## **SPIRIT**

- <u>Gen 1:2</u> And the earth was without form, and void; and darkness *was* upon the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters.
- <u>Gen\_6:3</u> And the LORD said, My spirit shall not always strive with man, for that he also *is* flesh: yet his days shall be an hundred and twenty years.
- <u>Gen\_41:8</u> And it came to pass in the morning that his spirit was troubled; and he sent and called for all the magicians of Egypt, and all the wise men thereof: and Pharaoh told them his dream; but *there was* none that could interpret them unto Pharaoh.
- <u>Gen 41:38</u> And Pharaoh said unto his servants, Can we find *such a one* as this *is,* a man in whom the Spirit of God *is?*
- <u>Gen\_45:27</u> And they told him all the words of Joseph, which he had said unto them: and when he saw the wagons which Joseph had sent to carry him, the spirit of Jacob their father revived:
- <u>Exo\_6:9</u> And Moses spake so unto the children of Israel: but they hearkened not unto Moses for anguish of spirit, and for cruel bondage.
- <u>Exo\_28:3</u> And thou shalt speak unto all *that are* wise hearted, whom I have filled with the spirit of wisdom, that they may make Aaron's garments to consecrate him, that he may minister unto me in the priest's office.
- Exo\_31:3 And I have filled him with the spirit of God, in wisdom, and in understanding, and in knowledge, and in all manner of workmanship,
- <u>Exo\_35:21</u> And they came, every one whose heart stirred him up, and every one whom his spirit made willing, *and* they brought the LORD'S offering to the work of the tabernacle of the congregation, and for all his service, and for the holy garments.
- <u>Exo\_35:31</u> And he hath filled him with the spirit of God, in wisdom, in understanding, and in knowledge, and in all manner of workmanship;
- <u>Lev\_20:27</u> A man also or woman that hath a familiar spirit, or that is a wizard, shall surely be put to death: they shall stone them with stones: their blood *shall be* upon them.
- <u>Num\_5:14</u> And the spirit of jealousy come upon him, and he be jealous of his wife, and she be defiled: or if the spirit of jealousy come upon him, and he be jealous of his wife, and she be not defiled:
- Num\_5:30 Or when the spirit of jealousy cometh upon him, and he be jealous over his wife, and shall set the woman before the LORD, and the priest shall execute upon her all this law.

- Num\_11:17 And I will come down and talk with thee there: and I will take of the spirit which *is* upon thee, and will put *it* upon them; and they shall bear the burden of the people with thee, that thou bear *it* not thyself alone.
- <u>Num\_11:25</u> And the LORD came down in a cloud, and spake unto him, and took of the spirit that *was* upon him, and gave *it* unto the seventy elders: and it came to pass, *that*, when the spirit rested upon them, they prophesied, and did not cease.
- Num\_11:26 But there remained two *of the* men in the camp, the name of the one *was* Eldad, and the name of the other Medad: and the spirit rested upon them; and they *were* of them that were written, but went not out unto the tabernacle: and they prophesied in the camp.
- Num\_11:29 And Moses said unto him, Enviest thou for my sake? would God that all the LORD'S people were prophets, *and* that the LORD would put his spirit upon them!
- Num\_14:24 But my servant Caleb, because he had another spirit with him, and hath followed me fully, him will I bring into the land whereinto he went; and his seed shall possess it.
- Num\_24:2 And Balaam lifted up his eyes, and he saw Israel abiding *in his tents* according to their tribes; and the spirit of God came upon him.
- Num 27:18 And the LORD said unto Moses, Take thee Joshua the son of Nun, a man in whom *is* the spirit, and lay thine hand upon him;
- <u>Deu\_2:30</u> But Sihon king of Heshbon would not let us pass by him: for the LORD thy God hardened his spirit, and made his heart obstinate, that he might deliver him into thy hand, as *appeareth* this day.
- <u>Deu\_34:9</u> And Joshua the son of Nun was full of the spirit of wisdom; for Moses had laid his hands upon him: and the children of Israel hearkened unto him, and did as the LORD commanded Moses.
- Jos\_5:1 And it came to pass, when all the kings of the Amorites, which were on the side of Jordan westward, and all the kings of the Canaanites, which were by the sea, heard that the LORD had dried up the waters of Jordan from before the children of Israel, until we were passed over, that their heart melted, neither was there spirit in them any more, because of the children of Israel.
- <u>Jdg\_3:10</u> And the Spirit of the LORD came upon him, and he judged Israel, and went out to war: and the LORD delivered Chushanrishathaim king of Mesopotamia into his hand; and his hand prevailed against Chushanrishathaim.
- <u>ldg\_6:34</u> But the Spirit of the LORD came upon Gideon, and he blew a trumpet; and Abiezer was gathered after him.

- <u>Jdg 9:23</u> Then God sent an evil spirit between Abimelech and the men of Shechem; and the men of Shechem dealt treacherously with Abimelech:
- <u>Jdg\_11:29</u> Then the Spirit of the LORD came upon Jephthah, and he passed over Gilead, and Manasseh, and passed over Mizpeh of Gilead, and from Mizpeh of Gilead he passed over *unto* the children of Ammon.
- <u>Jdg\_13:25</u> And the Spirit of the LORD began to move him at times in the camp of Dan between Zorah and Eshtaol.
- <u>Jdg\_14:6</u> And the Spirit of the LORD came mightily upon him, and he rent him as he would have rent a kid, and *he had* nothing in his hand: but he told not his father or his mother what he had done.
- <u>Jdg\_14:19</u> And the Spirit of the LORD came upon him, and he went down to Ashkelon, and slew thirty men of them, and took their spoil, and gave change of garments unto them which expounded the riddle. And his anger was kindled, and he went up to his father's house.
- <u>Jdg\_15:14</u> And when he came unto Lehi, the Philistines shouted against him: and the Spirit of the LORD came mightily upon him, and the cords that were upon his arms became as flax that was burnt with fire, and his bands loosed from off his hands.
- <u>Jdg\_15:19</u> But God clave an hollow place that *was* in the jaw, and there came water thereout; and when he had drunk, his spirit came again, and he revived: wherefore he called the name thereof Enhakkore, which *is* in Lehi unto this day.
- <u>1Sa\_1:15</u> And Hannah answered and said, No, my lord, I *am* a woman of a sorrowful spirit: I have drunk neither wine nor strong drink, but have poured out my soul before the LORD.
- <u>1Sa\_10:6</u> And the Spirit of the LORD will come upon thee, and thou shalt prophesy with them, and shalt be turned into another man.
- <u>1Sa\_10:10</u> And when they came thither to the hill, behold, a company of prophets met him; and the Spirit of God came upon him, and he prophesied among them.
- <u>1Sa\_11:6</u> And the Spirit of God came upon Saul when he heard those tidings, and his anger was kindled greatly.
- <u>1Sa\_16:13</u> Then Samuel took the horn of oil, and anointed him in the midst of his brethren: and the Spirit of the LORD came upon David from that day forward. So Samuel rose up, and went to Ramah.
- <u>1Sa\_16:14</u> But the Spirit of the LORD departed from Saul, and an evil spirit from the LORD troubled him.

- <u>1Sa\_16:15</u> And Saul's servants said unto him, Behold now, an evil spirit from God troubleth thee.
- <u>1Sa\_16:16</u> Let our lord now command thy servants, *which are* before thee, to seek out a man, *who is* a cunning player on an harp: and it shall come to pass, when the evil spirit from God is upon thee, that he shall play with his hand, and thou shalt be well.
- <u>1Sa\_16:23</u> And it came to pass, when the *evil* spirit from God was upon Saul, that David took an harp, and played with his hand: so Saul was refreshed, and was well, and the evil spirit departed from him.
- <u>1Sa</u> <u>18:10</u> And it came to pass on the morrow, that the evil spirit from God came upon Saul, and he prophesied in the midst of the house: and David played with his hand, as at other times: and *there was* a javelin in Saul's hand.
- 1Sa 19:9 And the evil spirit from the LORD was upon Saul, as he sat in his house with his javelin in his hand: and David played with his hand.
- <u>1Sa\_19:20</u> And Saul sent messengers to take David: and when they saw the company of the prophets prophesying, and Samuel standing *as* appointed over them, the Spirit of God was upon the messengers of Saul, and they also prophesied.
- <u>1Sa</u> <u>19:23</u> And he went thither to Naioth in Ramah: and the Spirit of God was upon him also, and he went on, and prophesied, until he came to Naioth in Ramah.
- <u>1Sa\_28:7</u> Then said Saul unto his servants, Seek me a woman that hath a familiar spirit, that I may go to her, and enquire of her. And his servants said to him, Behold, *there is* a woman that hath a familiar spirit at Endor.
- <u>1Sa\_28:8</u> And Saul disguised himself, and put on other raiment, and he went, and two men with him, and they came to the woman by night: and he said, I pray thee, divine unto me by the familiar spirit, and bring me *him* up, whom I shall name unto thee.
- <u>1Sa 30:12</u> And they gave him a piece of a cake of figs, and two clusters of raisins: and when he had eaten, his spirit came again to him: for he had eaten no bread, nor drunk *any* water, three days and three nights.
- 2Sa\_23:2 The Spirit of the LORD spake by me, and his word was in my tongue.
- <u>1Ki\_10:5</u> And the meat of his table, and the sitting of his servants, and the attendance of his ministers, and their apparel, and his cupbearers, and his ascent by which he went up unto the house of the LORD; there was no more spirit in her.

