## Do you not Realize that you are Rich!

And the LORD spake unto Aaron, Thou shalt have no inheritance in their land, neither shalt thou have any part among them: I am thy part and thine inheritance among the children of Israel. Numbers 18:20

When the Lord divided Canaan among Israel the tribe of Levi received no share of the land. God said to Aaron simply, "I am thy part and thine inheritance," which made him richer than all his brethren and richer than all the rulers and wealthy merchants.
