The perfection of beauty, The joy of the whole earth?
- <u>Lam_3:34</u> To crush under his feet all the prisoners of the earth,
- <u>Lam_4:12</u> The kings of the earth, and all the inhabitants of the world, would not have believed that the adversary and the enemy should have entered into the gates of Jerusalem.
- <u>Eze_1:15</u> Now as I beheld the living creatures, behold one wheel upon the

earth by the living creatures, with his four faces.

- <u>Eze_1:19</u> And when the living creatures went, the wheels went by them: and when the living creatures were lifted up from the earth, the wheels were lifted up.
- <u>Eze_1:21</u> When those went, *these* went; and when those stood, *these* stood; and when those were lifted up from the earth, the wheels were lifted up over against them: for the spirit of the living creature *was* in the wheels.
- <u>Eze_7:21</u> And I will give it into the hands of the strangers for a prey, and to the wicked of the earth for a spoil; and they shall pollute it.
- <u>Eze_8:3</u> And he put forth the form of an hand, and took me by a lock of mine head; and the spirit lifted me up between the earth and the heaven, and brought me in the visions of God to Jerusalem, to the door of the inner gate that looketh toward the north; where *was* the seat of the image of jealousy, which provoketh to jealousy.

Eze 8:12

Then said he unto me, Son of man, hast thou seen what the ancients of the house of Israel do in the dark, every man in the chambers of his imagery? for they say, The LORD seeth us not; the LORD hath forsaken the earth.

- <u>Eze_9:9</u> Then said he unto me, The iniquity of the house of Israel and Judah *is* exceeding great, and the land is full of blood, and the city full of perverseness: for they say, The LORD hath forsaken the earth, and the LORD seeth not.
- <u>Eze_10:16</u> And when the cherubims went, the wheels went by them: and when the cherubims lifted up their wings to mount up from the earth, the same wheels also turned not from beside them.
- <u>Eze_10:19</u> And the cherubims lifted up their wings, and mounted up from the earth in my sight: when they went out, the wheels also *were* beside them, and *every one* stood at the door of the east gate of the LORD'S house; and the glory of the God of Israel *was* over them above.
- <u>Eze_26:20</u> When I shall bring thee down with them that descend into the pit, with the people of old time, and shall set thee in the low parts of the earth, in places desolate of old, with them that go down to the pit, that thou be not inhabited; and I shall set glory in the land of the living;
- <u>Eze_27:33</u> When thy wares went forth out of the seas, thou filledst many people; thou didst enrich the kings of the earth with the multitude of thy riches and of thy merchandise.
- <u>Eze_28:18</u> Thou hast defiled thy sanctuaries by the multitude of thine

- iniquities, by the iniquity of thy traffick; therefore will I bring forth a fire from the midst of thee, it shall devour thee, and I will bring thee to ashes upon the earth in the sight of all them that behold thee.
- <u>Eze_31:12</u> And strangers, the terrible of the nations, have cut him off, and have left him: upon the mountains and in all the valleys his branches are fallen, and his boughs are broken by all the rivers of the land; and all the people of the earth are gone down from his shadow, and have left him.
- <u>Eze_31:14</u> To the end that none of all the trees by the waters exalt themselves for their height, neither shoot up their top among the thick boughs, neither their trees stand up in their height, all that drink water: for they are all delivered unto death, to the nether parts of the earth, in the midst of the children of men, with them that go down to the pit.
- <u>Eze_31:16</u> I made the nations to shake at the sound of his fall, when I cast him down to hell with them that descend into the pit: and all the trees of Eden, the choice and best of Lebanon, all that drink water, shall be comforted in the nether parts of the earth.
- <u>Eze_31:18</u> To whom art thou thus like in glory and in greatness among the trees of Eden? yet shalt thou be brought down with the trees of Eden unto the nether parts of the earth: thou shalt lie in the midst of the uncircumcised with them that be slain by the sword. This is Pharaoh and all his multitude, saith the Lord GOD.
- <u>Eze_32:4</u> Then will I leave thee upon the land, I will cast thee forth upon the open field, and will cause all the fowls of the heaven to remain upon thee, and I will fill the beasts of the whole earth with thee.
- <u>Eze_32:18</u> Son of man, wail for the multitude of Egypt, and cast them down, *even* her, and the daughters of the famous nations, unto the nether parts of the earth, with them that go down into the pit.
- <u>Eze_32:24</u> There *is* Elam and all her multitude round about her grave, all of them slain, fallen by the sword, which are gone down uncircumcised into the nether parts of the earth, which caused their terror in the land of the living; yet have they borne their shame with them that go down to the pit.
- <u>Eze_34:6</u> My sheep wandered through all the mountains, and upon every high hill: yea, my flock was scattered upon all the face of the earth, and none did search or seek *after them*.
- <u>Eze_34:27</u> And the tree of the field shall yield her fruit, and the earth shall yield her increase, and they shall be safe in their land, and shall know that I am the LORD, when I have broken the bands of their yoke, and delivered them out of the hand of those that served themselves of them.

- <u>Eze_35:14</u> Thus saith the Lord GOD; When the whole earth rejoiceth, I will make thee desolate.
- <u>Eze_38:20</u> So that the fishes of the sea, and the fowls of the heaven, and the beasts of the field, and all creeping things that creep upon the earth, and all the men that *are* upon the face of the earth, shall shake at my presence, and the mountains shall be thrown down, and the steep places shall fall, and every wall shall fall to the ground.
- <u>Eze_39:14</u> And they shall sever out men of continual employment, passing through the land to bury with the passengers those that remain upon the face of the earth, to cleanse it: after the end of seven months shall they search.
- <u>Eze_39:18</u> Ye shall eat the flesh of the mighty, and drink the blood of the princes of the earth, of rams, of lambs, and of goats, of bullocks, all of them fatlings of Bashan.
- <u>Eze_43:2</u> And, behold, the glory of the God of Israel came from the way of the east: and his voice *was* like a noise of many waters: and the earth shined with his glory.
- <u>Dan_2:10</u> The Chaldeans answered before the king, and said, There is not a man upon the earth that can shew the king's matter: therefore *there is* no king, lord, nor ruler, *that* asked such things at any magician, or astrologer, or Chaldean.
- <u>Dan_2:35</u> Then was the iron, the clay, the brass, the silver, and the gold, broken to pieces together, and became like the chaff of the summer threshingfloors; and the wind carried them away, that no place was found for them: and the stone that smote the image became a great mountain, and filled the whole earth.
- <u>Dan_2:39</u> And after thee shall arise another kingdom inferior to thee, and another third kingdom of brass, which shall bear rule over all the earth.
- <u>Dan_4:1</u> Nebuchadnezzar the king, unto all people, nations, and languages, that dwell in all the earth; Peace be multiplied unto you.
- <u>Dan_4:10</u> Thus *were* the visions of mine head in my bed; I saw, and behold a tree in the midst of the earth, and the height thereof *was* great.
- <u>Dan 4:11</u> The tree grew, and was strong, and the height thereof reached unto heaven, and the sight thereof to the end of all the earth:
- <u>Dan_4:15</u> Nevertheless leave the stump of his roots in the earth, even with a band of iron and brass, in the tender grass of the field; and let it be wet with the dew of heaven, and *let* his portion *be* with the beasts in the grass of the earth:

- <u>Dan 4:20</u> The tree that thou sawest, which grew, and was strong, whose height reached unto the heaven, and the sight thereof to all the earth;
- <u>Dan_4:22</u> It *is* thou, O king, that art grown and become strong: for thy greatness is grown, and reacheth unto heaven, and thy dominion to the end of the earth.
- <u>Dan_4:23</u> And whereas the king saw a watcher and an holy one coming down from heaven, and saying, Hew the tree down, and destroy it; yet leave the stump of the roots thereof in the earth, even with a band of iron and brass, in the tender grass of the field; and let it be wet with the dew of heaven, and *let* his portion *be* with the beasts of the field, till seven times pass over him;
- <u>Dan_4:35</u> And all the inhabitants of the earth *are* reputed as nothing: and he doeth according to his will in the army of heaven, and *among* the inhabitants of the earth: and none can stay his hand, or say unto him, What doest thou?
- <u>Dan_6:25</u> Then king Darius wrote unto all people, nations, and languages, that dwell in all the earth; Peace be multiplied unto you.
- <u>Dan_6:27</u> He delivereth and rescueth, and he worketh signs and wonders in heaven and in earth, who hath delivered Daniel from the power of the lions.
- <u>Dan_7:4</u> The first was like a lion, and had eagle's wings: I beheld till the wings thereof were plucked, and it was lifted up from the earth, and made stand upon the feet as a man, and a man's heart was given to it.
- <u>Dan_7:17</u> These great beasts, which are four, *are* four kings, *which* shall arise out of the earth.
- <u>Dan_7:23</u> Thus he said, The fourth beast shall be the fourth kingdom upon earth, which shall be diverse from all kingdoms, and shall devour the whole earth, and shall tread it down, and break it in pieces.
- <u>Dan_8:5</u> And as I was considering, behold, an he goat came from the west on the face of the whole earth, and touched not the ground: and the goat *had* a notable horn between his eyes.
- <u>Dan_12:2</u> And many of them that sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, some to everlasting life, and some to shame *and* everlasting contempt.
- <u>Hos_2:18</u> And in that day will I make a covenant for them with the beasts of the field, and with the fowls of heaven, and *with* the creeping things of the ground: and I will break the bow and the sword and the battle out of the earth, and will make them to lie down safely.
- <u>Hos_2:21</u> And it shall come to pass in that day, I will hear, saith the LORD, I will hear the heavens, and they shall hear the earth;

- Hos 2:22 And the earth shall hear the corn, and the wine, and the oil; and they shall hear Jezreel.
- Hos 2:23 And I will sow her unto me in the earth; and I will have mercy upon her that had not obtained mercy; and I will say to *them which were* not my people, Thou *art* my people; and they shall say, *Thou art* my God.
- <u>Hos_6:3</u> Then shall we know, *if* we follow on to know the LORD: his going forth is prepared as the morning; and he shall come unto us as the rain, as the latter *and* former rain unto the earth.
- <u>Joe</u> 2:10 The earth shall quake before them; the heavens shall tremble: the sun and the moon shall be dark, and the stars shall withdraw their shining:
- <u>Joe_2:30</u> And I will shew wonders in the heavens and in the earth, blood, and fire, and pillars of smoke.
- <u>Joe_3:16</u> The LORD also shall roar out of Zion, and utter his voice from Jerusalem; and the heavens and the earth shall shake: but the LORD *will be* the hope of his people, and the strength of the children of Israel.
- Amo_2:7 That pant after the dust of the earth on the head of the poor, and turn aside the way of the meek: and a man and his father will go in unto the
- same maid, to profane my holy name:
- Amo_3:2 You only have I known of all the families of the earth: therefore I will punish you for all your iniquities.
- Amo_3:5 Can a bird fall in a snare upon the earth, where no gin *is* for him? shall *one* take up a snare from the earth, and have taken nothing at all?
- Amo_4:13 For, lo, he that formeth the mountains, and createth the wind, and declareth unto man what *is* his thought, that maketh the morning darkness, and treadeth upon the high places of the earth, The LORD, The God of hosts, *is* his name.
- <u>Amo_5:7</u> Ye who turn judgment to wormwood, and leave off righteousness in the earth,
- Amo_5:8 Seek him that maketh the seven stars and Orion, and turneth the shadow of death into the morning, and maketh the day dark with night: that calleth for the waters of the sea, and poureth them out upon the face of the earth: The LORD *is* his name:
- Amo_8:9 And it shall come to pass in that day, saith the Lord GOD, that I will cause the sun to go down at noon, and I will darken the earth in the clear day:
- Amo_9:6 It is he that buildeth his stories in the heaven, and hath founded his