- <u>1Ki\_18:12</u> And it shall come to pass, as soon as I am gone from thee, that the Spirit of the LORD shall carry thee whither I know not; and so when I come and tell Ahab, and he cannot find thee, he shall slay me: but I thy servant fear the LORD from my youth.
- <u>1Ki\_21:5</u> But Jezebel his wife came to him, and said unto him, Why is thy spirit so sad, that thou eatest no bread?
- 1Ki\_22:21 And there came forth a spirit, and stood before the LORD, and said, I will persuade him.
- 1Ki 22:22 And the LORD said unto him, Wherewith? And he said, I will go forth, and I will be a lying spirit in the mouth of all his prophets. And he said, Thou shalt persuade

him, and prevail also: go forth, and do so.

- 1Ki\_22:23 Now therefore, behold, the LORD hath put a lying spirit in the mouth of all these thy prophets, and the LORD hath spoken evil concerning thee.
- <u>1Ki\_22:24</u> But Zedekiah the son of Chenaanah went near, and smote Micaiah on the cheek, and said, Which way went the Spirit of the LORD from me to speak unto thee?
- <u>2Ki 2:9</u> And it came to pass, when they were gone over, that Elijah said unto Elisha, Ask what I shall do for thee, before I be taken away from thee. And Elisha said, I pray thee, let a double portion of thy spirit be upon me.
- <u>2Ki\_2:15</u> And when the sons of the prophets which *were* to view at Jericho saw him, they said, The spirit of Elijah doth rest on Elisha. And they came to meet him, and bowed themselves to the ground before him.
- <u>2Ki\_2:16</u> And they said unto him, Behold now, there be with thy servants fifty strong men; let them go, we pray thee, and seek thy master: lest peradventure the Spirit of the LORD hath taken him up, and cast him upon some mountain, or into some valley. And he said, Ye shall not send.
- <u>1Ch\_5:26</u> And the God of Israel stirred up the spirit of Pul king of Assyria, and the spirit of Tilgathpilneser king of Assyria, and he carried them away, even the Reubenites, and the Gadites, and the half tribe of Manasseh, and brought them unto Halah, and Habor, and Hara, and to the river Gozan, unto this day.
- <u>1Ch\_10:13</u> So Saul died for his transgression which he committed against the LORD, *even* against the word of the LORD, which he kept not, and also for asking *counsel* of *one that had* a familiar spirit, to enquire *of it;*
- 1Ch\_12:18 Then the spirit came upon Amasai, who was chief of the captains,

- and he said, Thine are we, David, and on thy side, thou son of Jesse: peace, peace be unto thee, and peace be to thine helpers; for thy God helpeth thee. Then David received them, and made them captains of the band.
- <u>1Ch\_28:12</u> And the pattern of all that he had by the spirit, of the courts of the house of the LORD, and of all the chambers round about, of the treasuries of the house of God, and of the treasuries of the dedicated things:
- <u>2Ch\_9:4</u> And the meat of his table, and the sitting of his servants, and the attendance of his ministers, and their apparel; his cupbearers also, and their apparel; and his ascent by which he went up into the house of the LORD; there was no more spirit in her.
- 2Ch\_15:1 And the Spirit of God came upon Azariah the son of Oded:
- <u>2Ch\_18:20</u> Then there came out a spirit, and stood before the LORD, and said, I will entice him. And the LORD said unto him, Wherewith?
- <u>2Ch\_18:21</u> And he said, I will go out, and be a lying spirit in the mouth of all his prophets. And *the LORD* said, Thou shalt entice *him*, and thou shalt also prevail: go out, and do *even* so.
- 2Ch\_18:22 Now therefore, behold, the LORD hath put a lying spirit in the mouth of these thy prophets, and the LORD hath spoken evil against thee.
- <u>2Ch\_18:23</u> Then Zedekiah the son of Chenaanah came near, and smote Micaiah upon the cheek, and said, Which way went the Spirit of the LORD from me to speak unto thee?
- <u>2Ch\_20:14</u> Then upon Jahaziel the son of Zechariah, the son of Benaiah, the son of Jeiel, the son of Mattaniah, a Levite of the sons of Asaph, came the Spirit of the LORD in the midst of the congregation;
- <u>2Ch\_21:16</u> Moreover the LORD stirred up against Jehoram the spirit of the Philistines, and of the Arabians, that *were* near the Ethiopians:
- <u>2Ch\_24:20</u> And the Spirit of God came upon Zechariah the son of Jehoiada the priest, which stood above the people, and said unto them, Thus saith God, Why transgress ye the commandments of the LORD, that ye cannot prosper? because ye have forsaken the LORD, he hath also forsaken you.
- <u>2Ch\_33:6</u> And he caused his children to pass through the fire in the valley of the son of Hinnom: also he observed times, and used enchantments, and used witchcraft, and dealt with a familiar spirit, and with wizards: he wrought much evil in the sight of the LORD, to provoke him to anger.
- <u>2Ch\_36:22</u> Now in the first year of Cyrus king of Persia, that the word of the LORD *spoken* by the mouth of Jeremiah might be accomplished, the LORD

- stirred up the spirit of Cyrus king of Persia, that he made a proclamation throughout all his kingdom, and *put it* also in writing, saying,
- <u>Ezr\_1:1</u> Now in the first year of Cyrus king of Persia, that the word of the LORD by the mouth of Jeremiah might be fulfilled, the LORD stirred up the spirit of Cyrus king of Persia, that he made a proclamation throughout all his kingdom, and *put it* also in writing, saying,
- <u>Ezr\_1:5</u> Then rose up the chief of the fathers of Judah and Benjamin, and the priests, and the Levites, with all *them* whose spirit God had raised, to go up to build the house of the LORD which *is* in Jerusalem.
- Neh\_9:20 Thou gavest also thy good spirit to instruct them, and withheldest not thy manna from their mouth, and gavest them water for their thirst.
- <u>Neh\_9:30</u> Yet many years didst thou forbear them, and testifiedst against them by thy spirit in thy prophets: yet would they not give ear: therefore gavest thou them into the hand of the people of the lands.
- <u>Job\_4:15</u> Then a spirit passed before my face; the hair of my flesh stood up:
- <u>Job\_6:4</u> For the arrows of the Almighty *are* within me, the poison whereof drinketh up my spirit: the terrors of God do set themselves in array against me.
- <u>Job\_7:11</u> Therefore I will not refrain my mouth; I will speak in the anguish of my spirit; I will complain in the bitterness of my soul.
- <u>Job\_10:12</u> Thou hast granted me life and favour, and thy visitation hath preserved my spirit.
- <u>Job\_15:13</u> That thou turnest thy spirit against God, and lettest *such* words go out of thy mouth?
- <u>Job\_20:3</u> I have heard the check of my reproach, and the spirit of my understanding causeth me to answer.
- <u>Job\_21:4</u> As for me, *is* my complaint to man? and if *it were so,* why should not my spirit be troubled?
- <u>Job\_26:4</u> To whom hast thou uttered words? and whose spirit came from thee?
- <u>Job\_26:13</u> By his spirit he hath garnished the heavens; his hand hath formed the crooked serpent.
- <u>Job\_27:3</u> All the while my breath *is* in me, and the spirit of God *is* in my nostrils;

