## HUMBLE

<u>Exo\_10:3</u> And Moses and Aaron came in unto Pharaoh, and said unto him, Thus saith the LORD God of the Hebrews, How long wilt thou refuse to humble thyself before me? let my people go, that they may serve me.

<u>Deu\_8:2</u> And thou shalt remember all the way which the LORD thy God led thee these forty years in the wilderness, to humble thee, *and* to prove thee, to know what *was* in thine heart, whether thou wouldest keep his commandments, or no.

<u>Deu\_8:16</u> Who fed thee in the wilderness with manna, which thy fathers knew not, that he might humble thee, and that he might prove thee, to do thee good at thy latter end;

<u>Jdg 19:24</u> Behold, *here is* my daughter a maiden, and his concubine; them I will bring out now, and humble ye them, and do with them what seemeth good unto you: but unto this man do not so vile a thing.

<u>2Ch\_7:14</u> If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.

<u>2Ch\_34:27</u> Because thine heart was tender, and thou didst humble thyself before God, when thou heardest his words against this place, and against the inhabitants thereof, and humbledst thyself before me, and didst rend thy clothes, and weep before me; I have even heard *thee* also, saith the LORD.

<u>lob\_22:29</u> When *men* are cast down, then thou shalt say, *There is* lifting up; and he shall save the humble person.

<u>Psa\_9:12</u> When he maketh inquisition for blood, he remembereth them: he forgetteth not the cry of the humble.

<u>Psa\_10:12</u> Arise, O LORD; O God, lift up thine hand: forget not the humble.

<u>Psa\_10:17</u> LORD, thou hast heard the desire of the humble: thou wilt prepare their heart, thou wilt cause thine ear to hear:

<u>Psa\_34:2</u> My soul shall make her boast in the LORD: the humble shall hear *thereof,* and be glad.

<u>Psa\_69:32</u> The humble shall see *this, and* be glad: and your heart shall live that seek God.

<u>Pro\_6:3</u> Do this now, my son, and deliver thyself, when thou art come into the hand of thy friend; go, humble thyself, and make sure thy friend.

<u>Pro\_16:19</u> Better *it is to be* of an humble spirit with the lowly, than to divide the spoil with the proud.

<u>Pro\_29:23</u> A man's pride shall bring him low: but honour shall uphold the humble in spirit.

<u>Isa\_57:15</u> For thus saith the high and lofty One that inhabiteth eternity, whose name *is* Holy; I dwell in the high and holy *place*, with him also *that is* of a contrite and humble spirit, to revive the spirit of the humble, and to revive the heart of the contrite ones.

<u>Jer\_13:18</u> Say unto the king and to the queen, Humble yourselves, sit down: for your principalities shall come down, *even* the crown of your glory.

<u>Mat 18:4</u> Whosoever therefore shall humble himself as this little child, the same is greatest in the kingdom of heaven.

<u>Mat\_23:12</u> And whosoever shall exalt himself shall be abased; and he that shall humble himself shall be exalted.

<u>2Co\_12:21</u> And lest, when I come again, my God will humble me among you, and *that* I shall bewail many which have sinned already, and have not repented of the uncleanness and fornication and lasciviousness which they have committed.

<u>las\_4:6</u> But he giveth more grace. Wherefore he saith, God resisteth the proud, but giveth grace unto the humble.

<u>Jas\_4:10</u> Humble yourselves in the sight of the Lord, and he shall lift you up.

<u>1Pe\_5:5</u> Likewise, ye younger, submit yourselves unto the elder. Yea, all *of you* be subject one to another, and be clothed with humility: for God resisteth the proud, and giveth grace to the humble.

<u> $1Pe_5:6$ </u> Humble yourselves therefore under the mighty hand of God, that he may exalt you in due time:
