SABBATH

Exo_16:23 And he said unto them, This *is that* which the LORD hath said, To morrow *is* the rest of the holy sabbath unto the LORD: bake *that* which ye will bake *to day*, and seethe that ye will seethe; and that which remaineth over lay up for you to be kept until the morning.

<u>Exo_16:25</u> And Moses said, Eat that to day; for to day *is* a sabbath unto the LORD: to day ye shall not find it in the field.

<u>Exo_16:26</u> Six days ye shall gather it; but on the seventh day, *which is* the sabbath, in it there shall be none.

<u>Exo_16:29</u> See, for that the LORD hath given you the sabbath, therefore he giveth you on the sixth day the bread of two days; abide ye every man in his place, let no man go out of his place on the seventh day.

 $Exo_{20:8}$ Remember the sabbath day, to keep it holy.

<u>Exo_20:10</u> But the seventh day *is* the sabbath of the LORD thy God: *in it* thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thy cattle, nor thy stranger that *is* within thy gates:

<u>Exo_20:11</u> For *in* six days the LORD made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them *is*, and rested the seventh day: wherefore the LORD blessed the sabbath day, and hallowed it.

<u>Exo_31:14</u> Ye shall keep the sabbath therefore; for it *is* holy unto you: every one that defileth it shall surely be put to death: for whosoever doeth *any* work therein, that soul shall be cut off from among his people.

<u>Exo_31:15</u> Six days may work be done; but in the seventh *is* the sabbath of rest, holy to the LORD: whosoever doeth *any* work in the sabbath day, he shall surely be put to death.

<u>Exo_31:16</u> Wherefore the children of Israel shall keep the sabbath, to observe the sabbath throughout their generations, *for* a perpetual covenant.

<u>Exo_35:2</u> Six days shall work be done, but on the seventh day there shall be to you an holy day, a sabbath of rest to the LORD: whosoever doeth work therein shall be put to death.

<u>Exo_35:3</u> Ye shall kindle no fire throughout your habitations upon the sabbath day.

<u>Lev_16:31</u> It *shall be* a sabbath of rest unto you, and ye shall afflict your souls, by a statute for ever.

Lev_23:3 Six days shall work be done: but the seventh day *is* the sabbath of rest, an holy convocation; ye shall do no work *therein:* it *is* the sabbath of the

LORD in all your dwellings.

<u>Lev_23:11</u> And he shall wave the sheaf before the LORD, to be accepted for you: on the morrow after the sabbath the priest shall wave it.

Lev_23:15 And ye shall count unto you from the morrow after the sabbath, from the day that ye brought the sheaf of the wave offering; seven sabbaths shall be complete:

<u>Lev_23:16</u> Even unto the morrow after the seventh sabbath shall ye number fifty days; and ye shall offer a new meat offering unto the LORD.

<u>Lev 23:24</u> Speak unto the children of Israel, saying, In the seventh month, in the first day of the month, shall ye have a sabbath, a memorial of blowing of trumpets, an holy convocation.

<u>Lev_23:32</u> It *shall be* unto you a sabbath of rest, and ye shall afflict your souls: in the ninth *day* of the month at even, from even unto even, shall ye celebrate your sabbath.

Lev_23:39 Also in the fifteenth day of the seventh month, when ye have gathered in the fruit of the land, ye shall keep a feast unto the LORD seven days: on the first day *shall be* a sabbath, and on the eighth day *shall be* a sabbath.

<u>Lev_24:8</u> Every sabbath he shall set it in order before the LORD continually, *being taken* from the children of Israel by an everlasting covenant.

Lev_25:2 Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, When ye come into the land which I give you, then shall the land keep a sabbath unto the LORD.

<u>Lev_25:4</u> But in the seventh year shall be a sabbath of rest unto the land, a sabbath for the LORD: thou shalt neither sow thy field, nor prune thy vineyard.

Lev_25:6 And the sabbath of the land shall be meat for you; for thee, and for thy servant, and for thy maid, and for thy hired servant, and for thy stranger that sojourneth with thee,

<u>Num_15:32</u> And while the children of Israel were in the wilderness, they found a man that gathered sticks upon the sabbath day.

<u>Num_28:9</u> And on the sabbath day two lambs of the first year without spot, and two tenth deals of flour *for* a meat offering, mingled with oil, and the drink offering thereof:

<u>Num_28:10</u> *This is* the burnt offering of every sabbath, beside the continual burnt offering, and his drink offering.

<u>Deu_5:12</u> Keep the sabbath day to sanctify it, as the LORD thy God hath commanded thee.

<u>Deu 5:14</u> But the seventh day *is* the sabbath of the LORD thy God: *in it* thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, nor thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thine ox, nor thine ass, nor any of thy cattle, nor thy stranger that *is* within thy gates; that thy manservant and thy maidservant may rest as well as thou.