- <u>Job\_32:8</u> But *there is* a spirit in man: and the inspiration of the Almighty giveth them understanding.
- <u>Job\_32:18</u> For I am full of matter, the spirit within me constraineth me.
- <u>Job\_33:4</u> The Spirit of God hath made me, and the breath of the Almighty hath given me life.
- <u>Job\_34:14</u> If he set his heart upon man, *if* he gather unto himself his spirit and his breath;
- <u>Psa\_31:5</u> Into thine hand I commit my spirit: thou hast redeemed me, O LORD God of truth.
- <u>Psa\_32:2</u> Blessed *is* the man unto whom the LORD imputeth not iniquity, and in whose spirit *there is* no guile.
- <u>Psa\_34:18</u> The LORD *is* nigh unto them that are of a broken heart; and saveth such as be of a contrite spirit.
- <u>Psa\_51:10</u> Create in me a clean heart, O God; and renew a right spirit within me.
- <u>Psa\_51:11</u> Cast me not away from thy presence; and take not thy holy spirit from me.
- <u>Psa\_51:12</u> Restore unto me the joy of thy salvation; and uphold me *with thy* free spirit.
- <u>Psa\_51:17</u> The sacrifices of God *are* a broken spirit: a broken and a contrite heart, O God, thou wilt not despise.
- <u>Psa\_76:12</u> He shall cut off the spirit of princes: *he is* terrible to the kings of the earth.
- <u>Psa\_77:3</u> I remembered God, and was troubled: I complained, and my spirit was overwhelmed. Selah.
- <u>Psa\_77:6</u> I call to remembrance my song in the night: I commune with mine own heart: and my spirit made diligent search.
- <u>Psa\_78:8</u> And might not be as their fathers, a stubborn and rebellious generation; a generation *that* set not their heart aright, and whose spirit was not stedfast with God.
- <u>Psa\_104:30</u> Thou sendest forth thy spirit, they are created: and thou renewest the face of the earth.
- Psa\_106:33 Because they provoked his spirit, so that he spake unadvisedly

- with his lips.
- <u>Psa\_139:7</u> Whither shall I go from thy spirit? or whither shall I flee from thy presence?
- <u>Psa\_142:3</u> When my spirit was overwhelmed within me, then thou knewest my path. In the way wherein I walked have they privily laid a snare for me.
- <u>Psa\_143:4</u> Therefore is my spirit overwhelmed within me; my heart within me is desolate.
- <u>Psa\_143:7</u> Hear me speedily, O LORD: my spirit faileth: hide not thy face from me, lest I be like unto them that go down into the pit.
- $\underline{\text{Psa}}$  143:10 Teach me to do thy will; for thou art my God: thy spirit is good; lead me into the land of uprightness.
- <u>Pro\_1:23</u> Turn you at my reproof: behold, I will pour out my spirit unto you, I will make known my words unto you.
- <u>Pro\_11:13</u> A talebearer revealeth secrets: but he that is of a faithful spirit concealeth the matter.
- <u>Pro\_14:29</u> He that is slow to wrath is of great understanding: but he that is hasty of spirit exalteth folly.
- <u>Pro\_15:4</u> A wholesome tongue *is* a tree of life: but perverseness therein *is* a breach in the spirit.
- <u>Pro\_15:13</u> A merry heart maketh a cheerful countenance: but by sorrow of the heart the spirit is broken.
- Pro\_16:18 Pride goeth before destruction, and an haughty spirit before a fall.
- <u>Pro\_16:19</u> Better *it is to be* of an humble spirit with the lowly, than to divide the spoil with the proud.
- <u>Pro\_16:32</u> He that is slow to anger is better than the mighty; and he that ruleth his spirit than he that taketh a city.
- <u>Pro\_17:22</u> A merry heart doeth good *like* a medicine: but a broken spirit drieth the bones.
- <u>Pro\_17:27</u> He that hath knowledge spareth his words: *and* a man of understanding is of an excellent spirit.
- <u>Pro\_18:14</u> The spirit of a man will sustain his infirmity; but a wounded spirit who can bear?

- <u>Pro\_20:27</u> The spirit of man *is* the candle of the LORD, searching all the inward parts of the belly.
- <u>Pro\_25:28</u> He that *hath* no rule over his own spirit *is like* a city *that is* broken down, *and* without walls.
- <u>Pro\_29:23</u> A man's pride shall bring him low: but honour shall uphold the humble in spirit.
- Ecc\_1:14 I have seen all the works that are done under the sun; and, behold,
  all is vanity and vexation of

spirit.

- Ecc\_1:17 And I gave my heart to know wisdom, and to know madness and folly: I perceived that this also is vexation of spirit.
- <u>Ecc\_2:11</u> Then I looked on all the works that my hands had wrought, and on the labour that I had laboured to do: and, behold, all *was* vanity and vexation of spirit, and *there was* no profit under the sun.
- <u>Ecc\_2:17</u> Therefore I hated life; because the work that is wrought under the sun *is* grievous unto me: for all *is* vanity and vexation of spirit.
- <u>Ecc\_2:26</u> For *God* giveth to a man that *is* good in his sight wisdom, and knowledge, and joy: but to the sinner he giveth travail, to gather and to heap up, that he may give to *him that is* good before God. This also *is* vanity and vexation of spirit.
- <u>Ecc\_3:21</u> Who knoweth the spirit of man that goeth upward, and the spirit of the beast that goeth downward to the earth?
- Ecc\_4:4 Again, I considered all travail, and every right work, that for this a man is envied of his neighbour. This is also vanity and vexation of spirit.
- <u>Ecc\_4:6</u> Better *is* an handful *with* quietness, than both the hands full *with* travail and vexation of spirit.
- <u>Ecc\_4:16</u> There is no end of all the people, even of all that have been before them: they also that come after shall not rejoice in him. Surely this also is vanity and vexation of spirit.
- <u>Ecc\_6:9</u> Better *is* the sight of the eyes than the wandering of the desire: this *is* also vanity and vexation of spirit.
- <u>Ecc\_7:8</u> Better *is* the end of a thing than the beginning thereof: *and* the patient in spirit *is* better than the proud in spirit.
- Ecc\_7:9 Be not hasty in thy spirit to be angry: for anger resteth in the bosom

of fools.

- <u>Ecc\_8:8</u> There is no man that hath power over the spirit to retain the spirit; neither hath he power in the day of death: and there is no discharge in that war; neither shall wickedness deliver those that are given to it.
- <u>Ecc\_10:4</u> If the spirit of the ruler rise up against thee, leave not thy place; for yielding pacifieth great offences.
- <u>Ecc\_11:5</u> As thou knowest not what *is* the way of the spirit, *nor* how the bones *do grow* in the womb of her that is with child: even so thou knowest not the works of God who maketh all.
- <u>Ecc\_12:7</u> Then shall the dust return to the earth as it was: and the spirit shall return unto God who gave it.
- <u>Isa\_4:4</u> When the Lord shall have washed away the filth of the daughters of Zion, and shall have purged the blood of Jerusalem from the midst thereof by the spirit of judgment, and by the spirit of burning.
- <u>Isa\_11:2</u> And the spirit of the LORD shall rest upon him, the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the LORD;
- <u>Isa\_19:3</u> And the spirit of Egypt shall fail in the midst thereof; and I will destroy the counsel thereof: and they shall seek to the idols, and to the charmers, and to them that have familiar spirits, and to the wizards.
- <u>Isa\_19:14</u> The LORD hath mingled a perverse spirit in the midst thereof: and they have caused Egypt to err in every work thereof, as a drunken *man* staggereth in his vomit.
- <u>Isa\_26:9</u> With my soul have I desired thee in the night; yea, with my spirit within me will I seek thee early: for when thy judgments *are* in the earth, the inhabitants of the world will learn righteousness.
- <u>Isa\_28:6</u> And for a spirit of judgment to him that sitteth in judgment, and for strength to them that turn the battle to the gate.
- <u>Isa 29:4</u> And thou shalt be brought down, *and* shalt speak out of the ground, and thy speech shall be low out of the dust, and thy voice shall be, as of one that hath a familiar spirit, out of the ground, and thy speech shall whisper out of the dust.
- <u>Isa\_29:10</u> For the LORD hath poured out upon you the spirit of deep sleep, and hath closed your eyes: the prophets and your rulers, the seers hath he covered.

- <u>Isa\_29:24</u> They also that erred in spirit shall come to understanding, and they that murmured shall learn doctrine.
- <u>Isa\_30:1</u> Woe to the rebellious children, saith the LORD, that take counsel, but not of me; and that cover with a covering, but not of my spirit, that they may add sin to sin:
- <u>Isa\_31:3</u> Now the Egyptians *are* men, and not God; and their horses flesh, and not spirit. When the LORD shall stretch out his hand, both he that helpeth shall fall, and he that is holpen shall fall down, and they all shall fail together.
- <u>Isa 32:15</u> Until the spirit be poured upon us from on high, and the wilderness be a fruitful field, and the fruitful field be counted for a forest.
- <u>Isa\_34:16</u> Seek ye out of the book of the LORD, and read: no one of these shall fail, none shall want her mate: for my mouth it hath commanded, and his spirit it hath gathered them.
- <u>Isa\_38:16</u> O Lord, by these *things men* live, and in all these *things is* the life of my spirit: so wilt thou recover me, and make me to live.
- <u>Isa\_40:7</u> The grass withereth, the flower fadeth: because the spirit of the LORD bloweth upon it: surely the people *is* grass.
- <u>Isa\_40:13</u> Who hath directed the Spirit of the LORD, or *being* his counsellor hath taught him?
- <u>Isa\_42:1</u> Behold my servant, whom I uphold; mine elect, *in whom* my soul delighteth; I have put my spirit upon him: he shall bring forth judgment to the Gentiles.
- <u>Isa\_42:5</u> Thus saith God the LORD, he that created the heavens, and stretched them out; he that spread forth the earth, and that which cometh out of it; he that giveth breath unto the people upon it, and spirit to them that walk therein:
- <u>Isa\_44:3</u> For I will pour water upon him that is thirsty, and floods upon the dry ground: I will pour my spirit upon thy seed, and my blessing upon thine offspring:
- <u>Isa\_48:16</u> Come ye near unto me, hear ye this; I have not spoken in secret from the beginning; from the time that it was, there *am* I: and now the Lord GOD, and his Spirit, hath sent me.
- <u>Isa\_54:6</u> For the LORD hath called thee as a woman forsaken and grieved in spirit, and a wife of youth, when thou wast refused, saith thy God.
- <u>Isa\_57:15</u> For thus saith the high and lofty One that inhabiteth eternity, whose

- name *is* Holy; I dwell in the high and holy *place*, with him also *that is* of a contrite and humble spirit, to revive the spirit of the humble, and to revive the heart of the contrite ones.
- <u>Isa\_57:16</u> For I will not contend for ever, neither will I be always wroth: for the spirit should fail before me, and the souls *which* I have made.
- <u>Isa\_59:19</u> So shall they fear the name of the LORD from the west, and his glory from the rising of the sun. When the enemy shall come in like a flood, the Spirit of the LORD shall lift up a standard against him.
- <u>Isa\_59:21</u> As for me, this *is* my covenant with them, saith the LORD; My spirit that *is* upon thee, and my words which I have put in thy mouth, shall not depart out of thy mouth, nor out of the mouth of thy seed, nor out of the mouth of thy seed's seed, saith the LORD, from henceforth and for ever.
- <u>Isa\_61:1</u> The Spirit of the Lord GOD *is* upon me; because the LORD hath anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek; he hath sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to *them that are* bound;
- <u>Isa\_61:3</u> To appoint unto them that mourn in Zion, to give unto them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; that they might be called trees of righteousness, the planting of the LORD, that he might be glorified.
- <u>Isa\_63:10</u> But they rebelled, and vexed his holy Spirit: therefore he was turned to be their enemy, *and* he fought against them.
- <u>Isa\_63:11</u> Then he remembered the days of old, Moses, *and* his people, saying, Where *is* he that brought them up out of the sea with the shepherd of his flock? where *is* he that put his holy Spirit within him?
- <u>Isa\_63:14</u> As a beast goeth down into the valley, the Spirit of the LORD caused him to rest: so didst thou lead thy people, to make thyself a glorious name.
- <u>Isa\_65:14</u> Behold, my servants shall sing for joy of heart, but ye shall cry for sorrow of heart, and shall howl for vexation of spirit.
- <u>Isa\_66:2</u> For all those *things* hath mine hand made, and all those *things* have been, saith the LORD: but to this *man* will I look, *even* to *him that is* poor and of a contrite spirit, and trembleth at my word.
- <u>Jer\_51:11</u> Make bright the arrows; gather the shields: the LORD hath raised up the spirit of the kings of the Medes: for his device *is* against Babylon, to destroy it; because it *is* the vengeance of the LORD, the vengeance of his temple.

- <u>Eze\_1:12</u> And they went every one straight forward: whither the spirit was to go, they went; *and* they turned not when they went.
- <u>Eze\_1:20</u> Whithersoever the spirit was to go, they went, thither was their spirit to go; and the wheels were lifted up over against them: for the spirit of the living creature was in the wheels.
- <u>Eze\_1:21</u> When those went, *these* went; and when those stood, *these* stood; and when those were lifted up from the earth, the wheels were lifted up over against them: for the spirit of the living creature *was* in the wheels.
- <u>Eze\_2:2</u> And the spirit entered into me when he spake unto me, and set me upon my feet, that I heard him that spake unto me.
- <u>Eze\_3:12</u> Then the spirit took me up, and I heard behind me a voice of a great rushing, saying, Blessed be the glory of the LORD from his place.
- <u>Eze\_3:14</u> So the spirit lifted me up, and took me away, and I went in bitterness, in the heat of my spirit; but the hand of the LORD was strong upon me.
- <u>Eze\_3:24</u> Then the spirit entered into me, and set me upon my feet, and spake with me, and said unto me, Go, shut thyself within thine house.
- <u>Eze\_8:3</u> And he put forth the form of an hand, and took me by a lock of mine head; and the spirit lifted me up between the earth and the heaven, and brought me in the visions of God to Jerusalem, to the door of the inner gate that looketh toward the north; where *was* the seat of the image of jealousy, which provoketh to jealousy.
- <u>Eze\_10:17</u> When they stood, *these* stood; and when they were lifted up, *these* lifted up themselves *also:* for the

spirit of the living creature was in them.

- <u>Eze\_11:1</u> Moreover the spirit lifted me up, and brought me unto the east gate of the LORD'S house, which looketh eastward: and behold at the door of the gate five and twenty men; among whom I saw Jaazaniah the son of Azur, and Pelatiah the son of Benaiah, princes of the people.
- <u>Eze\_11:5</u> And the Spirit of the LORD fell upon me, and said unto me, Speak; Thus saith the LORD; Thus have ye said, O house of Israel: for I know the things that come into your mind, *every one of* them.
- <u>Eze\_11:19</u> And I will give them one heart, and I will put a new spirit within you; and I will take the stony heart out of their flesh, and will give them an heart of flesh:

- <u>Eze\_11:24</u> Afterwards the spirit took me up, and brought me in a vision by the Spirit of God into Chaldea, to them of the captivity. So the vision that I had seen went up from me.
- <u>Eze\_13:3</u> Thus saith the Lord GOD; Woe unto the foolish prophets, that follow their own spirit, and have seen nothing!
- <u>Eze\_18:31</u> Cast away from you all your transgressions, whereby ye have transgressed; and make you a new heart and a new spirit: for why will ye die, O house of Israel?
- <u>Eze\_21:7</u> And it shall be, when they say unto thee, Wherefore sighest thou? that thou shalt answer, For the tidings; because it cometh: and every heart shall melt, and all hands shall be feeble, and every spirit shall faint, and all knees shall be weak *as* water: behold, it cometh, and shall be brought to pass, saith the Lord GOD.
- <u>Eze\_36:26</u> A new heart also will I give you, and a new spirit will I put within you: and I will take away the stony heart out of your flesh, and I will give you an heart of flesh.
- <u>Eze\_36:27</u> And I will put my spirit within you, and cause you to walk in my statutes, and ye shall keep my judgments, and do *them*.
- <u>Eze\_37:1</u> The hand of the LORD was upon me, and carried me out in the spirit of the LORD, and set me down in the midst of the valley which was full of bones,
- <u>Eze\_37:14</u> And shall put my spirit in you, and ye shall live, and I shall place you in your own land: then shall ye know that I the LORD have spoken *it*, and performed *it*, saith the LORD.
- <u>Eze\_39:29</u> Neither will I hide my face any more from them: for I have poured out my spirit upon the house of Israel, saith the Lord GOD.
- <u>Eze\_43:5</u> So the spirit took me up, and brought me into the inner court; and, behold, the glory of the LORD filled the house.
- <u>Dan 2:1</u> And in the second year of the reign of Nebuchadnezzar Nebuchadnezzar dreamed dreams, wherewith his spirit was troubled, and his sleep brake from him.
- <u>Dan\_2:3</u> And the king said unto them, I have dreamed a dream, and my spirit was troubled to know the dream.
- <u>Dan\_4:8</u> But at the last Daniel came in before me, whose name was Belteshazzar, according to the name of my god, and in whom is the spirit of the holy gods: and before him I told the dream, saying,