- troop in the earth; he that calleth for the waters of the sea, and poureth them out upon the face of the earth: The LORD *is* his name.
- Amo_9:8 Behold, the eyes of the Lord GOD are upon the sinful kingdom, and I will destroy it from off the face of the earth; saving that I will not utterly destroy the house of Jacob, saith the LORD.
- Amo_9:9 For, lo, I will command, and I will sift the house of Israel among all nations, like as *corn* is sifted in a sieve, yet shall not the least grain fall upon the earth.
- <u>Jon_2:6</u> I went down to the bottoms of the mountains; the earth with her bars was about me for ever: yet hast thou brought up my life from corruption, O LORD my God.
- Mic_1:2 Hear, all ye people; hearken, O earth, and all that therein is: and let the Lord GOD be witness against you, the Lord from his holy temple.
- Mic_1:3 For, behold, the LORD cometh forth out of his place, and will come down, and tread upon the high places of the earth.
- Mic_4:13 Arise and thresh, O daughter of Zion: for I will make thine horn iron, and I will make thy hoofs brass: and thou shalt beat in pieces many people: and I will consecrate their gain unto the LORD, and their substance unto the Lord of the whole earth.
- Mic_5:4 And he shall stand and feed in the strength of the LORD, in the majesty of the name of the LORD his God; and they shall abide: for now shall he be great unto the ends of the earth.
- Mic_6:2 Hear ye, O mountains, the LORD'S controversy, and ye strong foundations of the earth: for the LORD hath a controversy with his people, and he will plead with Israel.
- <u>Mic_7:2</u> The good *man* is perished out of the earth: and *there is* none upright among men: they all lie in wait for blood; they hunt every man his brother with a net.
- Mic_7:17 They shall lick the dust like a serpent, they shall move out of their holes like worms of the earth: they shall be afraid of the LORD our God, and shall fear because of thee.
- Nah_1:5 The mountains quake at him, and the hills melt, and the earth is burned at his presence, yea, the world, and all that dwell therein.
- Nah_2:13 Behold, I am against thee, saith the LORD of hosts, and I will burn her chariots in the smoke, and the sword shall devour thy young lions: and I will cut off thy prey from the earth, and the voice of thy messengers shall no

more be heard.

- <u>Hab_2:14</u> For the earth shall be filled with the knowledge of the glory of the LORD, as the waters cover the sea.
- <u>Hab 2:20</u> But the LORD *is* in his holy temple: let all the earth keep silence before him.
- <u>Hab_3:3</u> God came from Teman, and the Holy One from mount Paran. Selah. His glory covered the heavens, and the earth was full of his praise.
- <u>Hab_3:6</u> He stood, and measured the earth: he beheld, and drove asunder the nations; and the everlasting mountains were scattered, the perpetual hills did bow: his ways *are* everlasting.
- <u>Hab 3:9</u> Thy bow was made quite naked, *according* to the oaths of the tribes, *even thy* word. Selah. Thou didst cleave the earth with rivers.
- Zep_2:3 Seek ye the LORD, all ye meek of the earth, which have wrought his judgment; seek righteousness, seek meekness: it may be ye shall be hid in the day of the LORD'S anger.
- <u>Zep_2:11</u> The LORD *will be* terrible unto them: for he will famish all the gods of the earth; and *men* shall worship him, every one from his place, *even* all the isles of the heathen.
- <u>Zep_3:8</u> Therefore wait ye upon me, saith the LORD, until the day that I rise up to the prey: for my determination *is* to gather the nations, that I may assemble the kingdoms, to pour upon them mine indignation, *even* all my fierce anger: for all the earth shall be devoured with the fire of my jealousy.
- Zep_3:20 At that time will I bring you again, even in the time that I gather you: for I will make you a name and a praise among all people of the earth, when I turn back your captivity before your eyes, saith the LORD.
- <u>Hag 1:10</u> Therefore the heaven over you is stayed from dew, and the earth is stayed *from* her fruit.
- <u>Hag 2:6</u> For thus saith the LORD of hosts; Yet once, it *is* a little while, and I will shake the heavens, and the earth, and the sea, and the dry *land*;
- <u>Hag 2:21</u> Speak to Zerubbabel, governor of Judah, saying, I will shake the heavens and the earth;
- Zec 1:10 And the man that stood among the myrtle trees answered and said, These are they whom the LORD hath sent to walk to and fro through the earth.
- Zec_1:11 And they answered the angel of the LORD that stood among the myrtle trees, and said, We have walked to and fro through the earth, and,