<u>Deu_5:15</u> And remember that thou wast a servant in the land of Egypt, and *that* the LORD thy God brought thee out thence through a mighty hand and by a stretched out arm: therefore the LORD thy God commanded thee to keep the sabbath day.

<u>2Ki_4:23</u> And he said, Wherefore wilt thou go to him to day? *it is* neither new moon, nor sabbath. And she said, *It shall be* well.

<u>2Ki_11:5</u> And he commanded them, saying, This *is* the thing that ye shall do; A third part of you that enter in on the sabbath shall even be keepers of the watch of the king's house;

 $2Ki_{11:7}$ And two parts of all you that go forth on the sabbath, even they shall keep the watch of the house of the LORD about the king.

<u>2Ki_11:9</u> And the captains over the hundreds did according to all *things* that Jehoiada the priest commanded: and they took every man his men that were to come in on the sabbath, with them that should go out on the sabbath, and came to Jehoiada the priest.

<u>2Ki_16:18</u> And the covert for the sabbath that they had built in the house, and the king's entry without, turned he from the house of the LORD for the king of Assyria.

<u>1Ch_9:32</u> And *other* of their brethren, of the sons of the Kohathites, *were* over the shewbread, to prepare *it* every sabbath.

<u>2Ch_23:4</u> This *is* the thing that ye shall do; A third part of you entering on the sabbath, of the priests and of the Levites, *shall be* porters of the doors;

<u>2Ch_23:8</u> So the Levites and all Judah did according to all things that Jehoiada the priest had commanded, and took every man his men that were to come in on the sabbath, with them that were to go *out* on the sabbath: for Jehoiada the priest dismissed not the courses.

<u>2Ch_36:21</u> To fulfil the word of the LORD by the mouth of Jeremiah, until the land had enjoyed her sabbaths: *for* as long as she lay desolate she kept sabbath, to fulfil threescore and ten years.

<u>Neh_9:14</u> And madest known unto them thy holy sabbath, and commandedst them precepts, statutes, and laws, by the hand of Moses thy servant:

<u>Neh_10:31</u> And *if* the people of the land bring ware or any victuals on the sabbath day to sell, *that* we would not buy it of them on the sabbath, or on the holy day: and *that* we would leave the seventh year, and the exaction of every debt.

<u>Neh_13:15</u> In those days saw I in Judah *some* treading wine presses on the sabbath, and bringing in sheaves, and lading asses; as also wine, grapes, and figs, and all *manner of* burdens, which they brought into Jerusalem on the sabbath day: and I testified *against them* in the day wherein they sold victuals.

<u>Neh_13:16</u> There dwelt men of Tyre also therein, which brought fish, and all manner of ware, and sold on the sabbath unto the children of Judah, and in Jerusalem.

<u>Neh_13:17</u> Then I contended with the nobles of Judah, and said unto them, What evil thing *is* this that ye do, and profane the sabbath day?

<u>Neh_13:18</u> Did not your fathers thus, and did not our God bring all this evil upon us, and upon this city? yet ye bring more wrath upon Israel by profaning the sabbath.

<u>Neh_13:19</u> And it came to pass, that when the gates of Jerusalem began to be dark before the sabbath, I commanded that the gates should be shut, and charged that they should not be opened till after the sabbath: and *some* of my servants set I at the gates, *that* there should no burden be brought in on the sabbath day.

<u>Neh_13:21</u> Then I testified against them, and said unto them, Why lodge ye about the wall? if ye do *so* again, I will lay hands on you. From that time forth came they no *more* on the sabbath.

<u>Neh_13:22</u> And I commanded the Levites that they should cleanse themselves, and *that* they should come *and* keep the gates, to sanctify the sabbath day. Remember me, O my God, *concerning* this also, and spare me according to the greatness of thy mercy.

<u>Psa_92:1</u> **A Psalm** *or* **Song for the sabbath day.** *It is a* good *thing* to give thanks unto the LORD, and to sing praises unto thy name, O most High:

<u>Isa_56:2</u> Blessed *is* the man *that* doeth this, and the son of man *that* layeth hold on it; that keepeth the sabbath from polluting it, and keepeth his hand from doing any evil.

<u>Isa_56:6</u> Also the sons of the stranger, that join themselves to the LORD, to serve him, and to love the name of the LORD, to be his servants, every one

that keepeth the sabbath from polluting it, and taketh hold of my covenant;

<u>Isa_58:13</u> If thou turn away thy foot from the sabbath, *from* doing thy pleasure on my holy day; and call the sabbath a delight, the holy of the LORD, honourable; and shalt honour him, not doing thine own ways, nor finding thine own pleasure, nor speaking *thine own* words:

<u>Isa_66:23</u> And it shall come to pass, *that* from one new moon to another, and from one sabbath to another, shall all flesh come to worship before me, saith the LORD.

<u>Jer_17:21</u> Thus saith the LORD; Take heed to yourselves, and bear no burden on the sabbath day, nor bring *it* in by the gates of Jerusalem;

<u>Jer_17:22</u> Neither carry forth a burden out of your houses on the sabbath day, neither do ye any work, but hallow ye the sabbath day, as I commanded your fathers.

<u>Jer_17:24</u> And it shall come to pass, if ye diligently hearken unto me, saith the LORD, to bring in no burden through the gates of this city on the

sabbath day, but hallow the sabbath day, to do no work therein;

<u>Jer_17:27</u> But if ye will not hearken unto me to hallow the sabbath day, and not to bear a burden, even entering in at the gates of Jerusalem on the sabbath day; then will I kindle a fire in the gates thereof, and it shall devour the palaces of Jerusalem, and it shall not be quenched.

<u>Eze_46:1</u> Thus saith the Lord GOD; The gate of the inner court that looketh toward the east shall be shut the six working days; but on the sabbath it shall be opened, and in the day of the new moon it shall be opened.

<u>Eze_46:4</u> And the burnt offering that the prince shall offer unto the LORD in the sabbath day *shall be* six lambs without blemish, and a ram without blemish.

<u>Eze_46:12</u> Now when the prince shall prepare a voluntary burnt offering or peace offerings voluntarily unto the LORD, *one* shall then open him the gate that looketh toward the east, and he shall prepare his burnt offering and his peace offerings, as he did on the sabbath day: then he shall go forth; and after his going forth *one* shall shut the gate.

<u>Amo_8:5</u> Saying, When will the new moon be gone, that we may sell corn? and the sabbath, that we may set forth wheat, making the ephah small, and the shekel great, and falsifying the balances by deceit?

<u>Mat_12:1</u> At that time Jesus went on the sabbath day through the corn; and his disciples were an hungred, and began to pluck the ears of corn, and to eat.

<u>Mat_12:2</u> But when the Pharisees saw *it,* they said unto him, Behold, thy disciples do that which is not lawful to do upon the sabbath day.

<u>Mat_12:5</u> Or have ye not read in the law, how that on the sabbath days the priests in the temple profane the sabbath, and are blameless?

<u>Mat_12:8</u> For the Son of man is Lord even of the sabbath day.

<u>Mat_12:10</u> And, behold, there was a man which had *his* hand withered. And they asked him, saying, Is it lawful to heal on the sabbath days? that they might accuse him.

<u>Mat 12:11</u> And he said unto them, What man shall there be among you, that shall have one sheep, and if it fall into a pit on the sabbath day, will he not lay hold on it, and lift *it* out?

<u>Mat_12:12</u> How much then is a man better than a sheep? Wherefore it is lawful to do well on the sabbath days.

<u>Mat_24:20</u> But pray ye that your flight be not in the winter, neither on the sabbath day:

<u>Mat_28:1</u> In the end of the sabbath, as it began to dawn toward the first *day* of the week, came Mary Magdalene and the other Mary to see the sepulchre.

<u>Mar_1:21</u> And they went into Capernaum; and straightway on the sabbath day he entered into the synagogue, and taught.

<u>Mar_2:23</u> And it came to pass, that he went through the corn fields on the sabbath day; and his disciples began, as they went, to pluck the ears of corn.

<u>Mar_2:24</u> And the Pharisees said unto him, Behold, why do they on the sabbath day that which is not lawful?

<u>Mar_2:27</u> And he said unto them, The sabbath was made for man, and not man for the sabbath:

Mar_2:28 Therefore the Son of man is Lord also of the sabbath.

<u>Mar_3:2</u> And they watched him, whether he would heal him on the sabbath day; that they might accuse him.

<u>Mar_3:4</u> And he saith unto them, Is it lawful to do good on the sabbath days, or to do evil? to save life, or to kill? But they held their peace.

<u>Mar_6:2</u> And when the sabbath day was come, he began to teach in the synagogue: and many hearing *him* were astonished, saying, From whence hath this *man* these things? and what wisdom *is* this which is given unto him, that even such mighty works are wrought by his hands?

<u>Mar_15:42</u> And now when the even was come, because it was the preparation, that is, the day before the sabbath,

<u>Mar_16:1</u> And when the sabbath was past, Mary Magdalene, and Mary the *mother* of James, and Salome, had bought sweet spices, that they might come and anoint him.

<u>Luk_4:16</u> And he came to Nazareth, where he had been brought up: and, as his custom was, he went into the synagogue on the sabbath day, and stood up for to read.

<u>Luk_4:31</u> And came down to Capernaum, a city of Galilee, and taught them on the sabbath days.

<u>Luk_6:1</u> And it came to pass on the second sabbath after the first, that he went through the corn fields; and his disciples plucked the ears of corn, and did eat, rubbing *them* in *their* hands.

<u>Luk_6:2</u> And certain of the Pharisees said unto them, Why do ye that which is not lawful to do on the sabbath days?

Luk_6:5 And he said unto them, That the Son of man is Lord also of the sabbath.

Luk_6:6 And it came to pass also on another sabbath, that he entered into the synagogue and taught: and there was a man whose right hand was withered.

<u>Luk_6:7</u> And the scribes and Pharisees watched him, whether he would heal on the sabbath day; that they might find an accusation against him.

<u>Luk_6:9</u> Then said Jesus unto them, I will ask you one thing; Is it lawful on the sabbath days to do good, or to do evil? to save life, or to destroy *it*?

Luk_13:10 And he was teaching in one of the synagogues on the sabbath.

Luk_13:14 And the ruler of the synagogue answered with indignation, because that Jesus had healed on the sabbath day, and said unto the people, There are six days in which men ought to work: in them therefore come and be healed, and not on the sabbath day.

Luk_13:15 The Lord then answered him, and said, *Thou* hypocrite, doth not each one of you on the sabbath loose his ox or *his* ass from the stall, and lead *him* away to watering?

Luk_13:16 And ought not this woman, being a daughter of Abraham, whom Satan hath bound, lo, these eighteen years, be loosed from this bond on the sabbath day?

Luk_14:1 And it came to pass, as he went into the house of one of the chief

Pharisees to eat bread on the sabbath day, that they watched him.

Luk_14:3 And Jesus answering spake unto the lawyers and Pharisees, saying, Is it lawful to heal on the sabbath day?

Luk_14:5 And answered them, saying, Which of you shall have an ass or an ox fallen into a pit, and will not straightway pull him out on the sabbath day?

Luk_23:54 And that day was the preparation, and the sabbath drew on.

Luk_23:56 And they returned, and prepared spices and ointments; and rested the sabbath day according to the commandment.

<u>Joh_5:9</u> And immediately the man was made whole, and took up his bed, and walked: and on the same day was the sabbath.

<u>Joh_5:10</u> The Jews therefore said unto him that was cured, It is the sabbath day: it is not lawful for thee to carry thy bed.

<u>Joh_5:16</u> And therefore did the Jews persecute Jesus, and sought to slay him, because he had done these things on the sabbath day.

<u>Joh_5:18</u> Therefore the Jews sought the more to kill him, because he not only had broken the sabbath, but said also that God was his Father, making himself equal with God.

<u>Joh_7:22</u> Moses therefore gave unto you circumcision; (not because it is of Moses, but of the fathers;) and ye on the sabbath day circumcise a man.

<u>Joh_7:23</u> If a man on the sabbath day receive circumcision, that the law of Moses should not be broken; are ye angry at me, because I have made a man every whit whole on the sabbath day?

<u>Joh_9:14</u> And it was the sabbath day when Jesus made the clay, and opened his eyes.

<u>Joh_9:16</u> Therefore said some of the Pharisees, This man is not of God, because he keepeth not the sabbath day. Others said, How can a man that is a sinner do such miracles? And there was a division among them.

<u>Joh_19:31</u> The Jews therefore, because it was the preparation, that the bodies should not remain upon the cross on the sabbath day, (for that sabbath day was an high day,) besought Pilate that their legs might be broken, and *that* they might be taken away.

<u>Act_1:12</u> Then returned they unto Jerusalem from the mount called Olivet, which is from Jerusalem a sabbath day's journey.

<u>Act_13:14</u> But when they departed from Perga, they came to Antioch in

Pisidia, and went into the synagogue on the sabbath day, and sat down.

<u>Act_13:27</u> For they that dwell at Jerusalem, and their rulers, because they knew him not, nor yet the voices of the prophets which are read every sabbath day, they have fulfilled *them* in condemning *him*.

<u>Act_13:42</u> And when the Jews were gone out of the synagogue, the Gentiles besought that these words might be preached to them the next sabbath.

<u>Act_13:44</u> And the next sabbath day came almost the whole city together to hear the word of God.

<u>Act_15:21</u> For Moses of old time hath in every city them that preach him, being read in the synagogues every sabbath day.

<u>Act_16:13</u> And on the sabbath we went out of the city by a river side, where prayer was wont to be made; and we sat down, and spake unto the women which resorted *thither*.

<u>Act_17:2</u> And Paul, as his manner was, went in unto them, and three sabbath days reasoned with them out of the scriptures,

<u>Act_18:4</u> And he reasoned in the synagogue every sabbath, and persuaded the Jews and the Greeks.