- <u>Dan\_4:9</u> O Belteshazzar, master of the magicians, because I know that the spirit of the holy gods *is* in thee, and no secret troubleth thee, tell me the visions of my dream that I have seen, and the interpretation thereof.
- <u>Dan\_4:18</u> This dream I king Nebuchadnezzar have seen. Now thou, O Belteshazzar, declare the interpretation thereof, forasmuch as all the wise *men* of my kingdom are not able to make known unto me the interpretation: but thou *art* able; for the spirit of the holy gods *is* in thee.
- <u>Dan\_5:11</u> There is a man in thy kingdom, in whom *is* the spirit of the holy gods; and in the days of thy father light and understanding and wisdom, like the wisdom of the gods, was found in him; whom the king Nebuchadnezzar thy father, the king, *I say*, thy father, made master of the magicians, astrologers, Chaldeans, *and* soothsayers;
- <u>Dan\_5:12</u> Forasmuch as an excellent spirit, and knowledge, and understanding, interpreting of dreams, and shewing of hard sentences, and dissolving of doubts, were found in the same Daniel, whom the king named Belteshazzar: now let Daniel be called, and he will shew the interpretation.
- <u>Dan\_5:14</u> I have even heard of thee, that the spirit of the gods *is* in thee, and *that* light and understanding and excellent wisdom is found in thee.
- <u>Dan 6:3</u> Then this Daniel was preferred above the presidents and princes, because an excellent spirit *was* in him; and the king thought to set him over the whole realm.
- $\underline{\text{Dan}}_{7:15}$  I Daniel was grieved in my spirit in the midst of my body, and the visions of my head troubled me.
- <u>Hos\_4:12</u> My people ask counsel at their stocks, and their staff declareth unto them: for the spirit of whoredoms hath caused *them* to err, and they have gone a whoring from under their God.
- <u>Hos\_5:4</u> They will not frame their doings to turn unto their God: for the spirit of whoredoms *is* in the midst of them, and they have not known the LORD.
- <u>Joe\_2:28</u> And it shall come to pass afterward, *that* I will pour out my spirit upon all flesh; and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your old men shall dream dreams, your young men shall see visions:
- <u>Joe\_2:29</u> And also upon the servants and upon the handmaids in those days will I pour out my spirit.
- Mic\_2:7 O thou that art named the house of Jacob, is the spirit of the LORD straitened? are these his doings? do not my words do good to him that walketh uprightly?

- Mic\_2:11 If a man walking in the spirit and falsehood do lie, saying, I will prophesy unto thee of wine and of strong drink; he shall even be the prophet of this people.
- <u>Mic\_3:8</u> But truly I am full of power by the spirit of the LORD, and of judgment, and of might, to declare unto Jacob his transgression, and to Israel his sin.
- <u>Hag\_1:14</u> And the LORD stirred up the spirit of Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel, governor of Judah, and the spirit of Joshua the son of Josedech, the high priest, and the spirit of all the remnant of the people; and they came and did work in the house of the LORD of hosts, their God,
- <u>Hag 2:5</u> According to the word that I covenanted with you when ye came out of Egypt, so my spirit remaineth among you: fear ye not.
- <u>Zec\_4:6</u> Then he answered and spake unto me, saying, This *is* the word of the LORD unto Zerubbabel, saying, Not by might, nor by power, but by my spirit, saith the LORD of hosts.
- <u>Zec\_6:8</u> Then cried he upon me, and spake unto me, saying, Behold, these that go toward the north country have quieted my spirit in the north country.
- Zec\_7:12 Yea, they made their hearts as an adamant stone, lest they should hear the law, and the words which the LORD of hosts hath sent in his spirit by the former prophets: therefore came a great wrath from the LORD of hosts.
- <u>Zec\_12:1</u> The burden of the word of the LORD for Israel, saith the LORD, which stretcheth forth the heavens, and layeth the foundation of the earth, and formeth the spirit of man within him.
- <u>Zec\_12:10</u> And I will pour upon the house of David, and upon the inhabitants of Jerusalem, the spirit of grace and of supplications: and they shall look upon me whom they have pierced, and they shall mourn for him, as one mourneth for *his* only *son*, and shall be in bitterness for him, as one that is in bitterness for *his* firstborn.
- Zec\_13:2 And it shall come to pass in that day, saith the LORD of hosts, that I will cut off the names of the idols out of the land, and they shall no more be remembered: and also I will cause the prophets and the unclean spirit to pass out of the land.
- Mal\_2:15 And did not he make one? Yet had he the residue of the spirit. And wherefore one? That he might seek a godly seed. Therefore take heed to your spirit, and let none deal treacherously against the wife of his youth.
- <u>Mal\_2:16</u> For the LORD, the God of Israel, saith that he hateth putting away: for *one* covereth violence with his garment, saith the LORD of hosts: therefore

- take heed to your spirit, that ye deal not treacherously.
- Mat\_3:16 And Jesus, when he was baptized, went up straightway out of the water: and, lo, the heavens were opened unto him, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove, and lighting upon him:
- <u>Mat\_4:1</u> Then was Jesus led up of the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted of the devil.
- <u>Mat\_5:3</u> Blessed *are* the poor in spirit: for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.
- <u>Mat\_10:20</u> For it is not ye that speak, but the Spirit of your Father which speaketh in you.
- Mat 12:18 Behold my servant, whom I have chosen; my beloved, in whom my soul is well pleased: I will put my spirit upon him, and he shall shew judgment to the Gentiles.
- Mat\_12:28 But if I cast out devils by the Spirit of God, then the kingdom of God is come unto you.
- Mat\_12:43 When the unclean spirit is gone out of a man, he walketh through dry places, seeking rest, and findeth none.
- <u>Mat\_14:26</u> And when the disciples saw him walking on the sea, they were troubled, saying, It is a spirit; and they cried out for fear.
- Mat 22:43 He saith unto them, How then doth David in spirit call him Lord, saying,
- Mat 26:41 Watch and pray, that ye enter not into temptation: the spirit indeed *is* willing, but the flesh *is* weak.
- Mar\_1:10 And straightway coming up out of the water, he saw the heavens opened, and the Spirit like a dove descending upon him:
- Mar\_1:12 And immediately the Spirit driveth him into the wilderness.
- Mar\_1:23 And there was in their synagogue a man with an unclean spirit; and he cried out,
- Mar\_1:26 And when the unclean spirit had torn him, and cried with a loud voice, he came out of him.
- <u>Mar\_2:8</u> And immediately when Jesus perceived in his spirit that they so reasoned within themselves, he said unto them, Why reason ye these things in your hearts?
- Mar\_3:30 Because they said, He hath an unclean spirit.

- Mar\_5:2 And when he was come out of the ship, immediately there met him out of the tombs a man with an unclean spirit,
- Mar\_5:8 For he said unto him, Come out of the man, thou unclean spirit.
- Mar\_6:49 But when they saw him walking upon the sea, they supposed it had been a spirit, and cried out:
- Mar\_7:25 For a *certain* woman, whose young daughter had an unclean spirit, heard of him, and came and fell at his feet:
- Mar\_8:12 And he sighed deeply in his
- spirit, and saith, Why doth this generation seek after a sign? verily I say unto you, There shall no sign be given unto this generation.
- Mar\_9:17 And one of the multitude answered and said, Master, I have brought unto thee my son, which hath a dumb spirit;
- Mar\_9:20 And they brought him unto him: and when he saw him, straightway the spirit tare him; and he fell on the ground, and wallowed foaming.
- Mar\_9:25 When Jesus saw that the people came running together, he rebuked the foul spirit, saying unto him, *Thou* dumb and deaf spirit, I charge thee, come out of him, and enter no more into him.
- Mar\_9:26 And the spirit cried, and rent him sore, and came out of him: and he was as one dead; insomuch that many said, He is dead.
- Mar\_14:38 Watch ye and pray, lest ye enter into temptation. The spirit truly *is* ready, but the flesh *is* weak.
- <u>Luk 1:17</u> And he shall go before him in the spirit and power of Elias, to turn the hearts of the fathers to the children, and the disobedient to the wisdom of the just; to make ready a people prepared for the Lord.
- <u>Luk\_1:47</u> And my spirit hath rejoiced in God my Saviour.
- <u>Luk\_1:80</u> And the child grew, and waxed strong in spirit, and was in the deserts till the day of his shewing unto Israel.
- <u>Luk\_2:27</u> And he came by the Spirit into the temple: and when the parents brought in the child Jesus, to do for him after the custom of the law,
- <u>Luk\_2:40</u> And the child grew, and waxed strong in spirit, filled with wisdom: and the grace of God was upon him.
- $\underline{\text{Luk}}$  4:1 And Jesus being full of the Holy Ghost returned from Jordan, and was led by the Spirit into the wilderness,