- behold, all the earth sitteth still, and is at rest.
- Zec_4:10 For who hath despised the day of small things? for they shall rejoice, and shall see the plummet in the hand of Zerubbabel *with* those seven; they *are* the eyes of the LORD, which run to and fro through the whole earth.
- <u>Zec_4:14</u> Then said he, These *are* the two anointed ones, that stand by the Lord of the whole earth.
- Zec_5:3 Then said he unto me, This *is* the curse that goeth forth over the face of the whole earth: for every one that stealeth shall be cut off *as* on this side according to it; and every one that sweareth shall be cut off *as* on that side according to it.
- <u>Zec_5:6</u> And I said, What *is* it? And he said, This *is* an ephah that goeth forth. He said moreover, This *is* their resemblance through all the earth.
- Zec_5:9 Then lifted I up mine eyes, and looked, and, behold, there came out two women, and the wind was in their wings; for they had wings like the wings of a stork: and they lifted up the ephah between the earth and the heaven.
- <u>Zec_6:5</u> And the angel answered and said unto me, These *are* the four spirits of the heavens, which go forth from standing before the Lord of all the earth.
- Zec_6:7 And the bay went forth, and sought to go that they might walk to and fro through the earth: and he said, Get you hence, walk to and fro through the earth. So they walked to and fro through the earth.
- <u>Zec_9:10</u> And I will cut off the chariot from Ephraim, and the horse from Jerusalem, and the battle bow shall be cut off: and he shall speak peace unto the heathen: and his dominion *shall be* from sea *even* to sea, and from the river *even* to the ends of the earth.
- <u>Zec_12:1</u> The burden of the word of the LORD for Israel, saith the LORD, which stretcheth forth the heavens, and layeth the foundation of the earth, and formeth the spirit of man within him.
- Zec_12:3 And in that day will I make Jerusalem a burdensome stone for all people: all that burden themselves with it shall be cut in pieces, though all the people of the earth be gathered together against it.
- <u>Zec_14:9</u> And the LORD shall be king over all the earth: in that day shall there be one LORD, and his name one.
- Zec_14:17 And it shall be, that whoso will not come up of all the families of the earth unto Jerusalem to worship the King, the LORD of hosts, even upon them shall be no rain.

- <u>Mal_4:6</u> And he shall turn the heart of the fathers to the children, and the heart of the children to their fathers, lest I come and smite the earth with a curse.
- Mat 5:5 Blessed *are* the meek: for they shall inherit the earth.
- Mat_5:13 Ye are the salt of the earth: but if the salt have lost his savour, wherewith shall it be salted? it is thenceforth good for nothing, but to be cast out, and to be trodden under foot of men.
- <u>Mat_5:18</u> For verily I say unto you, Till heaven and earth pass, one jot or one tittle shall in no wise pass from the law, till all be fulfilled.
- <u>Mat 5:35</u> Nor by the earth; for it is his footstool: neither by Jerusalem; for it is the city of the great King.
- Mat 6:10 Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven.
- <u>Mat 6:19</u> Lay not up for yourselves treasures upon earth, where moth and rust doth corrupt, and where thieves break through and steal:
- <u>Mat_9:6</u> But that ye may know that the Son of man hath power on earth to forgive sins, (then saith he to the sick of the palsy,) Arise, take up thy bed, and go unto thine house.
- Mat_10:34 Think not that I am come to send peace on earth: I came not to send peace, but a sword.
- Mat 11:25 At that time Jesus answered and said, I thank thee, O Father, Lord of heaven and earth, because thou hast hid these things from the wise and prudent, and hast revealed them unto babes.
- <u>Mat_12:40</u> For as Jonas was three days and three nights in the whale's belly; so shall the Son of man be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth.
- <u>Mat_12:42</u> The queen of the south shall rise up in the judgment with this generation, and shall condemn it: for she came from the uttermost parts of the earth to hear the wisdom of Solomon; and, behold, a greater than Solomon *is* here.
- <u>Mat 13:5</u> Some fell upon stony places, where they had not much earth: and forthwith they sprung up, because they had no deepness of earth:
- Mat_16:19 And I will give unto thee the keys of the kingdom of heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt loose on

earth shall be loosed in heaven.

- Mat 17:25 He saith, Yes. And when he was come into the house, Jesus prevented him, saying, What thinkest thou, Simon? of whom do the kings of the earth take custom or tribute? of their own children, or of strangers?
- <u>Mat_18:18</u> Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.
- Mat_18:19 Again I say unto you, That if two of you shall agree on earth as touching any thing that they shall ask, it shall be done for them of my Father which is in heaven.
- Mat 23:9 And call no *man* your father upon the earth: for one is your Father, which is in heaven.
- <u>Mat_23:35</u> That upon you may come all the righteous blood shed upon the earth, from the blood of righteous Abel unto the blood of Zacharias son of Barachias, whom ye slew between the temple and the altar.
- Mat_24:30 And then shall appear the sign of the Son of man in heaven: and then shall all the tribes of the earth mourn, and they shall see the Son of man coming in the clouds of heaven with power and great glory.
- <u>Mat_24:35</u> Heaven and earth shall pass away, but my words shall not pass away.
- Mat 25:18 But he that had received one went and digged in the earth, and hid his lord's money.
- Mat_25:25 And I was afraid, and went and hid thy talent in the earth: lo, there thou hast that is thine.
- Mat_27:51 And, behold, the veil of the temple was rent in twain from the top to the bottom; and the earth did quake, and the rocks rent;
- Mat_28:18 And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth.
- Mar 2:10 But that ye may know that the Son of man hath power on earth to forgive sins, (he saith to the sick of the palsy,)
- Mar_4:5 And some fell on stony ground, where it had not much earth; and immediately it sprang up, because it had no depth of earth:
- Mar_4:28 For the earth bringeth forth fruit of herself; first the blade, then the ear, after that the full corn in the ear.
- Mar_4:31 It is like a grain of mustard seed, which, when it is sown in the earth, is less than all the seeds that be in the earth:

- Mar_9:3 And his raiment became shining, exceeding white as snow; so as no fuller on earth can white them.
- Mar_13:27 And then shall he send his angels, and shall gather together his elect from the four winds, from the uttermost part of the earth to the uttermost part of heaven.
- Mar_13:31 Heaven and earth shall pass away: but my words shall not pass away.
- <u>Luk_2:14</u> Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace, good will toward men.
- <u>Luk</u> 5:24 But that ye may know that the Son of man hath power upon earth to forgive sins, (he said unto the sick of the palsy,) I say unto thee, Arise, and take up thy couch, and go into thine house.
- <u>Luk</u> 6:49 But he that heareth, and doeth not, is like a man that without a foundation built an house upon the earth; against which the stream did beat vehemently, and immediately it fell; and the ruin of that house was great.
- <u>Luk_10:21</u> In that hour Jesus rejoiced in spirit, and said, I thank thee, O Father, Lord of heaven and earth, that thou hast hid these things from the wise and prudent, and hast revealed them unto babes: even so, Father; for so it seemed good in thy sight.
- <u>Luk 11:2</u> And he said unto them, When ye pray, say, Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done, as in heaven, so in earth.
- <u>Luk_11:31</u> The queen of the south shall rise up in the judgment with the men of this generation, and condemn them: for she came from the utmost parts of the earth to hear the wisdom of Solomon; and, behold, a greater than Solomon *is* here.
- <u>Luk_12:49</u> I am come to send fire on the earth; and what will I, if it be already kindled?
- <u>Luk 12:51</u> Suppose ye that I am come to give peace on earth? I tell you, Nay; but rather division:
- <u>Luk_12:56</u> Ye hypocrites, ye can discern the face of the sky and of the earth; but how is it that ye do not discern this time?
- <u>Luk_16:17</u> And it is easier for heaven and earth to pass, than one tittle of the law to fail.
- <u>Luk_18:8</u> I tell you that he will avenge them speedily. Nevertheless when the

- Son of man cometh, shall he find faith on the earth?
- <u>Luk_21:25</u> And there shall be signs in the sun, and in the moon, and in the stars; and upon the earth distress of nations, with perplexity; the sea and the waves roaring;
- <u>Luk 21:26</u> Men's hearts failing them for fear, and for looking after those things which are coming on the earth: for the powers of heaven shall be shaken.
- <u>Luk 21:33</u> Heaven and earth shall pass away: but my words shall not pass away.
- <u>Luk_21:35</u> For as a snare shall it come on all them that dwell on the face of the whole earth.
- <u>Luk_23:44</u> And it was about the sixth hour, and there was a darkness over all the earth until the ninth hour.
- <u>Luk_24:5</u> And as they were afraid, and bowed down *their* faces to the earth, they said unto them, Why seek ye the living among the dead?
- <u>Joh_3:31</u> He that cometh from above is above all: he that is of the earth is earthly, and speaketh of the earth: he that cometh from heaven is above all.
- <u>Joh_12:32</u> And I, if I be lifted up from the earth, will draw all *men* unto me.
- <u>Joh_17:4</u> I have glorified thee on the earth: I have finished the work which thou gavest me to do.
- Act_1:8 But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.
- Act 2:19 And I will shew wonders in heaven above, and signs in the earth beneath; blood, and fire, and vapour of smoke:
- Act_3:25 Ye are the children of the prophets, and of the covenant which God made with our fathers, saying unto Abraham, And in thy seed shall all the kindreds of the earth be blessed.
- Act_4:24 And when they heard that, they lifted up their voice to God with one accord, and said, Lord, thou art God, which hast made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and all that in them is:
- Act_4:26 The kings of the earth stood up, and the rulers were gathered together against the Lord, and against his Christ.
- Act_7:49 Heaven is my throne, and earth is my footstool: what house will ye build me? saith the Lord: or what is the place of my rest?

- Act_8:33 In his humiliation his judgment was taken away: and who shall declare his generation? for his life is taken from the earth.
- Act 9:4 And he fell to the earth, and heard a voice saying unto him, Saul, Saul, why persecutest thou me?
- Act_9:8 And Saul arose from the earth; and when his eyes were opened, he saw no man: but they led him by the hand, and brought *him* into Damascus.
- Act_10:11 And saw heaven opened, and a certain vessel descending unto him, as it had been a great sheet knit at the four corners, and let down to the earth:
- Act_10:12 Wherein were all manner of fourfooted beasts of the earth, and wild beasts, and creeping things, and fowls of the air.
- Act_11:6 Upon the which when I had fastened mine eyes, I considered, and saw fourfooted beasts of the earth, and wild beasts, and creeping things, and fowls of the air.
- <u>Act_13:47</u> For so hath the Lord commanded us, *saying*, I have set thee to be a light of the Gentiles, that thou shouldest be for salvation unto the ends of the earth.
- Act_14:15 And saying, Sirs, why do ye these things? We also are men of like passions with you, and preach unto you that ye should turn from these vanities unto the living God, which made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and all things that are therein:
- <u>Act_17:24</u> God that made the world and all things therein, seeing that he is Lord of heaven and earth, dwelleth not in temples made with hands;
- <u>Act_17:26</u> And hath made of one blood all nations of men for to dwell on all the face of the earth, and hath determined the times before appointed, and the bounds of their habitation;
- Act_22:22 And they gave him audience unto this word, and *then* lifted up their voices, and said, Away with such a *fellow* from the earth: for it is not fit that he should live.
- Act 26:14 And when we were all fallen to the earth, I heard a voice speaking unto me, and saying in the Hebrew tongue, Saul, Saul, why persecutest thou me? it is hard for thee to kick against the pricks.
- Rom_9:17 For the scripture saith unto Pharaoh, Even for this same purpose have I raised thee up, that I might shew my power in thee, and that my name might be declared throughout all the earth.
- Rom_9:28 For he will finish the work, and cut it short in righteousness:

- because a short work will the Lord make upon the earth.
- Rom_10:18 But I say, Have they not heard? Yes verily, their sound went into all the earth, and their words unto the ends of the world.
- 1Co_8:5 For though there be that are called gods, whether in heaven or in earth, (as there be gods many, and lords many,)
- 1Co_10:26 For the earth is the Lord's, and the fulness thereof.
- <u>1Co_10:28</u> But if any man say unto you, This is offered in sacrifice unto idols, eat not for his sake that shewed it, and for conscience sake: for the earth *is* the Lord's, and the fulness thereof:
- <u>1Co_15:47</u> The first man *is* of the earth, earthy: the second man *is* the Lord from heaven.
- <u>Eph_1:10</u> That in the dispensation of the fulness of times he might gather together in one all things in Christ, both which are in heaven, and which are on earth; *even* in him:
- Eph_3:15 Of whom the whole family in heaven and earth is named,
- <u>Eph_4:9</u> (Now that he ascended, what is it but that he also descended first into the lower parts of the earth?
- <u>Eph_6:3</u> That it may be well with thee, and thou mayest live long on the earth.
- <u>Php_2:10</u> That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of *things* in heaven, and *things* in earth, and *things* under the earth;
- <u>Col_1:16</u> For by him were all things created, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible, whether *they be* thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: all things were created by him, and for him:
- <u>Col_1:20</u> And, having made peace through the blood of his cross, by him to reconcile all things unto himself; by him,
- I say, whether they be things in earth, or things in heaven.
- <u>Col_3:2</u> Set your affection on things above, not on things on the earth.
- <u>Col_3:5</u> Mortify therefore your members which are upon the earth; fornication, uncleanness, inordinate affection, evil concupiscence, and covetousness, which is idolatry:
- <u>2Ti_2:20</u> But in a great house there are not only vessels of gold and of silver, but also of wood and of earth; and some to honour, and some to dishonour.

- <u>Heb 1:10</u> And, Thou, Lord, in the beginning hast laid the foundation of the earth; and the heavens are the works of thine hands:
- <u>Heb_6:7</u> For the earth which drinketh in the rain that cometh oft upon it, and bringeth forth herbs meet for them by whom it is dressed, receiveth blessing from God:
- <u>Heb_8:4</u> For if he were on earth, he should not be a priest, seeing that there are priests that offer gifts according to the law:
- <u>Heb_11:13</u> These all died in faith, not having received the promises, but having seen them afar off, and were persuaded of *them*, and embraced *them*, and confessed that they were strangers and pilgrims on the earth.
- <u>Heb_11:38</u> (Of whom the world was not worthy:) they wandered in deserts, and *in* mountains, and *in* dens and caves of the earth.
- <u>Heb_12:25</u> See that ye refuse not him that speaketh. For if they escaped not who refused him that spake on earth, much more *shall not* we *escape*, if we turn away from him that *speaketh* from heaven:
- <u>Heb_12:26</u> Whose voice then shook the earth: but now he hath promised, saying, Yet once more I shake not the earth only, but also heaven.
- <u>Jas_5:5</u> Ye have lived in pleasure on the earth, and been wanton; ye have nourished your hearts, as in a day of slaughter.
- <u>Jas_5:7</u> Be patient therefore, brethren, unto the coming of the Lord. Behold, the husbandman waiteth for the precious fruit of the earth, and hath long patience for it, until he receive the early and latter rain.
- <u>Jas_5:12</u> But above all things, my brethren, swear not, neither by heaven, neither by the earth, neither by any other oath: but let your yea be yea; and *your* nay, nay; lest ye fall into condemnation.
- <u>Jas_5:17</u> Elias was a man subject to like passions as we are, and he prayed earnestly that it might not rain: and it rained not on the earth by the space of three years and six months.
- <u>Jas 5:18</u> And he prayed again, and the heaven gave rain, and the earth brought forth her fruit.
- <u>2Pe_3:5</u> For this they willingly are ignorant of, that by the word of God the heavens were of old, and the earth standing out of the water and in the water:
- <u>2Pe_3:7</u> But the heavens and the earth, which are now, by the same word are kept in store, reserved unto fire against the day of judgment and perdition of ungodly men.

