- <u>Lev\_26:19</u> And I will break the pride of your power; and I will make your heaven as iron, and your earth as brass:
- <u>1Sa\_17:28</u> And Eliab his eldest brother heard when he spake unto the men; and Eliab's anger was kindled against David, and he said, Why camest thou down hither? and with whom hast thou left those few sheep in the wilderness? I know thy pride, and the naughtiness of thine heart; for thou art come down that thou mightest see the battle.
- <u>2Ch\_32:26</u> Notwithstanding Hezekiah humbled himself for the pride of his heart, *both* he and the inhabitants of Jerusalem, so that the wrath of the LORD came not upon them in the days of Hezekiah.
- <u>Job\_33:17</u> That he may withdraw man *from his* purpose, and hide pride from man.
- <u>Job\_35:12</u> There they cry, but none giveth answer, because of the pride of evil men.
- <u>Job\_41:15</u> His scales are his pride, shut up together as with a close seal.
- <u>Job\_41:34</u> He beholdeth all high *things:* he *is* a king over all the children of pride.
- <u>Psa\_10:2</u> The wicked in *his* pride doth persecute the poor: let them be taken in the devices that they have imagined.
- <u>Psa\_10:4</u> The wicked, through the pride of his countenance, will not seek <u>after God</u>: God is not in all his thoughts.
- <u>Psa\_31:20</u> Thou shalt hide them in the secret of thy presence from the pride of man: thou shalt keep them secretly in a pavilion from the strife of tongues.
- <u>Psa\_36:11</u> Let not the foot of pride come against me, and let not the hand of the wicked remove me.
- <u>Psa\_59:12</u> For the sin of their mouth and the words of their lips let them even be taken in their pride: and for cursing and lying which they speak.
- <u>Psa\_73:6</u> Therefore pride compasseth them about as a chain; violence covereth them *as* a garment.
- <u>Pro\_8:13</u> The fear of the LORD *is* to hate evil: pride, and arrogancy, and the evil way, and the froward mouth, do I hate.
- <u>Pro\_11:2</u> When pride cometh, then cometh shame: but with the lowly *is* wisdom.
- $\underline{\text{Pro}}$  13:10 Only by pride cometh contention: but with the well advised is

wisdom.

- <u>Pro\_14:3</u> In the mouth of the foolish *is* a rod of pride: but the lips of the wise shall preserve them.
- Pro\_16:18 Pride goeth before destruction, and an haughty spirit before a fall.
- <u>Pro\_29:23</u> A man's pride shall bring him low: but honour shall uphold the humble in spirit.
- <u>Isa\_9:9</u> And all the people shall know, *even* Ephraim and the inhabitant of Samaria, that say in the pride and stoutness of heart,
- <u>Isa 16:6</u> We have heard of the pride of Moab; *he is* very proud: *even* of his haughtiness, and his pride, and his wrath: *but* his lies *shall* not *be* so.
- <u>Isa</u> 23:9 The LORD of hosts hath purposed it, to stain the pride of all glory, and to bring into contempt all the honourable of the earth.
- <u>Isa\_25:11</u> And he shall spread forth his hands in the midst of them, as he that swimmeth spreadeth forth *his hands* to swim: and he shall bring down their pride together with the spoils of their hands.
- <u>Isa\_28:1</u> Woe to the crown of pride, to the drunkards of Ephraim, whose glorious beauty *is* a fading flower, which *are* on the head of the fat valleys of them that are overcome with wine!
- <u>Isa\_28:3</u> The crown of pride, the drunkards of Ephraim, shall be trodden under feet:
- <u>Jer\_13:9</u> Thus saith the LORD, After this manner will I mar the pride of Judah, and the great pride of Jerusalem.
- <u>Jer\_13:17</u> But if ye will not hear it, my soul shall weep in secret places for *your* pride; and mine eye shall weep sore, and run down with tears, because the LORD'S flock is carried away captive.
- <u>Jer\_48:29</u> We have heard the pride of Moab, (he is exceeding proud) his loftiness, and his arrogancy, and his pride, and the haughtiness of his heart.
- <u>Jer\_49:16</u> Thy terribleness hath deceived thee, *and* the pride of thine heart, O thou that dwellest in the clefts of the rock, that holdest the height of the hill: though thou shouldest make thy nest as high as the eagle, I will bring thee down from thence, saith the LORD.
- <u>Eze\_7:10</u> Behold the day, behold, it is come: the morning is gone forth; the rod hath blossomed, pride hath budded.
- <u>Eze\_16:49</u> Behold, this was the iniquity of thy sister Sodom, pride, fulness of

- bread, and abundance of idleness was in her and in her daughters, neither did she strengthen the hand of the poor and needy.
- <u>Eze\_16:56</u> For thy sister Sodom was not mentioned by thy mouth in the day of thy pride,
- <u>Eze\_30:6</u> Thus saith the LORD; They also that uphold Egypt shall fall; and the pride of her power shall come down: from the tower of Syene shall they fall in it by the sword, saith the Lord GOD.
- <u>Dan\_4:37</u> Now I Nebuchadnezzar praise and extol and honour the King of heaven, all whose works *are* truth, and his ways judgment: and those that walk in pride he is able to abase.
- <u>Dan 5:20</u> But when his heart was lifted up, and his mind hardened in pride, he was deposed from his kingly throne, and they took his glory from him:
- <u>Hos 5:5</u> And the pride of Israel doth testify to his face: therefore shall Israel and Ephraim fall in their iniquity; Judah also shall fall with them.
- <u>Hos\_7:10</u> And the pride of Israel testifieth to his face: and they do not return to the LORD their God, nor seek him for all this.
- Oba\_1:3 The pride of thine heart hath deceived thee, thou that dwellest in the clefts of the rock, whose habitation *is* high; that saith in his heart, Who shall bring me down to the ground?
- Zep 2:10 This shall they have for their pride, because they have reproached and magnified *themselves* against the people of the LORD of hosts.
- Zep\_3:11 In that day shalt thou not be ashamed for all thy doings, wherein thou hast transgressed against me: for then I will take away out of the midst of thee them that rejoice in thy pride, and thou shalt no more be haughty because of my holy mountain.
- <u>Zec\_9:6</u> And a bastard shall dwell in Ashdod, and I will cut off the pride of the Philistines.
- Zec\_10:11 And he shall pass through the sea with affliction, and shall smite the waves in the sea, and all the deeps of the river shall dry up: and the pride of Assyria shall be brought down, and the sceptre of Egypt shall depart away.
- <u>Zec\_11:3</u> There is a voice of the howling of the shepherds; for their glory is spoiled: a voice of the roaring of young lions; for the pride of Jordan is spoiled.
- Mar\_7:22 Thefts, covetousness, wickedness, deceit, lasciviousness, an evil eye, blasphemy, pride, foolishness:
- <u>1Ti\_3:6</u> Not a novice, lest being lifted up with pride he fall into the

condemnation of the devil.