- <u>Luk\_4:14</u> And Jesus returned in the power of the Spirit into Galilee: and there went out a fame of him through all the region round about.
- <u>Luk\_4:18</u> The Spirit of the Lord *is* upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised,
- <u>Luk\_4:33</u> And in the synagogue there was a man, which had a spirit of an unclean devil, and cried out with a loud voice,
- <u>Luk 8:29</u> (For he had commanded the unclean spirit to come out of the man. For oftentimes it had caught him: and he was kept bound with chains and in fetters; and he brake the bands, and was driven of the devil into the wilderness.)
- <u>Luk\_8:55</u> And her spirit came again, and she arose straightway: and he commanded to give her meat.
- <u>Luk\_9:39</u> And, lo, a spirit taketh him, and he suddenly crieth out; and it teareth him that he foameth again, and bruising him hardly departeth from him.
- <u>Luk\_9:42</u> And as he was yet a coming, the devil threw him down, and tare *him.* And Jesus rebuked the unclean spirit, and healed the child, and delivered him again to his father.
- <u>Luk\_9:55</u> But he turned, and rebuked them, and said, Ye know not what manner of spirit ye are of.
- <u>Luk\_10:21</u> In that hour Jesus rejoiced in spirit, and said, I thank thee, O Father, Lord of heaven and earth, that thou hast hid these things from the wise and prudent, and hast revealed them unto babes: even so, Father; for so it seemed good in thy sight.
- <u>Luk\_11:13</u> If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children: how much more shall *your* heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to them that ask him?
- <u>Luk\_11:24</u> When the unclean spirit is gone out of a man, he walketh through dry places, seeking rest; and finding none, he saith, I will return unto my house whence I came out.
- <u>Luk\_13:11</u> And, behold, there was a woman which had a spirit of infirmity eighteen years, and was bowed together, and could in no wise lift up *herself*.
- <u>Luk\_23:46</u> And when Jesus had cried with a loud voice, he said, <u>Father</u>, into thy hands I commend my spirit: and having said thus, he gave up the ghost.

- <u>Luk\_24:37</u> But they were terrified and affrighted, and supposed that they had seen a spirit.
- <u>Luk 24:39</u> Behold my hands and my feet, that it is I myself: handle me, and see; for a spirit hath not flesh and bones, as ye see me have.
- <u>Joh\_1:32</u> And John bare record, saying, I saw the Spirit descending from heaven like a dove, and it abode upon him.
- Joh\_1:33 And I knew him not: but he that sent me to baptize with water, the same said unto me, Upon whom thou shalt see the Spirit descending, and remaining on him, the same is he which baptizeth with the Holy Ghost.
- <u>Joh\_3:5</u> Jesus answered, Verily, Verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and *of* the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God.
- <u>Joh\_3:6</u> That which is born of the flesh is flesh; and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit.
- <u>Joh\_3:8</u> The wind bloweth where it listeth, and thou hearest the sound thereof, but canst not tell whence it cometh, and whither it goeth: so is every one that is born of the Spirit.
- <u>Joh\_3:34</u> For he whom God hath sent speaketh the words of God: for God giveth not the Spirit by measure *unto him.*
- <u>Joh\_4:23</u> But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth: for the Father seeketh such to worship him.
- <u>Joh\_4:24</u> God *is* a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship *him* in spirit and in truth.
- <u>Joh\_6:63</u> It is the spirit that quickeneth; the flesh profiteth nothing: the words that I speak unto you, *they* are spirit, and *they* are life.
- <u>Joh\_7:39</u> (But this spake he of the Spirit, which they that believe on him should receive: for the Holy Ghost was not yet *given*; because that Jesus was not yet glorified.)
- <u>Joh\_11:33</u> When Jesus therefore saw her weeping, and the Jews also weeping which came with her, he groaned in the spirit, and was troubled,
- <u>Joh\_13:21</u> When Jesus had thus said, he was troubled in spirit, and testified, and said, Verily, verily, I say unto you, that one of you shall betray me.
- <u>Joh\_14:17</u> Even the Spirit of truth; whom the world cannot receive, because it seeth him not, neither knoweth him: but ye know him; for he dwelleth with you, and shall be in you.

- <u>Joh\_15:26</u> But when the Comforter is come, whom I will send unto you from the Father, *even* the Spirit of truth, which proceedeth from the Father, he shall testify of me:
- <u>Joh\_16:13</u> Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, *that* shall he speak: and he will shew you things to come.
- Act\_2:4 And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.
- Act 2:17 And it shall come to pass in the last days, saith God, I will pour out of my Spirit upon all flesh: and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams:
- Act\_2:18 And on my servants and on my handmaidens I will pour out in those days of my Spirit; and they shall prophesy:
- <u>Act\_5:9</u> Then Peter said unto her, How is it that ye have agreed together to tempt the Spirit of the Lord? behold, the feet of them which have buried thy husband *are* at the door, and shall carry thee out.
- Act\_6:10 And they were not able to resist the wisdom and the spirit by which he spake.
- Act\_7:59 And they stoned Stephen, calling upon *God*, and saying, Lord Jesus, receive my spirit.
- Act\_8:29 Then the Spirit said unto Philip, Go near, and join thyself to this chariot.
- Act\_8:39 And when they were come up out of the water, the Spirit of the Lord caught away Philip, that the eunuch saw him no more: and he went on his way rejoicing.
- <u>Act\_10:19</u> While Peter thought on the vision, the Spirit said unto him, Behold, three men seek thee.
- <u>Act\_11:12</u> And the Spirit bade me go with them, nothing doubting. Moreover these six brethren accompanied me, and we entered into the man's house:
- Act\_11:28 And there stood up one of them named Agabus, and signified by the Spirit that there should be great dearth throughout all the world: which came to pass in the days of Claudius Caesar.
- <u>Act\_16:7</u> After they were come to Mysia, they assayed to go into Bithynia: but the Spirit suffered them not.
- Act\_16:16 And it came to pass, as we went to prayer, a certain damsel

- possessed with a spirit of divination met us, which brought her masters much gain by soothsaying:
- <u>Act\_16:18</u> And this did she many days. But Paul, being grieved, turned and said to the spirit, I command thee in the name of Jesus Christ to come out of her. And he came out the same hour.
- Act\_17:16 Now while Paul waited for them at Athens, his spirit was stirred in him, when he saw the city wholly given to idolatry.
- <u>Act\_18:5</u> And when Silas and Timotheus were come from Macedonia, Paul was pressed in the spirit, and testified to the Jews *that* Jesus *was* Christ.
- Act\_18:25 This man was instructed in the way of the Lord; and being fervent in the spirit, he spake and taught diligently the things of the Lord, knowing only the baptism of John.
- Act\_19:15 And the evil spirit answered and said, Jesus I know, and Paul I know; but who are ye?
- Act\_19:16 And the man in whom the evil spirit was leaped on them, and overcame them, and prevailed against them, so that they fled out of that house naked and wounded.
- <u>Act\_19:21</u> After these things were ended, Paul purposed in the spirit, when he had passed through Macedonia and Achaia, to go to Jerusalem, saying, After I have been there, I must also see Rome.
- Act 20:22 And now, behold, I go bound in the spirit unto Jerusalem, not knowing the things that shall befall me there:
- Act\_21:4 And finding disciples, we tarried there seven days: who said to Paul through the Spirit, that he should not go up to Jerusalem.
- <u>Act\_23:8</u> For the Sadducees say that there is no resurrection, neither angel, nor spirit: but the Pharisees confess both.
- Act\_23:9 And there arose a great cry: and the scribes *that were* of the Pharisees' part arose, and strove, saying, We find no evil in this man: but if a spirit or an angel hath spoken to him, let us not fight against God.
- <u>Rom\_1:4</u> And declared *to be* the Son of God with power, according to the spirit of holiness, by the resurrection from the dead:
- <u>Rom\_1:9</u> For God is my witness, whom I serve with my spirit in the gospel of his Son, that without ceasing I make mention of you always in my prayers;
- Rom\_2:29 But he *is* a Jew, which is one inwardly; and circumcision *is that* of the heart, in the spirit, *and* not in the letter; whose praise *is* not of men, but of

God.

- Rom\_7:6 But now we are delivered from the law, that being dead wherein we were held; that we should serve in newness of spirit, and not *in* the oldness of the letter.
- <u>Rom\_8:1</u> There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.
- <u>Rom\_8:2</u> For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death.
- Rom\_8:4 That the righteousness of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.
- Rom\_8:5 For they that are after the flesh do mind the things of the flesh; but they that are after the Spirit the things of the Spirit.
- Rom\_8:9 But ye are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit, if so be that the Spirit of God dwell in you. Now if any man have not the Spirit of Christ, he is none of his.
- Rom\_8:10 And if Christ *be* in you, the body *is* dead because of sin; but the Spirit *is* life because of righteousness.
- Rom\_8:11 But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you.
- Rom\_8:13 For if ye live after the flesh, ye shall die: but if ye through the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body, ye shall live.
- Rom\_8:14 For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God.
- <u>Rom\_8:15</u> For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but ye have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father.
- <u>Rom\_8:16</u> The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God:
- <u>Rom\_8:23</u> And not only *they*, but ourselves also, which have the firstfruits of the Spirit, even we ourselves groan within ourselves, waiting for the adoption, *to wit*, the redemption of our body.
- <u>Rom\_8:26</u> Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered.