- <u>2Pe_3:10</u> But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night; in the which the heavens shall pass away with a great noise, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat, the earth also and the works that are therein shall be burned up.
- <u>2Pe_3:13</u> Nevertheless we, according to his promise, look for new heavens and a new earth, wherein dwelleth righteousness.
- <u>1Jn_5:8</u> And there are three that bear witness in earth, the Spirit, and the water, and the blood: and these three agree in one.
- Rev_1:5 And from Jesus Christ, who is the faithful witness, and the first begotten of the dead, and the prince of the kings of the earth. Unto him that loved us, and washed us from our sins in his own blood,
- <u>Rev_1:7</u> Behold, he cometh with clouds; and every eye shall see him, and they *also* which pierced him: and all kindreds of the earth shall wail because of him. Even so, Amen.
- <u>Rev_3:10</u> Because thou hast kept the word of my patience, I also will keep thee from the hour of temptation, which shall come upon all the world, to try them that dwell upon the earth.
- Rev_5:3 And no man in heaven, nor in earth, neither under the earth, was able to open the book, neither to look thereon.
- <u>Rev_5:6</u> And I beheld, and, lo, in the midst of the throne and of the four beasts, and in the midst of the elders, stood a Lamb as it had been slain, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God sent forth into all the earth.
- Rev_5:10 And hast made us unto our God kings and priests: and we shall reign on the earth.
- <u>Rev_5:13</u> And every creature which is in heaven, and on the earth, and under the earth, and such as are in the sea, and all that are in them, heard I saying, Blessing, and honour, and glory, and power, *be* unto him that sitteth upon the throne, and unto the Lamb for ever and ever.
- <u>Rev_6:4</u> And there went out another horse *that was* red: and *power* was given to him that sat thereon to take peace from the earth, and that they should kill one another: and there was given unto him a great sword.
- Rev_6:8 And I looked, and behold a pale horse: and his name that sat on him was Death, and Hell followed with him. And power was given unto them over the fourth part of the earth, to kill with sword, and with hunger, and with death, and with the beasts of the earth.

- <u>Rev_6:10</u> And they cried with a loud voice, saying, How long, O Lord, holy and true, dost thou not judge and avenge our blood on them that dwell on the earth?
- Rev_6:13 And the stars of heaven fell unto the earth, even as a fig tree casteth her untimely figs, when she is shaken of a mighty wind.
- Rev_6:15 And the kings of the earth, and the great men, and the rich men, and the chief captains, and the mighty men, and every bondman, and every free man, hid themselves in the dens and in the rocks of the mountains;
- <u>Rev_7:1</u> And after these things I saw four angels standing on the four corners of the earth, holding the four winds of the earth, that the wind should not blow on the earth, nor on the sea, nor on any tree.
- <u>Rev_7:2</u> And I saw another angel ascending from the east, having the seal of the living God: and he cried with a loud voice to the four angels, to whom it was given to hurt the earth and the sea,
- <u>Rev_7:3</u> Saying, Hurt not the earth, neither the sea, nor the trees, till we have sealed the servants of our God in their foreheads.
- <u>Rev_8:5</u> And the angel took the censer, and filled it with fire of the altar, and cast *it* into the earth: and there were voices, and thunderings, and lightnings, and an earthquake.
- <u>Rev_8:7</u> The first angel sounded, and there followed hail and fire mingled with blood, and they were cast upon the earth: and the third part of trees was burnt up, and all green grass was burnt up.
- Rev_8:13 And I beheld, and heard an angel flying through the midst of heaven, saying with a loud voice, Woe, woe, to the inhabiters of the earth by reason of the other voices of the trumpet of the three angels, which are yet to sound!
- <u>Rev_9:1</u> And the fifth angel sounded, and I saw a star fall from heaven unto the earth: and to him was given the key of the bottomless pit.
- Rev_9:3 And there came out of the smoke locusts upon the earth: and unto them was given power, as the scorpions of the earth have power.
- Rev_9:4 And it was commanded them that they should not hurt the grass of the earth, neither any green thing, neither any tree; but only those men which have not the seal of God in their foreheads.
- Rev_10:2 And he had in his hand a little book open: and he set his right foot upon the sea, and his left foot on the earth,

- Rev_10:5 And the angel which I saw stand upon the sea and upon the earth lifted up his hand to heaven,
- <u>Rev_10:6</u> And sware by him that liveth for ever and ever, who created heaven, and the things that therein are, and the earth, and the things that therein are, and the sea, and the things which are therein, that there should be time no longer:
- <u>Rev_10:8</u> And the voice which I heard from heaven spake unto me again, and said, Go *and* take the little book which is open in the hand of the angel which standeth upon the sea and upon the earth.
- Rev_11:4 These are the two olive trees, and the two candlesticks standing before the God of the earth.
- <u>Rev_11:6</u> These have power to shut heaven, that it rain not in the days of their prophecy: and have power over waters to turn them to blood, and to smite the earth with all plagues, as often as they will.
- Rev_11:10 And they that dwell upon the earth shall rejoice over them, and make merry, and shall send gifts one to another; because these two prophets tormented them that dwelt on the earth.
- Rev_11:18 And the nations were angry, and thy wrath is come, and the time of the dead, that they should be judged, and that thou shouldest give reward unto thy servants the prophets, and to the saints, and them that fear thy name, small and great; and shouldest destroy them which destroy the earth.
- Rev_12:4 And his tail drew the third part of the stars of heaven, and did cast them to the earth: and the dragon stood before the woman which was ready to be delivered, for to devour her child as soon as it was born.
- <u>Rev_12:9</u> And the great dragon was cast out, that old serpent, called the Devil, and Satan, which deceiveth the whole world: he was cast out into the earth, and his angels were cast out with him.
- Rev_12:12 Therefore rejoice, *ye* heavens, and ye that dwell in them. Woe to the inhabiters of the earth and of the sea! for the devil is come down unto you, having great wrath, because he knoweth that he hath but a short time.
- Rev_12:13 And when the dragon saw that he was cast unto the earth, he persecuted the woman which brought forth the man *child*.
- Rev_12:16 And the earth helped the woman, and the earth opened her mouth, and swallowed up the flood which the dragon cast out of his mouth.
- Rev_13:8 And all that dwell upon the earth shall worship him, whose names are not written in the book of life of the Lamb slain from the foundation of the

world.

- Rev_13:11 And I beheld another beast coming up out of the earth; and he had two horns like a lamb, and he spake as a dragon.
- Rev_13:12 And he exerciseth all the power of the first beast before him, and causeth the earth and them which dwell therein to worship the first beast, whose deadly wound was healed.

Rev_13:13

And he doeth great wonders, so that he maketh fire come down from heaven on the earth in the sight of men,

- Rev 13:14 And deceiveth them that dwell on the earth by *the means of* those miracles which he had power to do in the sight of the beast; saying to them that dwell on the earth, that they should make an image to the beast, which had the wound by a sword, and did live.
- <u>Rev_14:3</u> And they sung as it were a new song before the throne, and before the four beasts, and the elders: and no man could learn that song but the hundred *and* forty *and* four thousand, which were redeemed from the earth.
- <u>Rev_14:6</u> And I saw another angel fly in the midst of heaven, having the everlasting gospel to preach unto them that dwell on the earth, and to every nation, and kindred, and tongue, and people,
- <u>Rev_14:7</u> Saying with a loud voice, Fear God, and give glory to him; for the hour of his judgment is come: and worship him that made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and the fountains of waters.
- Rev_14:15 And another angel came out of the temple, crying with a loud voice to him that sat on the cloud, Thrust in thy sickle, and reap: for the time is come for thee to reap; for the harvest of the earth is ripe.
- Rev_14:16 And he that sat on the cloud thrust in his sickle on the earth; and the earth was reaped.
- Rev_14:18 And another angel came out from the altar, which had power over fire; and cried with a loud cry to him that had the sharp sickle, saying, Thrust in thy sharp sickle, and gather the clusters of the vine of the earth; for her grapes are fully ripe.
- Rev_14:19 And the angel thrust in his sickle into the earth, and gathered the vine of the earth, and cast *it* into the great winepress of the wrath of God.
- Rev_16:1 And I heard a great voice out of the temple saying to the seven angels, Go your ways, and pour out the vials of the wrath of God upon the

earth.

- <u>Rev_16:2</u> And the first went, and poured out his vial upon the earth; and there fell a noisome and grievous sore upon the men which had the mark of the beast, and *upon* them which worshipped his image.
- <u>Rev_16:14</u> For they are the spirits of devils, working miracles, *which* go forth unto the kings of the earth and of the whole world, to gather them to the battle of that great day of God Almighty.
- <u>Rev_16:18</u> And there were voices, and thunders, and lightnings; and there was a great earthquake, such as was not since men were upon the earth, so mighty an earthquake, *and* so great.
- <u>Rev_17:2</u> With whom the kings of the earth have committed fornication, and the inhabitants of the earth have been made drunk with the wine of her fornication.
- Rev_17:5 And upon her forehead was a name written, MYSTERY, BABYLON THE GREAT, THE MOTHER OF HARLOTS AND ABOMINATIONS OF THE EARTH.
- <u>Rev_17:8</u> The beast that thou sawest was, and is not; and shall ascend out of the bottomless pit, and go into perdition: and they that dwell on the earth shall wonder, whose names were not written in the book of life from the foundation of the world, when they behold the beast that was, and is not, and yet is.
- Rev_17:18 And the woman which thou sawest is that great city, which reigneth over the kings of the earth.
- Rev_18:1 And after these things I saw another angel come down from heaven, having great power; and the earth was lightened with his glory.
- Rev_18:3 For all nations have drunk of the wine of the wrath of her fornication, and the kings of the earth have committed fornication with her, and the merchants of the earth are waxed rich through the abundance of her delicacies.
- Rev_18:9 And the kings of the earth, who have committed fornication and lived deliciously with her, shall bewail her, and lament for her, when they shall see the smoke of her burning,
- Rev_18:11 And the merchants of the earth shall weep and mourn over her; for no man buyeth their merchandise any more:
- Rev_18:23 And the light of a candle shall shine no more at all in thee; and the voice of the bridegroom and of the bride shall be heard no more at all in thee: for thy merchants were the great men of the earth; for by thy sorceries were all nations deceived.

- Rev_18:24 And in her was found the blood of prophets, and of saints, and of all that were slain upon the earth.
- <u>Rev_19:2</u> For true and righteous *are* his judgments: for he hath judged the great whore, which did corrupt the earth with her fornication, and hath avenged the blood of his servants at her hand.
- <u>Rev_19:19</u> And I saw the beast, and the kings of the earth, and their armies, gathered together to make war against him that sat on the horse, and against his army.
- Rev_20:8 And shall go out to deceive the nations which are in the four quarters of the earth, Gog and Magog, to gather them together to battle: the number of whom *is* as the sand of the sea.
- <u>Rev_20:9</u> And they went up on the breadth of the earth, and compassed the camp of the saints about, and the beloved city: and fire came down from God out of heaven, and devoured them.
- Rev_20:11 And I saw a great white throne, and him that sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away; and there was found no place for them.
- Rev_21:1 And I saw a new heaven and a new earth: for the first heaven and the first earth were passed away; and there was no more sea.
- Rev_21:24 And the nations of them which are saved shall walk in the light of it: and the kings of the earth do bring their glory and honour into it.