- Rom\_8:27 And he that searcheth the hearts knoweth what *is* the mind of the Spirit, because he maketh intercession for the saints according to *the will of* God.
- Rom\_11:8 (According as it is written, God hath given them the spirit of slumber, eyes that they should not see, and ears that they should not hear;) unto this day.
- Rom 12:11 Not slothful in business; fervent in spirit; serving the Lord;
- Rom\_15:19 Through mighty signs and wonders, by the power of the Spirit of God; so that from Jerusalem, and round about unto Illyricum, I have fully preached the gospel of Christ.
- Rom\_15:30 Now I beseech you, brethren, for the Lord Jesus Christ's sake, and for the love of the Spirit, that ye strive together with me in *your* prayers to God for me;
- 1Co\_2:4 And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power:
- 1Co\_2:10 But God hath revealed *them* unto us by his Spirit: for the Spirit searcheth all things, yea, the deep things of God.
- 1Co\_2:11 For what man knoweth the things of a man, save the spirit of man which is in him? even so the things of God knoweth no man, but the Spirit of God.
- 1Co\_2:12 Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the spirit which is of God; that we might know the things that are freely given to us of God.
- <u>1Co\_2:14</u> But the natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of God: for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know *them,* because they are spiritually discerned.
- 1Co\_3:16 Know ye not that ye are the temple of God, and *that* the Spirit of God dwelleth in you?
- 1Co\_4:21 What will ye? shall I come unto you with a rod, or in love, and *in* the spirit of meekness?
- 1Co\_5:3 For I verily, as absent in body, but present in spirit, have judged already, as though I were present, concerning him that hath so done this deed,
- 1Co\_5:4 In the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, when ye are gathered together, and my spirit, with the power of our Lord Jesus Christ,
- 1Co\_5:5 To deliver such an one unto Satan for the destruction of the flesh,

- that the spirit may be saved in the day of the Lord Jesus.
- <u>1Co\_6:11</u> And such were some of you: but ye are washed, but ye are sanctified, but ye are justified in the name of the Lord Jesus, and by the Spirit of our God.
- 1Co 6:17 But he that is joined unto the Lord is one spirit.
- 1Co\_6:20 For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's.
- <u>1Co\_7:34</u> There is difference *also* between a wife and a virgin. The unmarried woman careth for the things of the Lord, that she may be holy both in body and in spirit: but she that is married careth for the things of the world, how she may please *her* husband.
- 1Co\_7:40 But she is happier if she so abide, after my judgment: and I think also that I have the Spirit of God.
- <u>1Co\_12:3</u> Wherefore I give you to understand, that no man speaking by the Spirit of God calleth Jesus accursed: and *that* no man can say that Jesus is the Lord, but by the Holy Ghost.
- 1Co\_12:4 Now there are diversities of gifts, but the same Spirit.
- 1Co\_12:7 But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to every man to profit withal.
- 1Co\_12:8 For to one is given by the Spirit the word of wisdom; to another the word of knowledge by the same Spirit;
- 1Co\_12:9 To another faith by the same Spirit; to another the gifts of healing by the same Spirit;
- 1Co\_12:11 But all these worketh that one and the selfsame Spirit, dividing to every man severally as he will.
- 1Co\_12:13 For by one Spirit are we all baptized into one body, whether we be Jews or Gentiles, whether we be bond or free; and have been all made to drink into one Spirit.
- <u>1Co\_14:2</u> For he that speaketh in an *unknown* tongue speaketh not unto men, but unto God: for no man understandeth *him;* howbeit in the spirit he speaketh mysteries.
- 1Co\_14:14 For if I pray in an *unknown* tongue, my spirit prayeth, but my understanding is unfruitful.
- 1Co\_14:15 What is it then? I will pray with the spirit, and I will pray with the

- understanding also: I will sing with the spirit, and I will sing with the understanding also.
- <u>1Co\_14:16</u> Else when thou shalt bless with the spirit, how shall he that occupieth the room of the unlearned say Amen at thy giving of thanks, seeing he understandeth not what thou sayest?
- 1Co\_15:45 And so it is written, The first man Adam was made a living soul; the last Adam was made a quickening spirit.
- <u>1Co\_16:18</u> For they have refreshed my spirit and yours: therefore acknowledge ye them that are such.
- 2Co\_1:22 Who hath also sealed us, and given the earnest of the Spirit in our hearts.
- 2Co\_2:13 I had no rest in my spirit, because I found not Titus my brother: but taking my leave of them, I went from thence into Macedonia.
- <u>2Co\_3:3</u> Forasmuch as ye are manifestly declared to be the epistle of Christ ministered by us, written not with ink, but with the Spirit of the living God; not in tables of stone, but in fleshy tables of the heart.
- <u>2Co\_3:6</u> Who also hath made us able ministers of the new testament; not of the letter, but of the spirit: for the letter killeth, but the spirit giveth life.
- 2Co\_3:8 How shall not the ministration of the spirit be rather glorious?
- 2Co\_3:17 Now the Lord is that Spirit: and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty.
- <u>2Co\_3:18</u> But we all, with open face beholding as in a glass the glory of the Lord, are changed into the same image from glory to glory, *even* as by the Spirit of the Lord.
- 2Co\_4:13 We having the same spirit of faith, according as it is written, I believed, and therefore have I spoken; we also believe, and therefore speak;
- 2Co\_5:5 Now he that hath wrought us for the selfsame thing *is* God, who also hath given unto us the earnest of the Spirit.
- <u>2Co\_7:1</u> Having therefore these promises, dearly beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from all filthiness of the flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in the fear of God.
- 2Co\_7:13 Therefore we were comforted in your comfort: yea, and exceedingly the more joyed we for the joy of Titus, because his spirit was refreshed by you all.

- <u>2Co\_11:4</u> For if he that cometh preacheth another Jesus, whom we have not preached, or *if* ye receive another spirit, which ye have not received, or another gospel, which ye have not accepted, ye might well bear with *him*.
- <u>2Co\_12:18</u> I desired Titus, and with *him* I sent a brother. Did Titus make a gain of you? walked we not in the same spirit? *walked we* not in the same steps?
- <u>Gal\_3:2</u> This only would I learn of you, Received ye the Spirit by the works of the law, or by the hearing of faith?
- <u>Gal\_3:3</u> Are ye so foolish? having begun in the Spirit, are ye now made perfect by the flesh?
- <u>Gal\_3:5</u> He therefore that ministereth to you the Spirit, and worketh miracles among you, *doeth he it* by the works of the law, or by the hearing of faith?
- <u>Gal\_3:14</u> That the blessing of Abraham might come on the Gentiles through Jesus Christ; that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.
- <u>Gal\_4:6</u> And because ye are sons, God hath sent forth the Spirit of his Son into your hearts, crying, Abba, Father.
- <u>Gal\_4:29</u> But as then he that was born after the flesh persecuted him *that was* born after the Spirit, even so *it is* now.
- <u>Gal\_5:5</u> For we through the Spirit wait for the hope of righteousness by faith.
- <u>Gal\_5:16</u> This I say then, Walk in the Spirit, and ye shall not fulfil the lust of the flesh.
- <u>Gal\_5:17</u> For the flesh lusteth against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh: and these are contrary the one to the other: so that ye cannot do the things that ye would.
- <u>Gal\_5:18</u> But if ye be led of the Spirit, ye are not under the law.
- <u>Gal\_5:22</u> But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith,
- <u>Gal\_5:25</u> If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit.
- <u>Gal\_6:1</u> Brethren, if a man be overtaken in a fault, ye which are spiritual, restore such an one in the spirit of meekness; considering thyself, lest thou also be tempted.
- <u>Gal\_6:8</u> For he that soweth to his flesh shall of the flesh reap corruption; but he that soweth to the Spirit shall of the Spirit reap life everlasting.

- <u>Gal\_6:18</u> Brethren, the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ *be* with your spirit. Amen. To the Galatians written from Rome.
- <u>Eph\_1:13</u> In whom ye also *trusted*, after that ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that holy Spirit of promise,
- <u>Eph\_1:17</u> That the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give unto you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of him:
- <u>Eph\_2:2</u> Wherein in time past ye walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that now worketh in the children of disobedience:
- <u>Eph\_2:18</u> For through him we both have access by one Spirit unto the Father.
- <u>Eph\_2:22</u> In whom ye also are builded together for an habitation of God through the Spirit.
- <u>Eph\_3:5</u> Which in other ages was not made known unto the sons of men, as it is now revealed unto his holy apostles and prophets by the Spirit;
- <u>Eph\_3:16</u> That he would grant you, according to the riches of his glory, to be strengthened with might by his Spirit in the inner man;
- <u>Eph\_4:3</u> Endeavouring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.
- <u>Eph\_4:4</u> There is one body, and one Spirit, even as ye are called in one hope of your calling;
- Eph\_4:23 And be renewed in the spirit of your mind;
- <u>Eph\_4:30</u> And grieve not the holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption.
- <u>Eph\_5:9</u> (For the fruit of the Spirit *is* in all goodness and righteousness and truth;)
- <u>Eph\_5:18</u> And be not drunk with wine, wherein is excess; but be filled with the Spirit;
- <u>Eph\_6:17</u> And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God:
- <u>Eph\_6:18</u> Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints;
- Php\_1:19 For I know that this shall turn to my salvation through your prayer, and the supply of the Spirit of Jesus Christ,

- <u>Php\_1:27</u> Only let your conversation be as it becometh the gospel of Christ: that whether I come and see you, or else be absent, I may hear of your affairs, that ye stand fast in one spirit, with one mind striving together for the faith of the gospel;
- <u>Php\_2:1</u> If there be therefore any consolation in Christ, if any comfort of love, if any fellowship of the Spirit, if any bowels and mercies,
- <u>Php\_3:3</u> For we are the circumcision, which worship God in the spirit, and rejoice in Christ Jesus, and have no confidence in the flesh.
- Col 1:8 Who also declared unto us your love in the Spirit.
- <u>Col\_2:5</u> For though I be absent in the flesh, yet am I with you in the spirit, joying and beholding your order, and the stedfastness of your faith in Christ.
- <u>1Th\_4:8</u> He therefore that despiseth, despiseth not man, but God, who hath also given unto us his holy Spirit.
- <u>1Th\_5:19</u> Quench not the Spirit.
- <u>1Th\_5:23</u> And the very God of peace sanctify you wholly; and *I pray God* your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.
- <u>2Th\_2:2</u> That ye be not soon shaken in mind, or be troubled, neither by spirit, nor by word, nor by letter as from us, as that the day of Christ is at hand.
- <u>2Th\_2:8</u> And then shall that Wicked be revealed, whom the Lord shall consume with the spirit of his mouth, and shall destroy with the brightness of his coming:
- <u>2Th\_2:13</u> But we are bound to give thanks alway to God for you, brethren beloved of the Lord, because God hath from the beginning chosen you to salvation through sanctification of the Spirit and belief of the truth:
- <u>1Ti\_3:16</u> And without controversy great is the mystery of godliness: God was manifest in the flesh, justified in the Spirit, seen of angels, preached unto the Gentiles, believed on in the world, received up into glory.
- <u>1Ti\_4:1</u> Now the Spirit speaketh expressly, that in the latter times some shall depart from the faith, giving heed to seducing spirits, and doctrines of devils;
- <u>1Ti\_4:12</u> Let no man despise thy youth; but be thou an example of the believers, in word, in conversation, in charity, in spirit, in faith, in purity.
- <u>2Ti\_1:7</u> For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.

- <u>2Ti\_4:22</u> The Lord Jesus Christ *be* with thy spirit. Grace *be* with you. Amen. The second epistle unto Timotheus, ordained the first bishop of the church of the Ephesians, was written from Rome, when Paul was brought before Nero the second time.
- <u>Phm\_1:25</u> The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ *be* with your spirit. Amen. Written from Rome to Philemon, by Onesimus a servant.
- <u>Heb\_4:12</u> For the word of God *is* quick, and powerful, and sharper than any twoedged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and *is* a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.
- <u>Heb\_9:14</u> How much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without spot to God, purge your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?
- <u>Heb\_10:29</u> Of how much sorer punishment, suppose ye, shall he be thought worthy, who hath trodden under foot the Son of God, and hath counted the blood of the covenant, wherewith he was sanctified, an unholy thing, and hath done despite unto the Spirit of grace?
- <u>Jas\_2:26</u> For as the body without the spirit is dead, so faith without works is dead also.
- <u>Jas\_4:5</u> Do ye think that the scripture saith in vain, The spirit that dwelleth in us lusteth to envy?
- <u>1Pe\_1:2</u> Elect according to the foreknowledge of God the Father, through sanctification of the Spirit, unto obedience and sprinkling of the blood of Jesus Christ: Grace unto you, and peace, be multiplied.
- <u>1Pe\_1:11</u> Searching what, or what manner of time the Spirit of Christ which was in them did signify, when it testified beforehand the sufferings of Christ, and the glory that should follow.
- <u>1Pe\_1:22</u> Seeing ye have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit unto unfeigned love of the brethren, see that ye love one another with a pure heart fervently:
- <u>1Pe\_3:4</u> But *let it be* the hidden man of the heart, in that which is not corruptible, *even the ornament* of a meek and quiet spirit, which is in the sight of God of great price.
- <u>1Pe\_3:18</u> For Christ also hath once suffered for sins, the just for the unjust, that he might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh, but quickened by the Spirit:

- <u>1Pe\_4:6</u> For for this cause was the gospel preached also to them that are dead, that they might be judged according to men in the flesh, but live according to God in the spirit.
- <u>1Pe\_4:14</u> If ye be reproached for the name of Christ, happy *are ye;* for the spirit of glory and of God resteth upon you: on their part he is evil spoken of, but on your part he is glorified.
- 1Jn\_3:24 And he that keepeth his commandments dwelleth in him, and he in him. And hereby we know that he abideth in us, by the Spirit which he hath given us.
- <u>1Jn\_4:1</u> Beloved, believe not every spirit, but try the spirits whether they are of God: because many false prophets are gone out into the world.
- <u>1Jn\_4:2</u> Hereby know ye the Spirit of God: Every spirit that confesseth that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is of God:
- <u>1Jn\_4:3</u> And every spirit that confesseth not that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is not of God: and this is that *spirit* of antichrist, whereof ye have heard that it should come; and even now already is it in the world.
- <u>1Jn\_4:6</u> We are of God: he that knoweth God heareth us; he that is not of God heareth not us. Hereby know we the spirit of truth, and the spirit of error.
- <u>1Jn\_4:13</u> Hereby know we that we dwell in him, and he in us, because he hath given us of his Spirit.
- <u>1Jn\_5:6</u> This is he that came by water and blood, *even* Jesus Christ; not by water only, but by water and blood. And it is the Spirit that beareth witness, because the Spirit is truth.
- <u>1Jn\_5:8</u> And there are three that bear witness in earth, the Spirit, and the water, and the blood: and these three agree in one.
- <u>Jud\_1:19</u> These be they who separate themselves, sensual, having not the Spirit.
- Rev\_1:10 I was in the Spirit on the Lord's day, and heard behind me a great voice, as of a trumpet,
- Rev\_2:7 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; To him that overcometh will I give to eat of the tree of life, which is in the midst of the paradise of God.
- Rev\_2:11 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; He that overcometh shall not be hurt of the second death.
- Rev\_2:17 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the

churches; To him that overcometh will I give to eat of the hidden manna, and will give him a white stone, and in the stone a new name written, which no man knoweth saving he that receiveth *it*.

Rev\_2:29 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches.

Rev\_3:6 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches.

Rev\_3:13 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches.

Rev\_3:22 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches.

Rev\_4:2 And immediately I was in the spirit: and, behold, a throne was set in heaven, and *one* sat on the throne.

Rev\_11:11 And after three days and an half the Spirit of life from God entered into them, and they stood upon their feet; and great fear fell upon them which saw them.

<u>Rev\_14:13</u> And I heard a voice from heaven saying unto me, Write, Blessed are the dead which die in the Lord from henceforth: Yea, saith the Spirit, that they may rest from their labours; and their works do follow them.

Rev 17:3 So he carried me away in the

spirit into the wilderness: and I saw a woman sit upon a scarlet coloured beast, full of names of blasphemy, having seven heads and ten horns.

<u>Rev\_18:2</u> And he cried mightily with a strong voice, saying, Babylon the great is fallen, is fallen, and is become the habitation of devils, and the hold of every foul spirit, and a cage of every unclean and hateful bird.

Rev\_19:10 And I fell at his feet to worship him. And he said unto me, See thou do it not: I am thy fellowservant, and of thy brethren that have the testimony of Jesus: worship God: for the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy.

<u>Rev\_21:10</u> And he carried me away in the spirit to a great and high mountain, and shewed me that great city, the holy Jerusalem, descending out of heaven from God,

Rev\_22:17 And the Spirit and the bride say, Come. And let him that heareth say, Come. And let him that is athirst come. And whosoever will, let him take the water of life freely.
